Clauses of purpose. (Придаточные предложения цели)

- **to**
- **in order to** + V_1
- **so as to**

He is running to catch the bus.

Clauses of purpose. (Придаточные предложения цели)

- **so that+ can/will** (в значении наст. или будущего)

She'll stay at the office late so that she will finish the report.

Clauses of purpose.

- **so that + could**
/would (в значении прошедшего)

Joe joined a gym so that he could become better.

Clauses of purpose

- **With the view to**

+ **V_{ing}**

- **With the aim of**

He went to the bank with the aim of asking for a loan.

Clauses of result (следствие)

- **That**
- **So that**
- **And as a result**
- **And as a consequence, consequently (formal)**

It hadn't rained for two months and as a result the country was facing a water shortage.

Clauses of result

- **So/such a (an) + adj.+ noun+ that**

*They are such nice people
that everybody likes them.*

*Mr. Abbot is such a good
teacher that all his students
love him.*

Clauses of result

- **Such a lot of + noun**

He had such a lot of work to do that he had to cancel our dinner plans.

Clauses of result

- **So + adj (adv) + that**

**They were talking so loudly that
the librarian asked them to
leave the library.**

**There was so much traffic in the
street that it took us an our to
drive home.**

Clauses of result

- **As a result**
- **Therefore** + **that**
- **Consequently**
- **So**

We couldn't find a room to book in that hotel and therefore we had to look elsewhere.
