- 10 provinces: Alberta, British Columbia, Prince Edward Island, Manitoba, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Nunavut, Ontario, Quebec, Saskatchewan
- 3 territories: Newfoundland, Northwest territories, Yukon territory

Official Languages

- Two official languages: English and French
- English is the mother tongue of 59% of Canadians
- French is the first language of 23% of the population

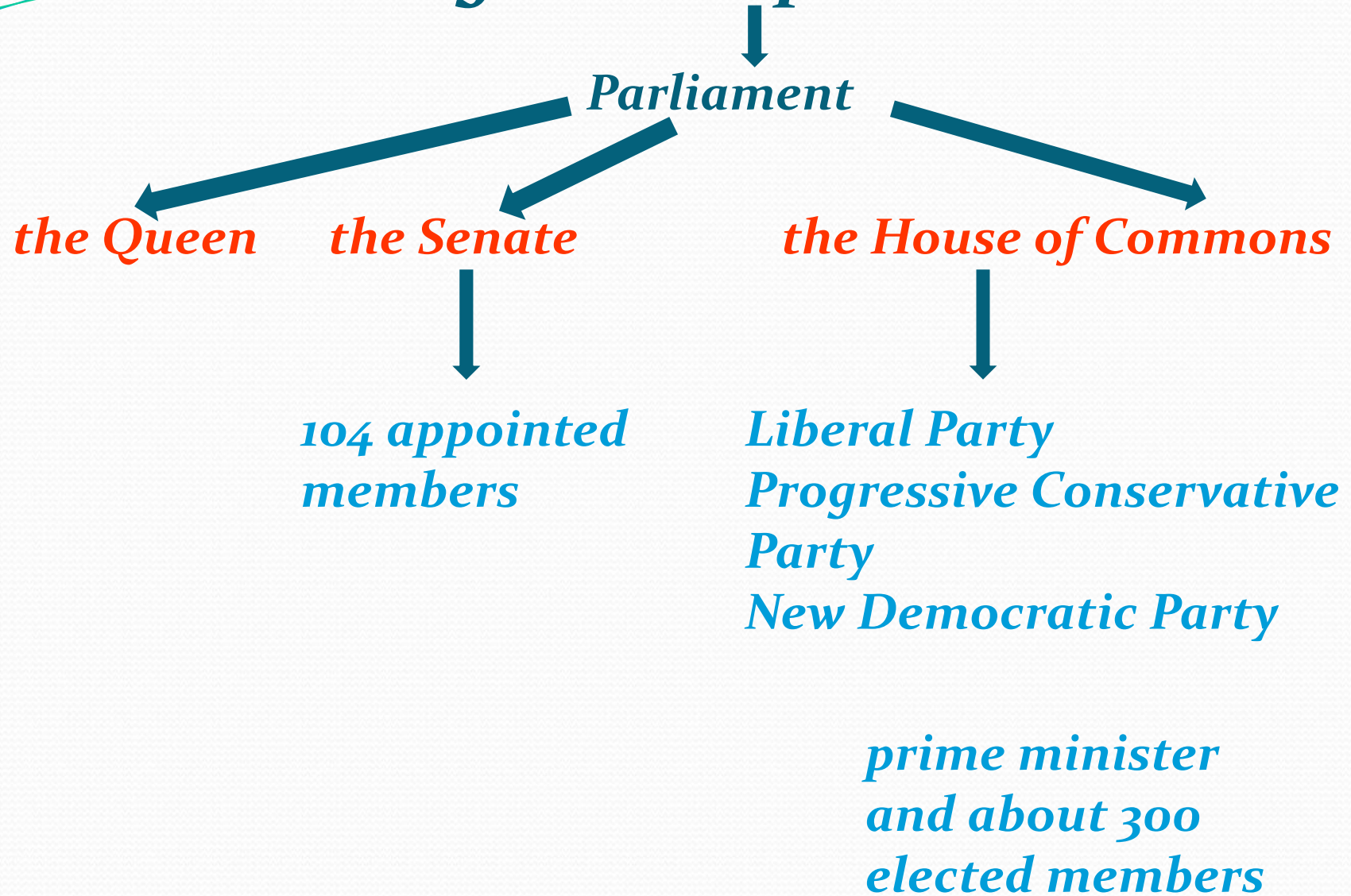
Canada is a constitutional monarchy
