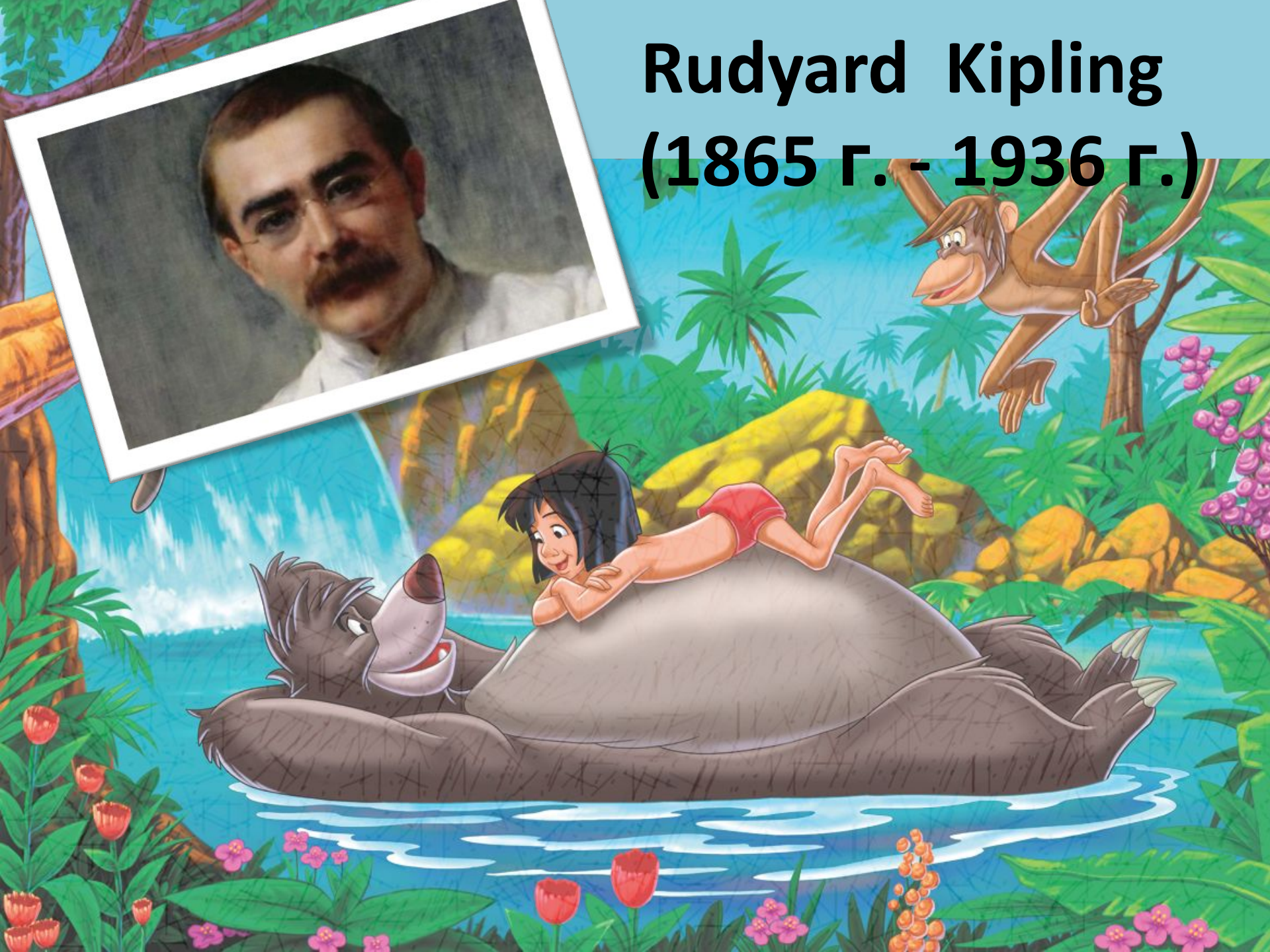


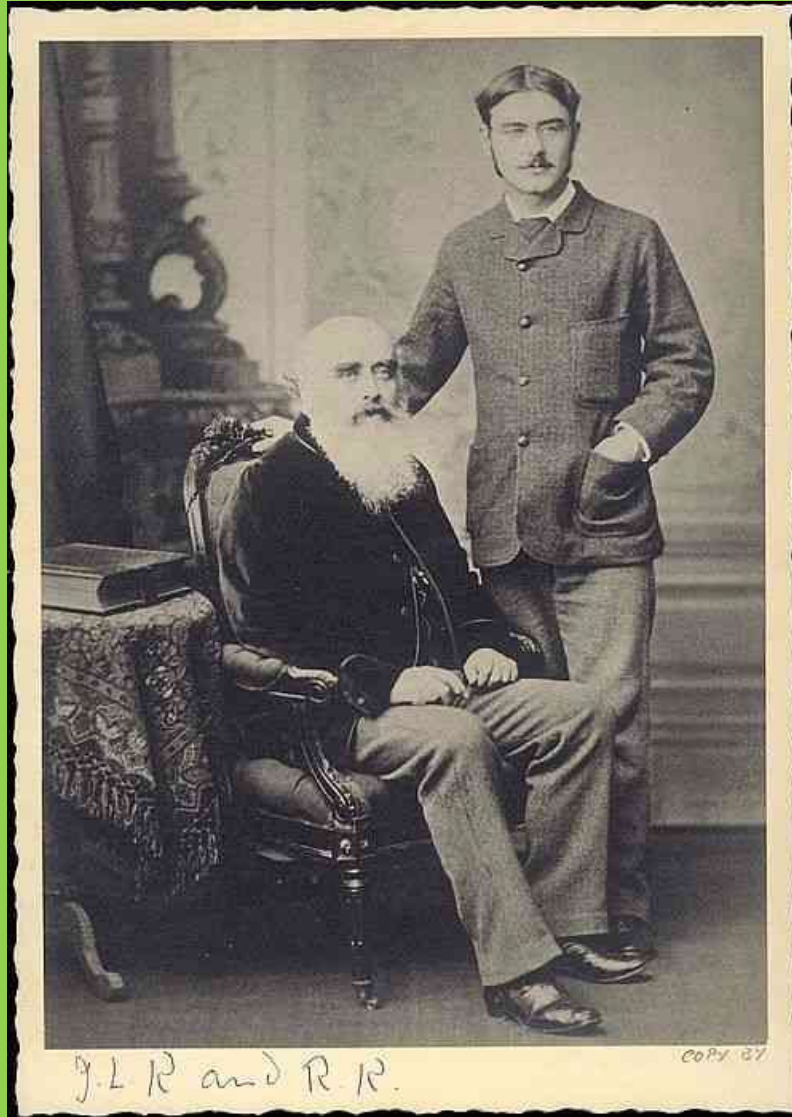

Rudyard Kipling was born on December 30, 1865 in Bombay (India). Early childhood Kipling later called as the time of



