Turkey

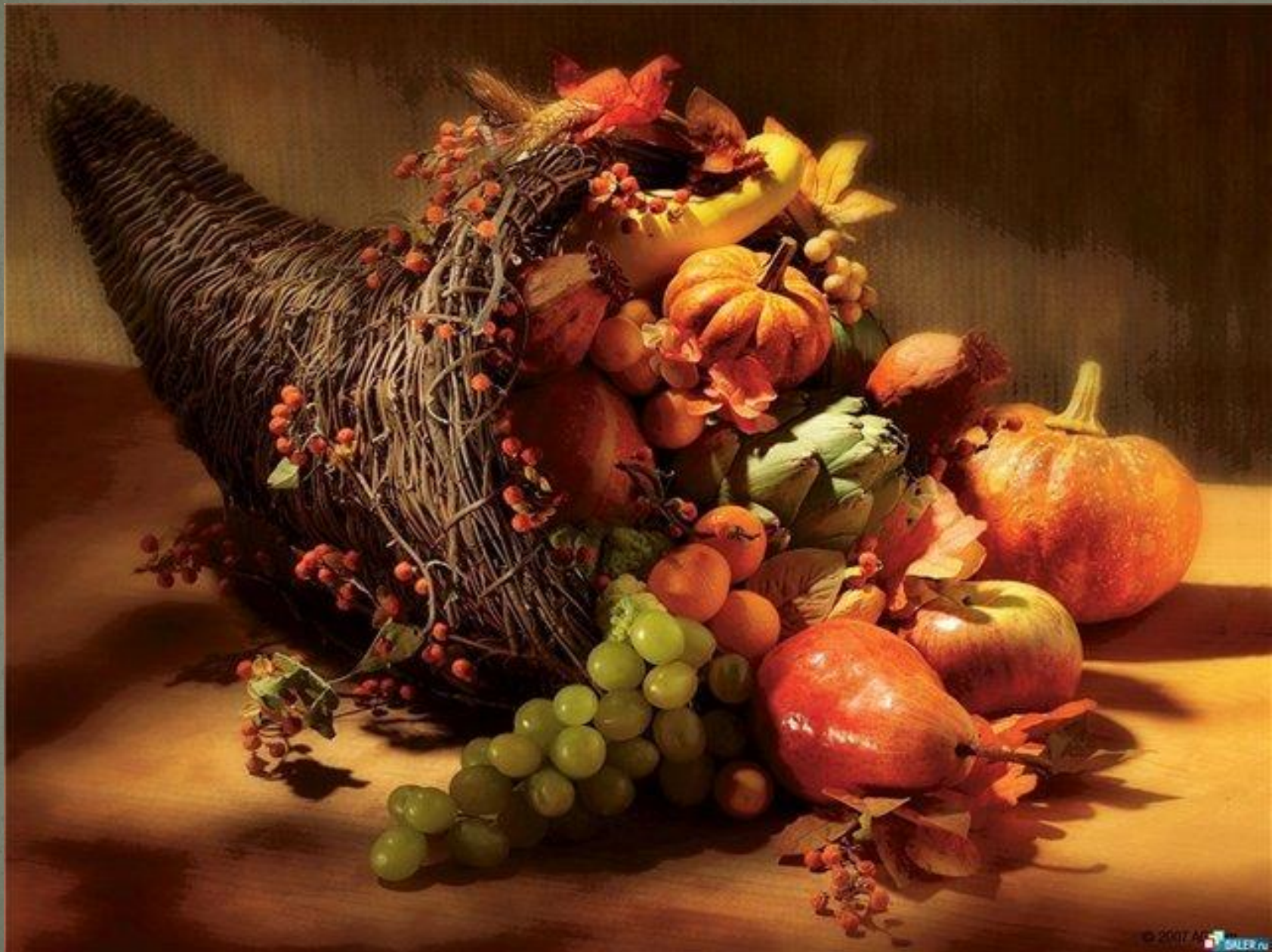
Cornucopia
