- *Action started in the past and continues to the present with the emphasis on the duration*
- *Action has just/recently stopped and its results are visible in the present*

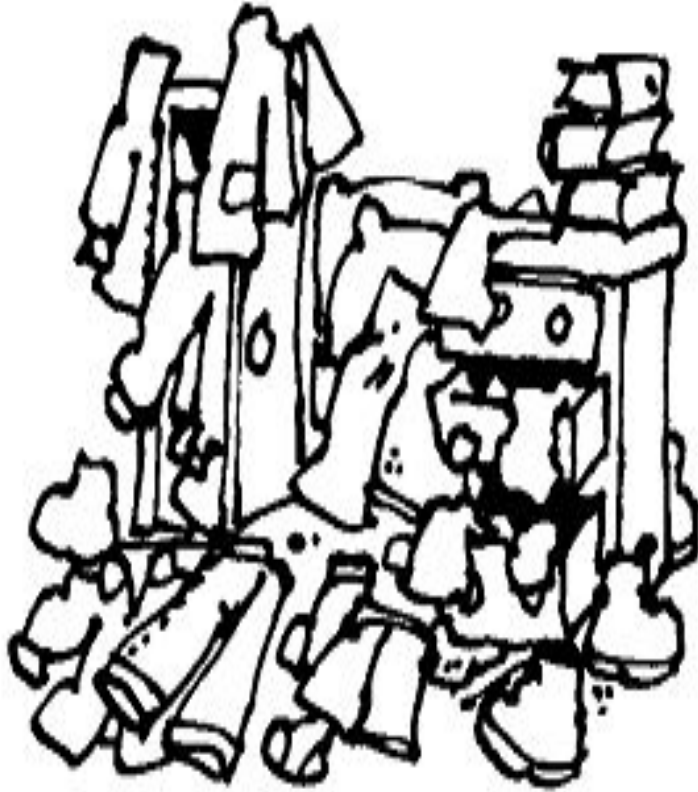

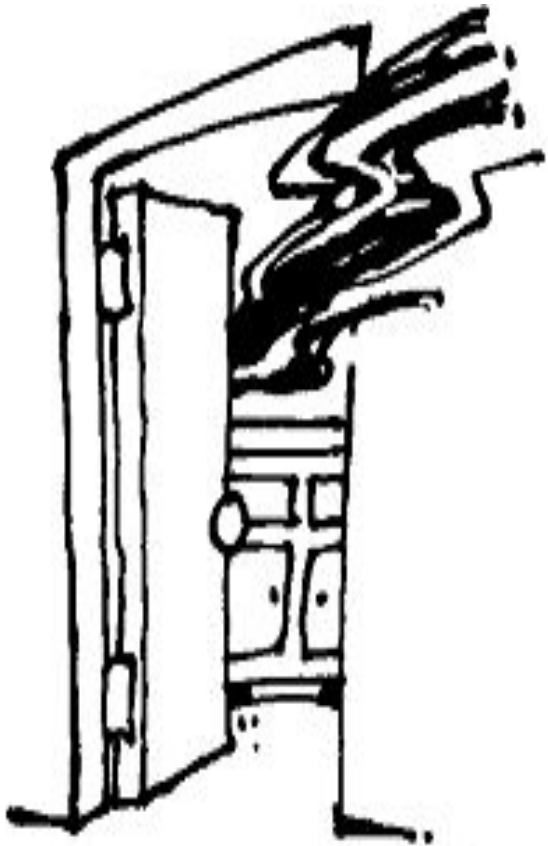
