- trust somebody with a secret- доверять кому-либо секрет
- get on sb`s nerves – действовать на нервы
- rely on – полагаться
- make up with – мириться
- cheer sb up – подбодрить кого-либо
- be down - в плохом настроении
- hang out with- болтаться без дела
