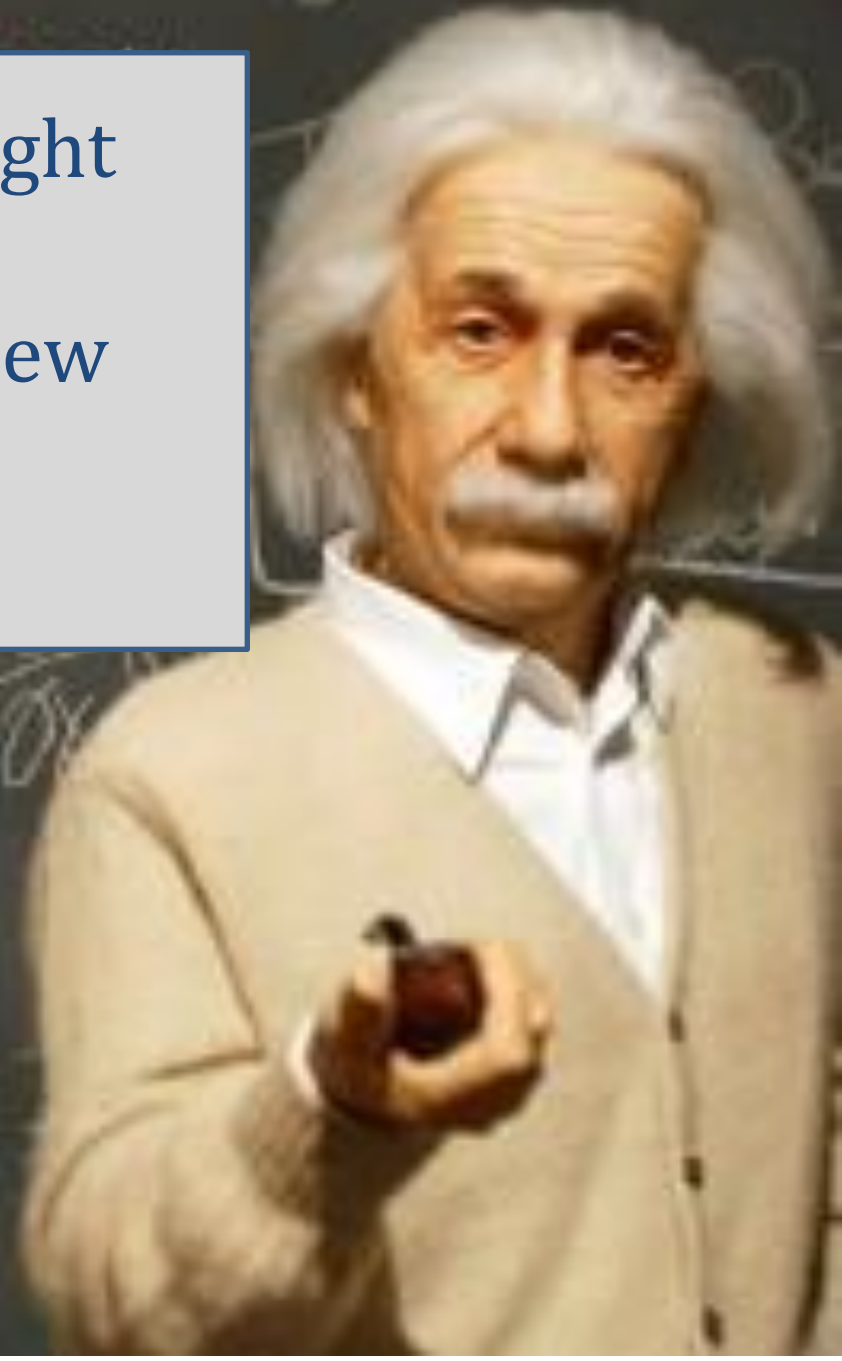

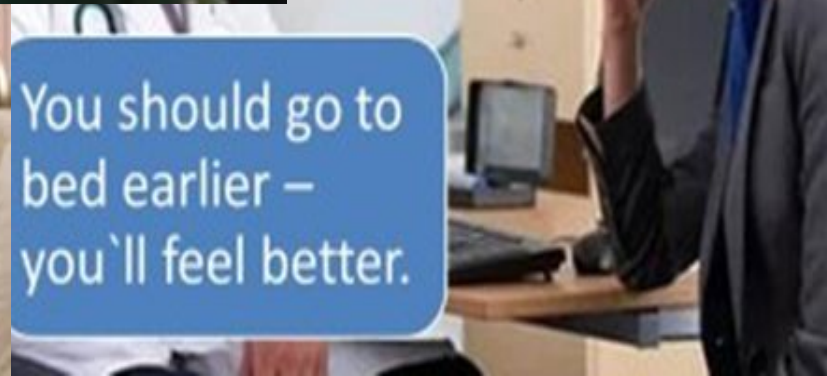

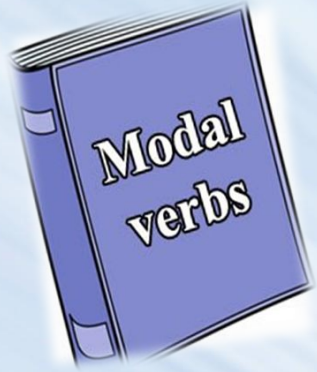

Should- следует, надо (совет)

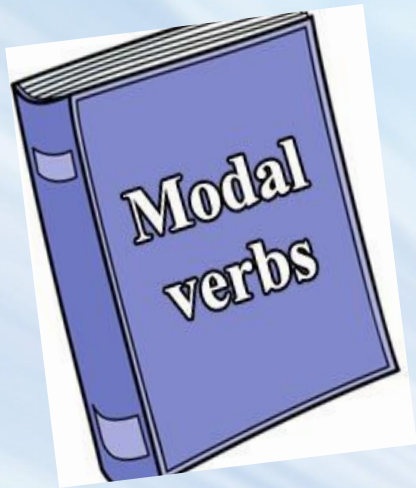




Rules of usage of modal verb **should:**

3. Частица ~~to~~ перед глаголом **should** **не ставится**





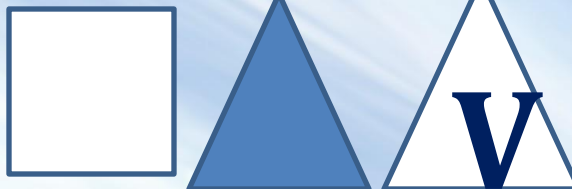

- выражает совет, рекомендации.

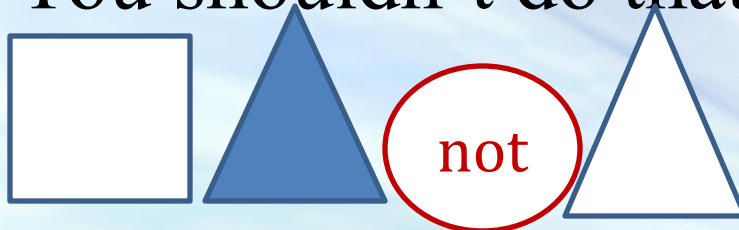