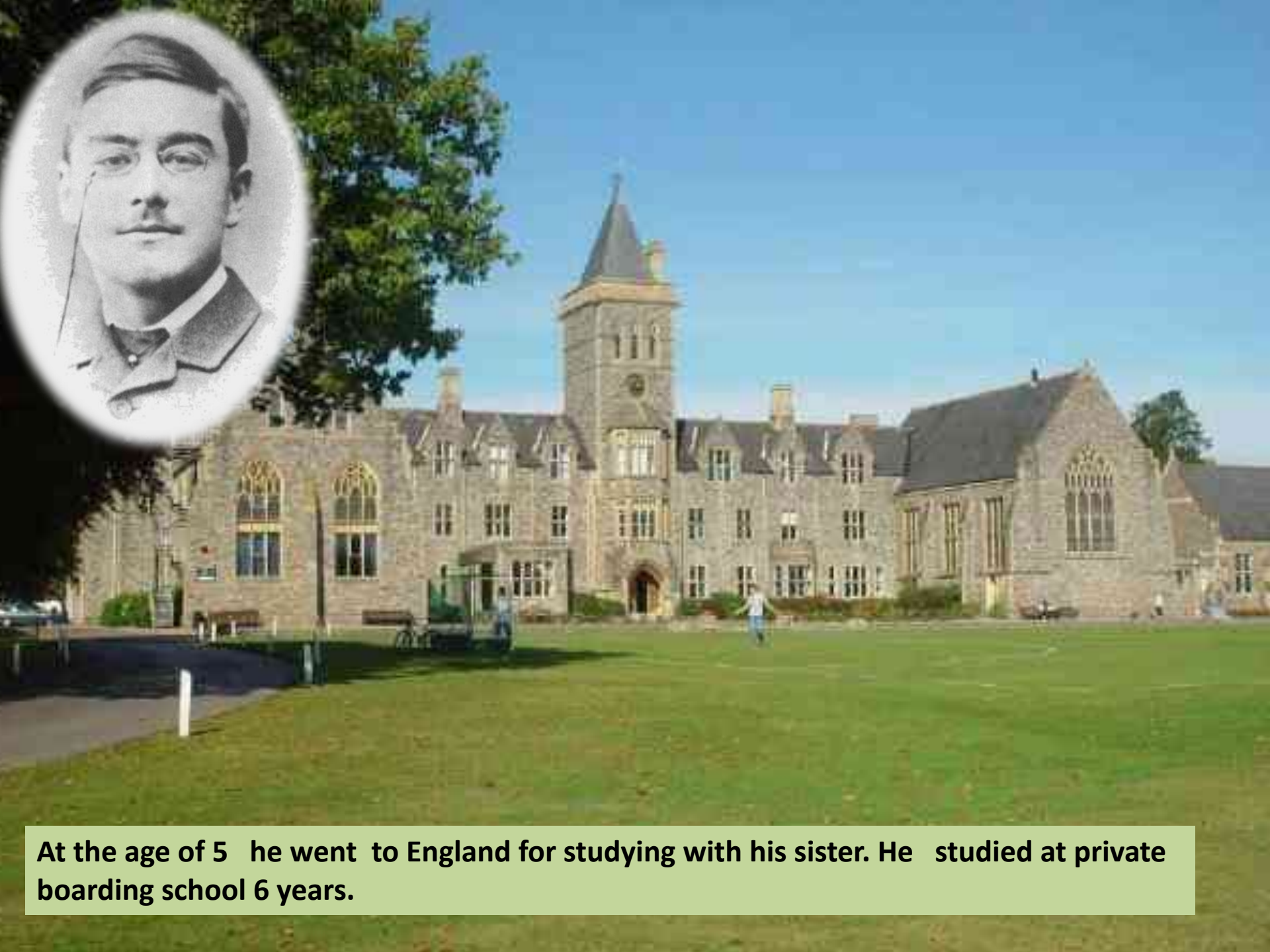
Rudyard Kipling and his father

His mother came from a known London family.

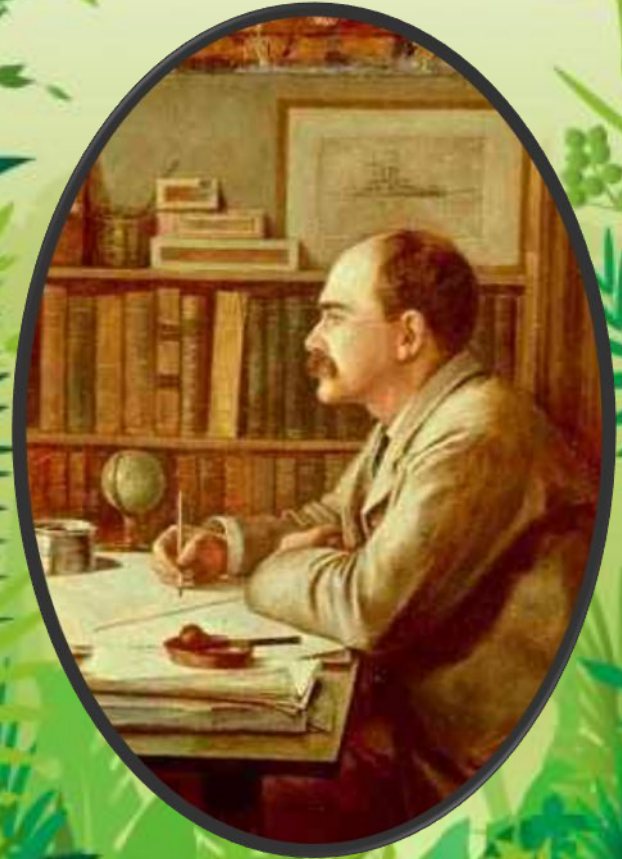
His both grandfathers were priests.
