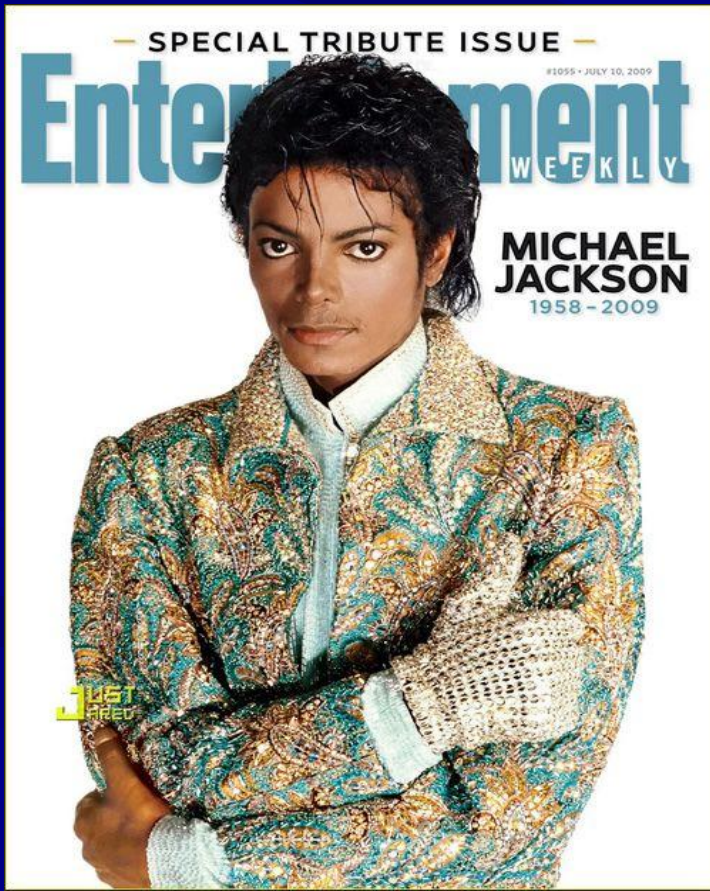

Michael Jackson



Michael Joseph Jackson was an American singer, songwriter, record producer and actor. He was born August, 29, 1958, in Gary, Indiana.



Date of death – June, 25, 2009.

