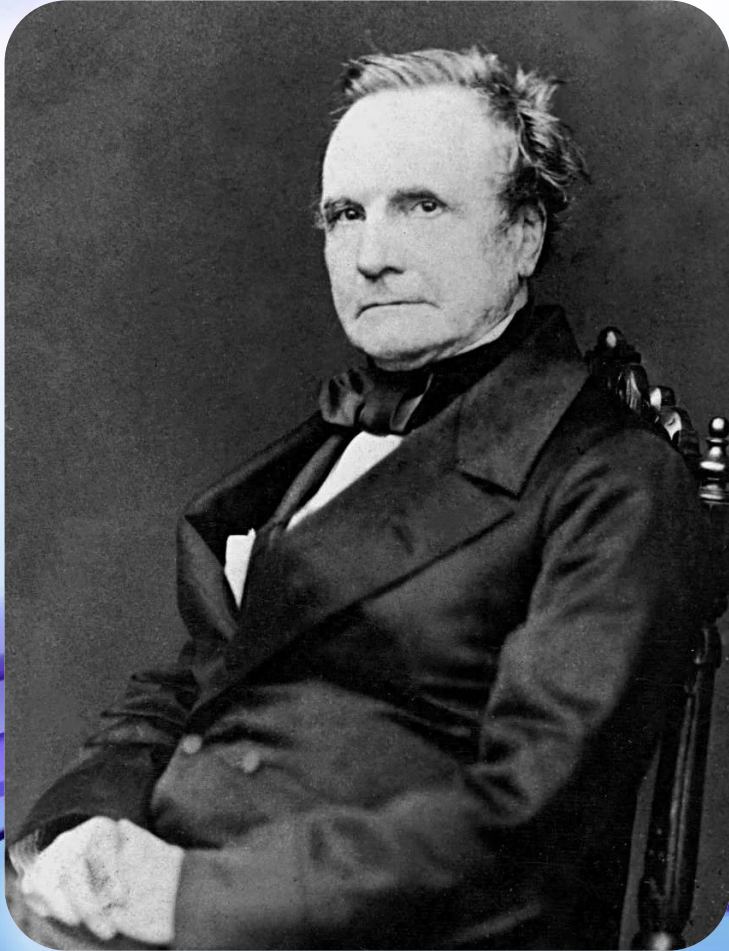

Charles Babbage



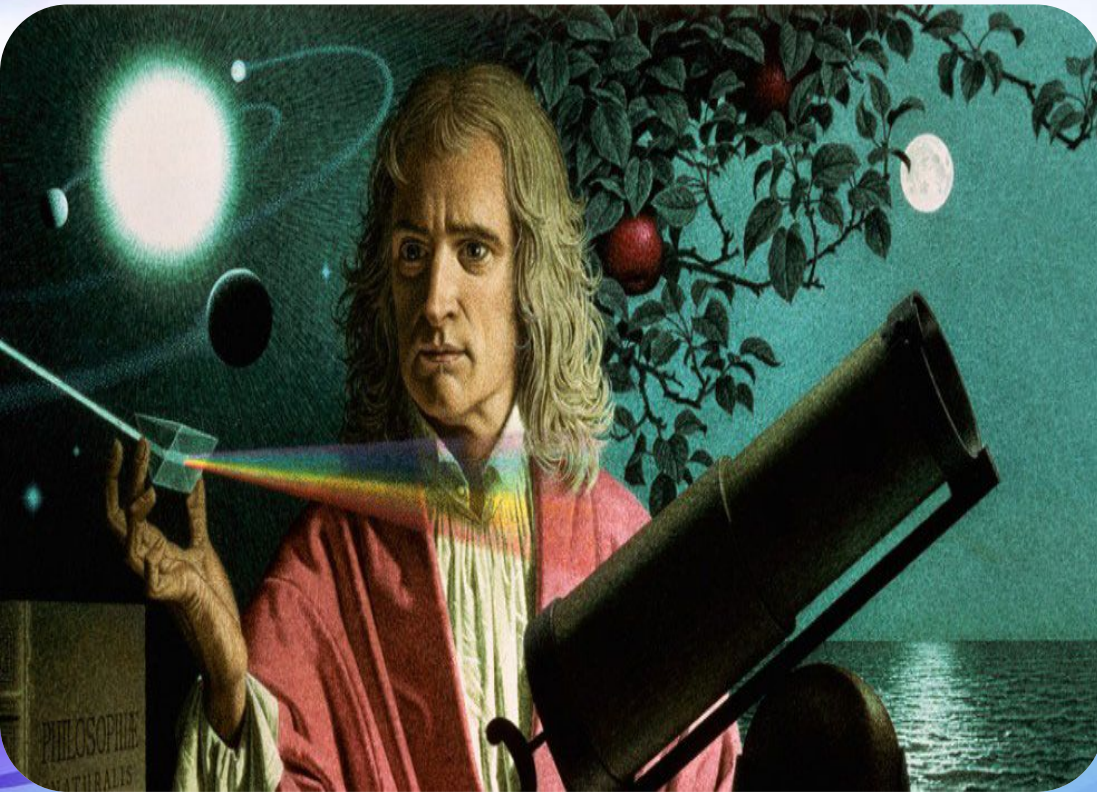

Isaac Newton



