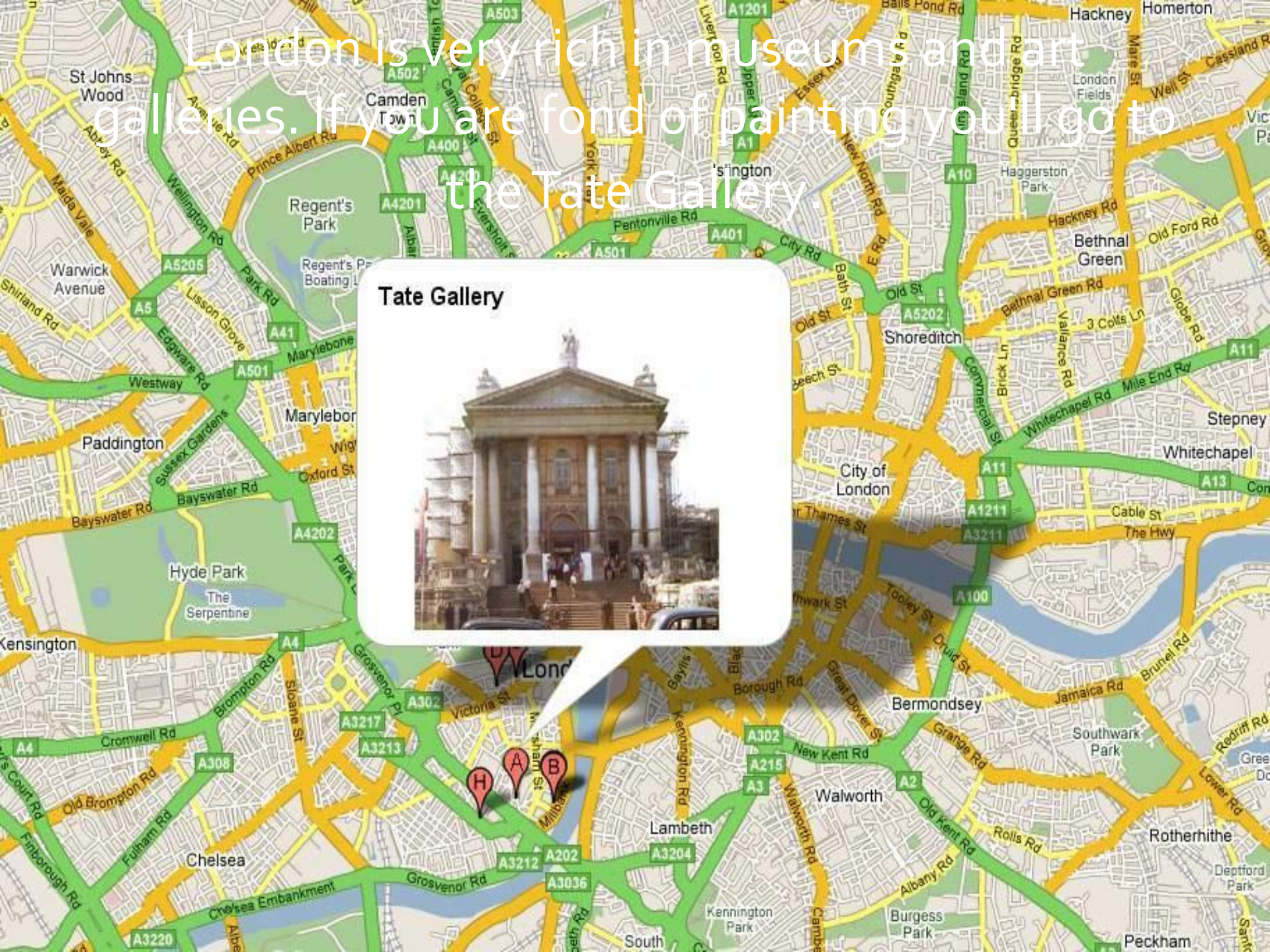
Big Ben