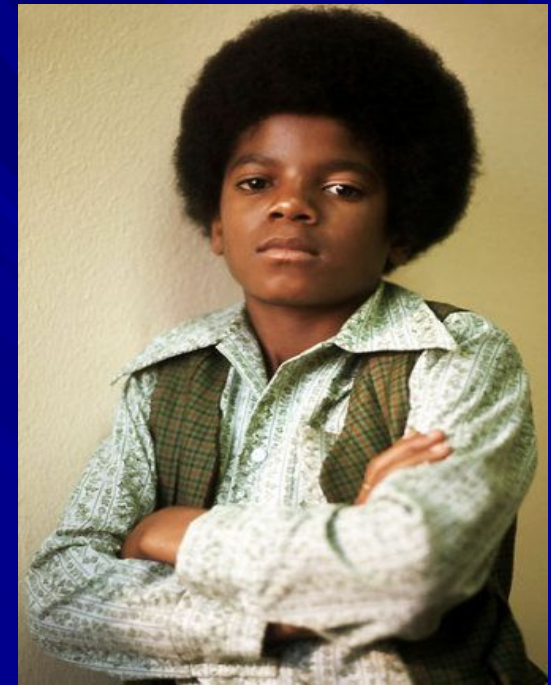


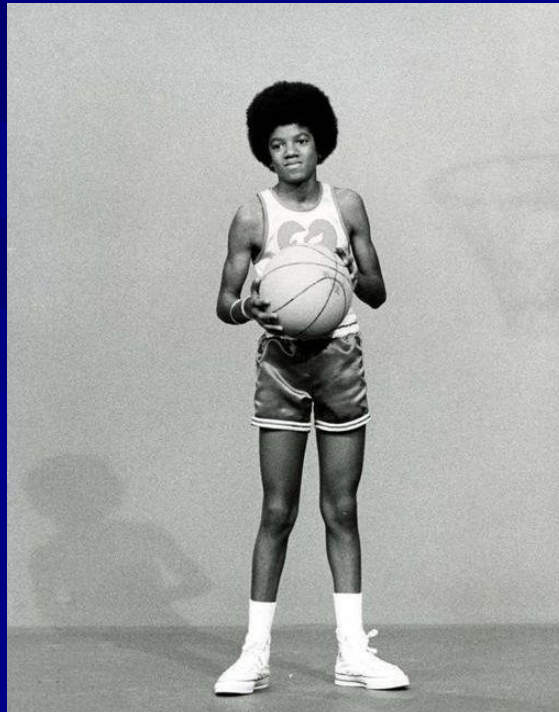
His parents were Joseph and Katherine Jackson, a crane operator and a seller.



The entire family - including older siblings, Rebbie, Jackie, Tito, Jermaine, LaToya and Marlon, and younger siblings Randy and Janet - lived together in a tiny two-bedroom house.

Since that time he had always been in the public eye. And since that time he had been working like a grown-up.



Michael began his career as the lead singer of the Motown act « The Jackson 5» in the 1960s, and made his first solo recordings in 1971 as part of the Jackson 5 franchise.



Jackson began a solo career in 1979 and formally parted with his siblings in 1987, and has since become the most successful recording artist in black music history, and one of the most successful solo artists in music history.



The 5th solo album «Off the wall» appeared in 1979 and was the ascent on the Pop Olymp. 19 million copies have been sold worldwide and it was the great success.



3 years later in 1982 his album «Thriller» became the best selling album in history, it has been said that 60 million copies have been sold worldwide. In addition to his albums, Jackson has also recorded thirteen number-one hits, including "Don't Stop 'Till You Get Enough", "Rock With You", "Billie Jean", and "Beat It".



The album «Bad» was out in 1987. 27 million copies have been sold worldwide.

Certainly his behaviour may seem eccentric. In public he often wore a face mask to protect himself from germs, he slept inside an oxygen capsule, which he believed would help him to live longer.



“I had pimples so badly it used to make me so shy. I used not to look at myself. I’d hide my face in the dark, I wouldn’t want to look in the mirror and my father teased me and I just hated it and I cried every day.”



Although Jackson's skin colour from his youth was that of an African American, his skin has lightened since 1982, and became later a pale melanin devoid colour.



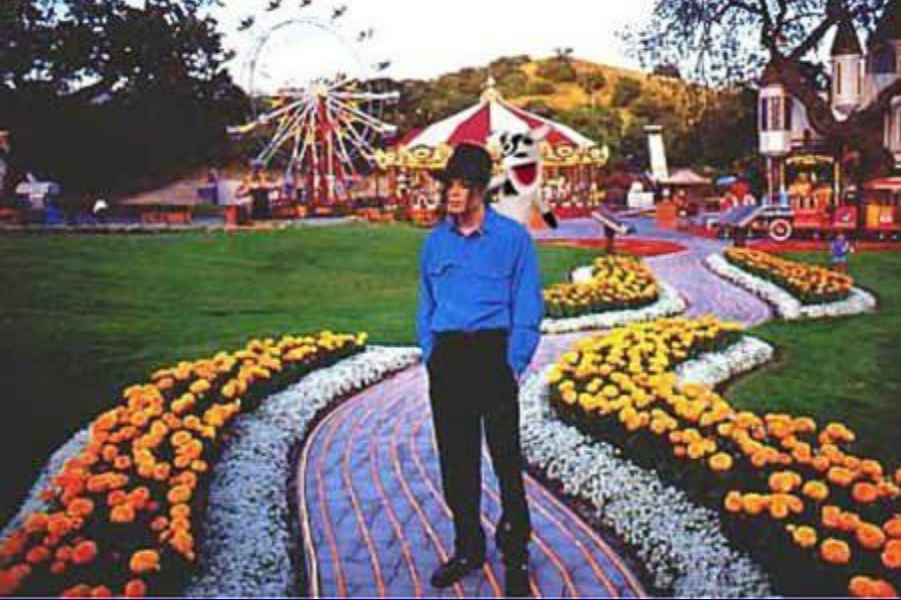
Jackson has explained his changing skin colour to vitiligo,- a skin disease in which the body develops antibodies against its own melanin, a body pigment, resulting in light patches and an eventual loss of all pigment.



