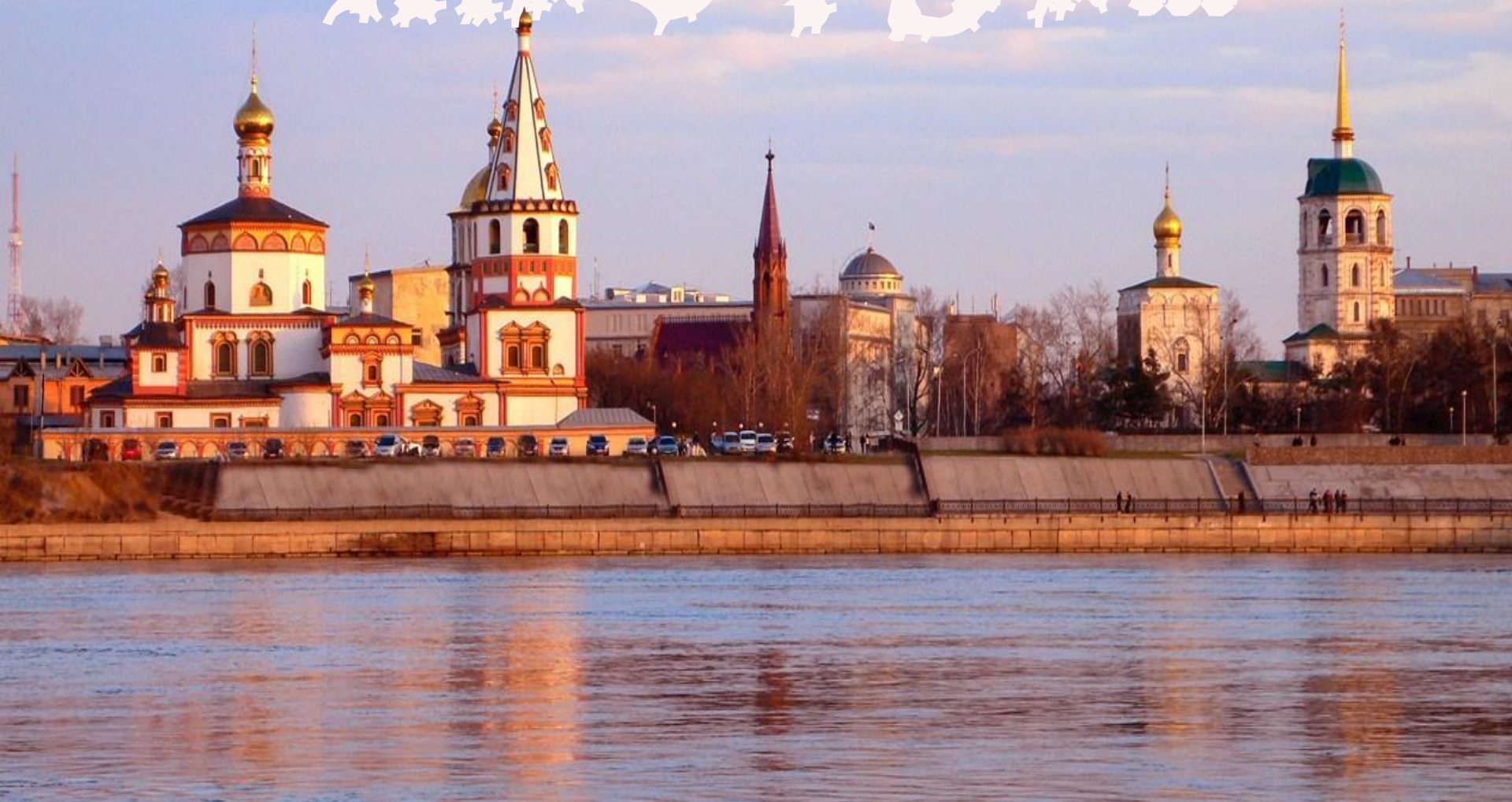

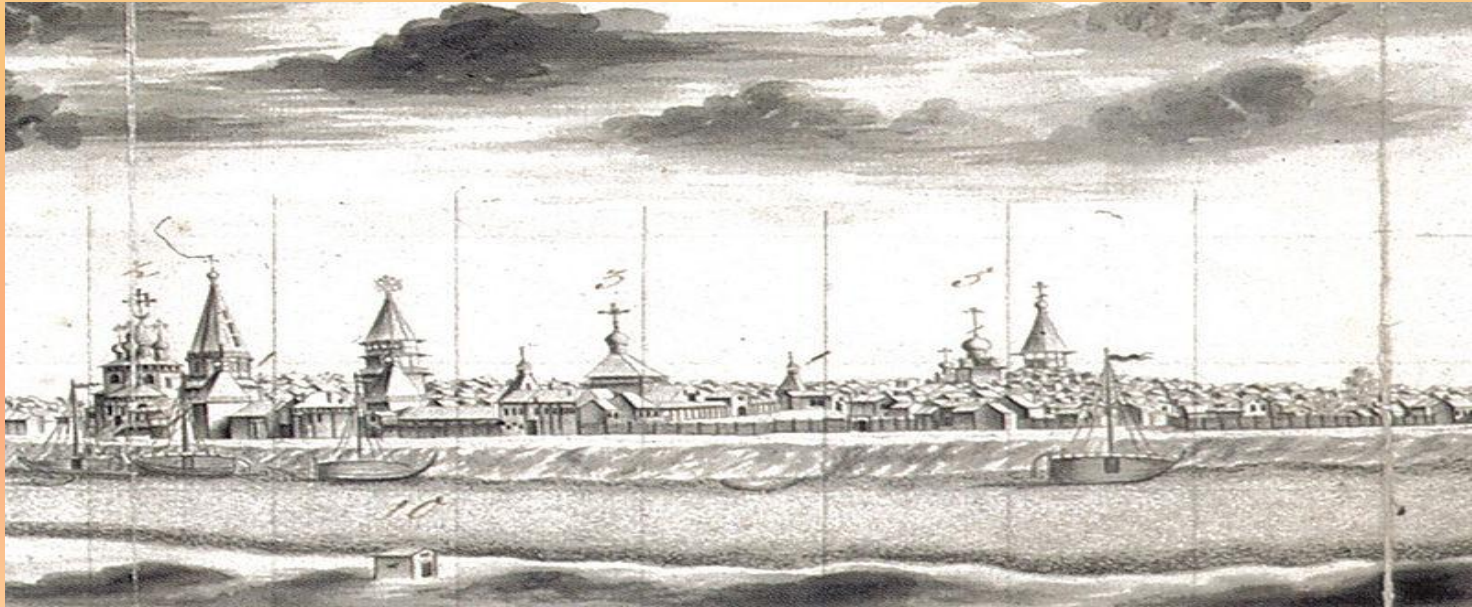
HISTORY

In 1652, Ivan Pokhabov built a zimovye (winter quarters) near the site of Irkutsk for gold trading and for the collection of fur taxes from the Buryats. In 1661, Yakov Pokhabov built an ostrog nearby. The ostrog gained official town rights from the government in 1686.

Восточной Сибири.)*