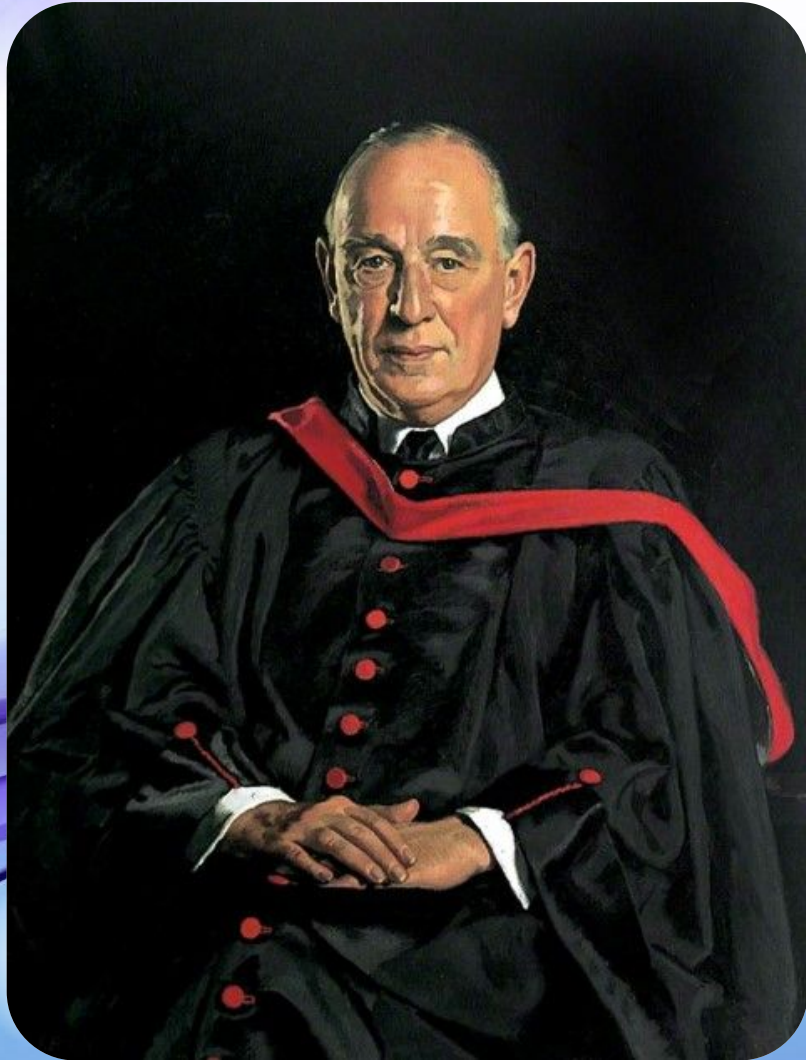
Isaac Newton* was a great **scientist** and contributed much to **developing** life sciences
