# Introduction

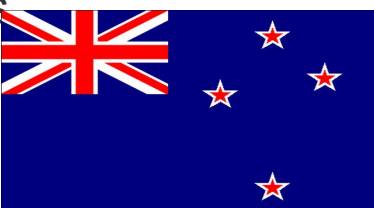
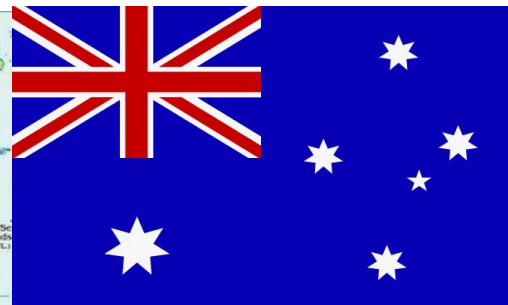

Canada has two official languages: French and English.

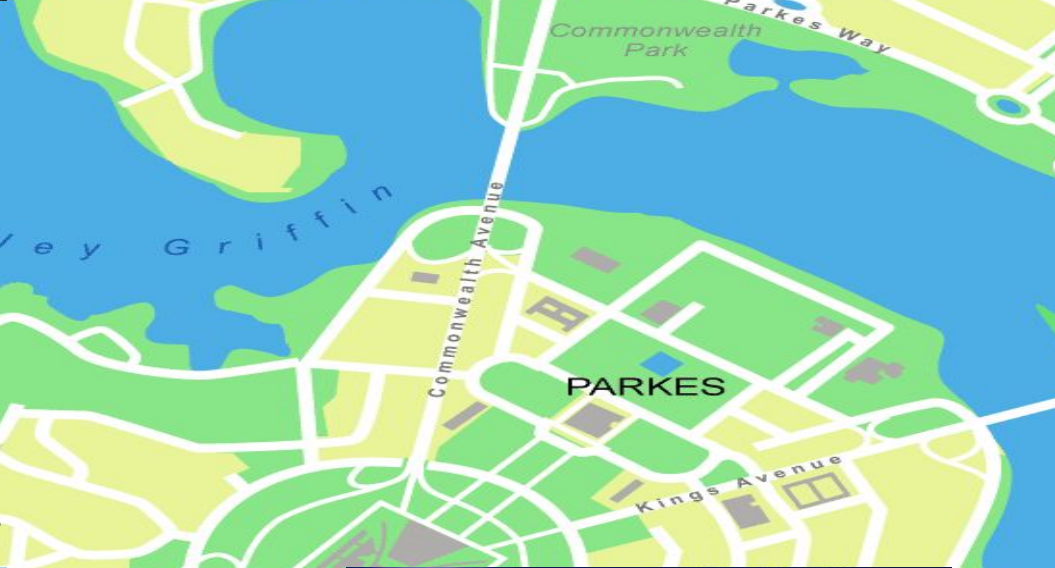
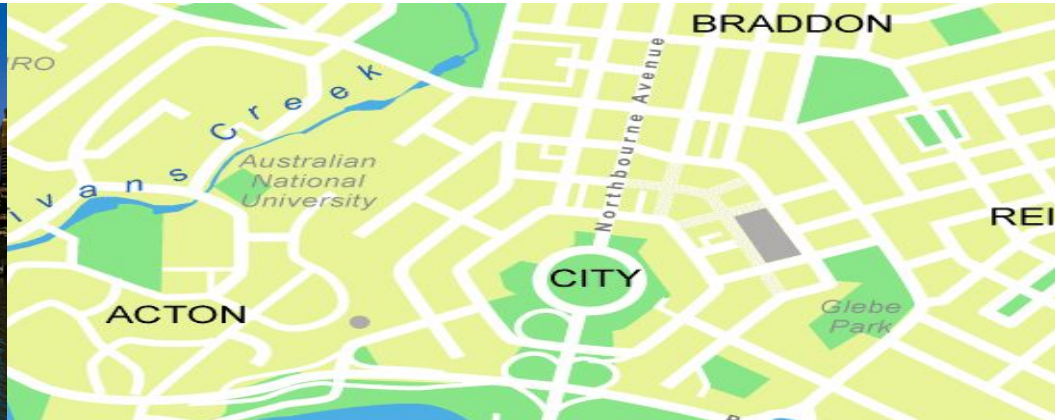
