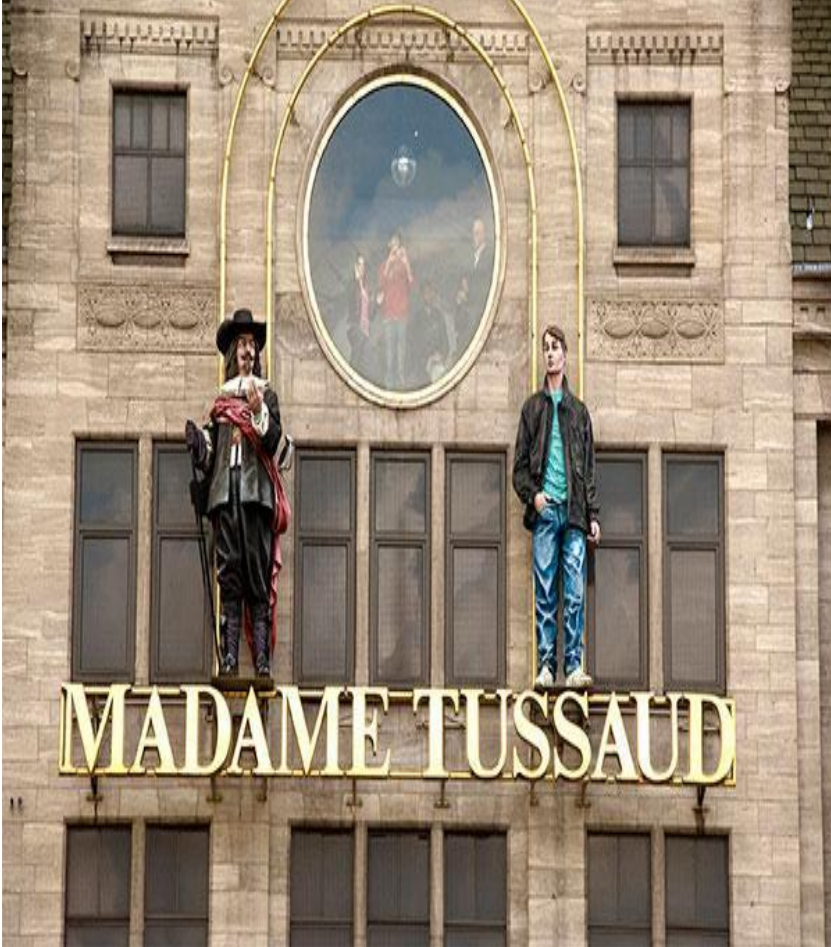


Trafalgar Square
