

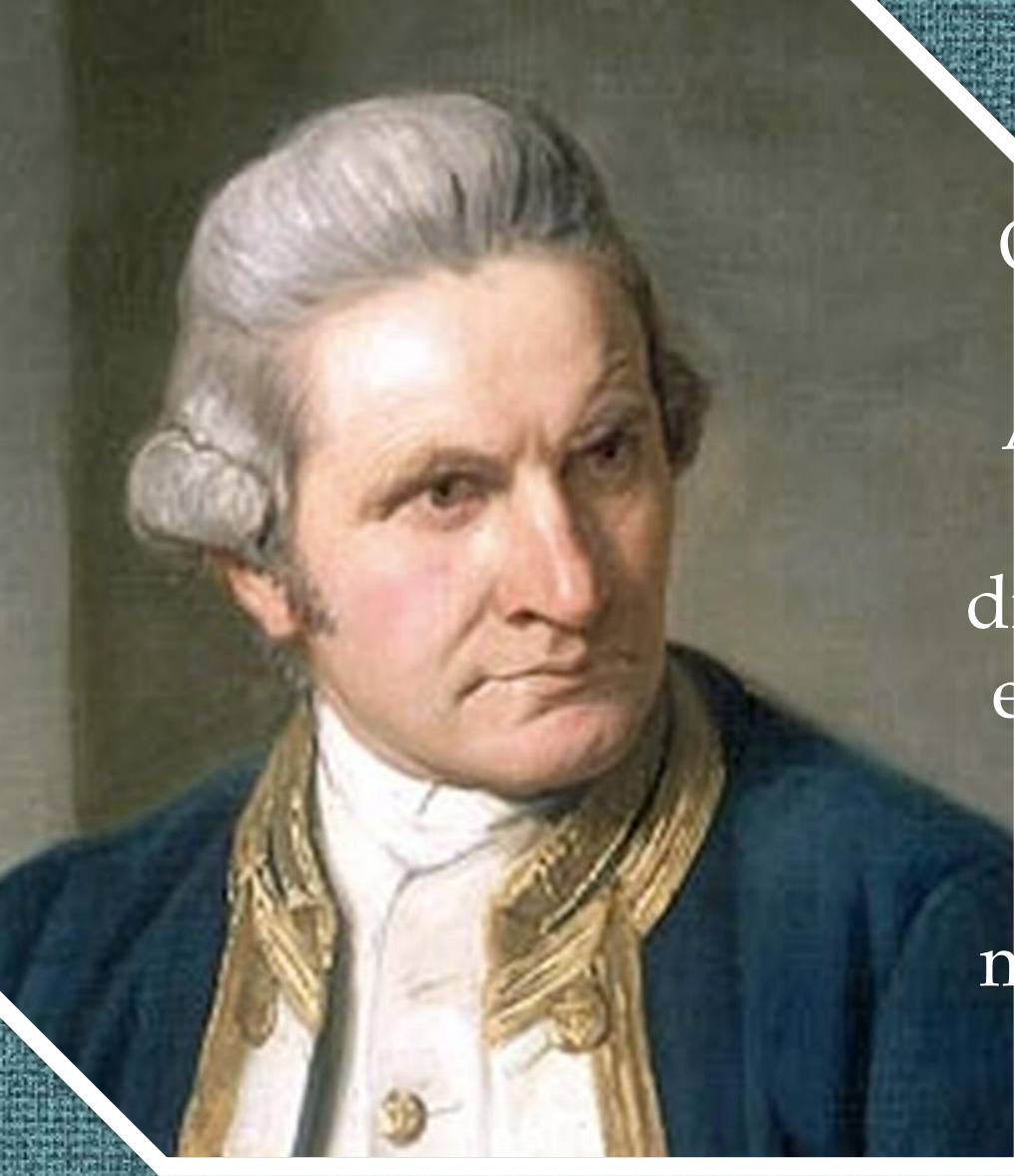


THE HISTORY OF THE AUSTRALIAN FLAG

perfection, constancy, chastity,
and protostele. (верность,