Jackson has regularly worn long shirts and under an umbrella while in public to hide from the sun.



It is Neverland Ranch in California, which he bought in 1988. It stands in 2,700 acres of ground. It is named after the magical kingdom, Neverland, from the children's story, "Peter Pan".



Jackson, a huge Disney fan, built an amusement park on the ranch, and frequently welcomed sick and poor children there to visit.



Jackson was fond of animals:
he owned a private zoo at
Neverland, and was often seen
with a chimpanzee named
Bubbles and a snake called
Muscles.



In 1994 Jackson married Lisa Marie Presley, the daughter of Elvis Presley; the marriage was severely criticized by the media and lasted less than two years.

In 1996 Jackson married Deborah Jeanne Rowe, with whom he had a son, Michael Joseph Jackson, Jr. (who publicly goes by the name "Prince"), and a daughter, Paris-Michael Katherine Jackson. They were divorced in 1999.

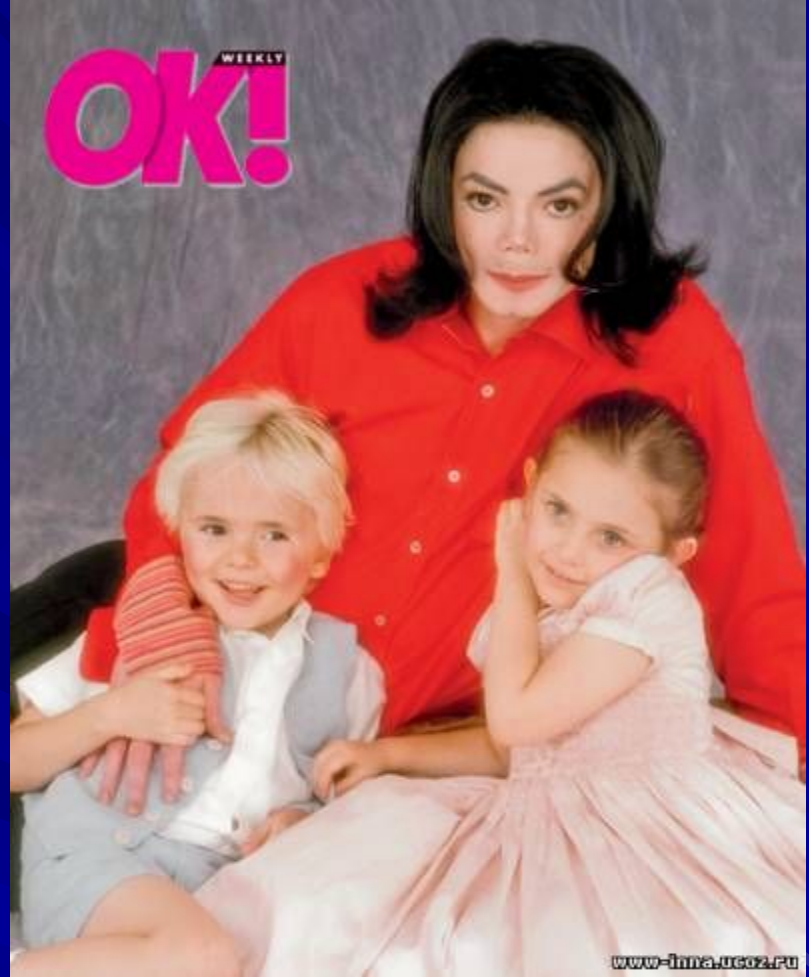

Around February 2002, Jackson had another son, *Michael Joseph Jackson III*, called both "*Prince Michael II*" and "*Blanket*", apparently with a surrogate mother whose identity has not been disclosed.

Michael Joseph Jackson died June, 25, 2009 as a result of heart disease.