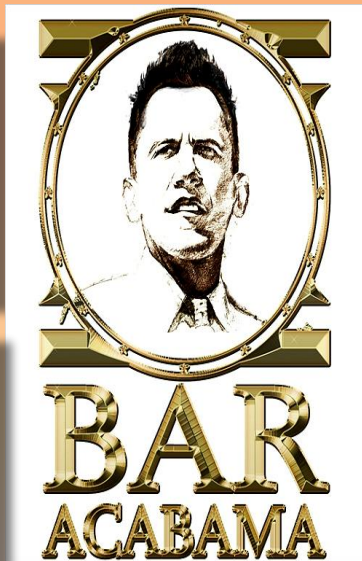
*Gradually, Irkutsk became the major center

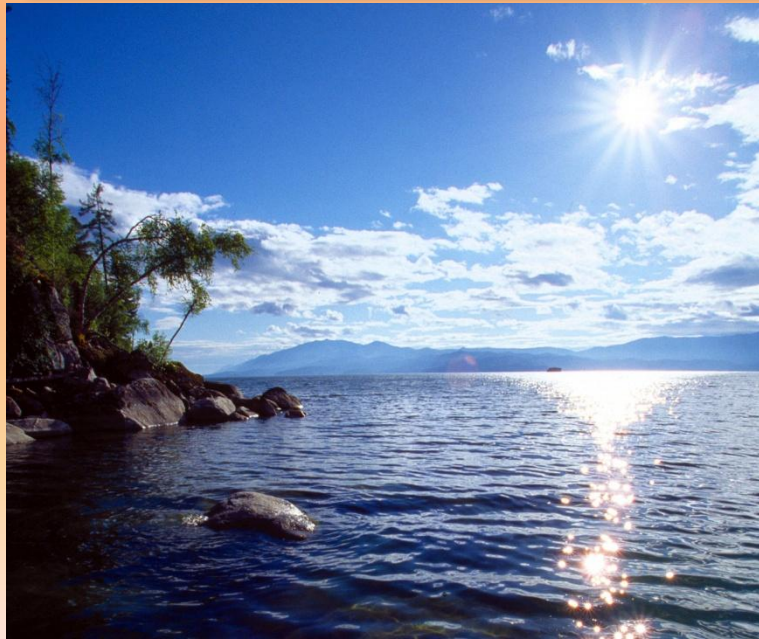

Lake Baikal is the deepest lake on the planet, the largest natural reservoir of fresh water. Lake and coastal areas offer a unique variety of flora and fauna. Local residents and many people in Russia are traditionally called Baikal Sea.
