VICTOR AGAPOV



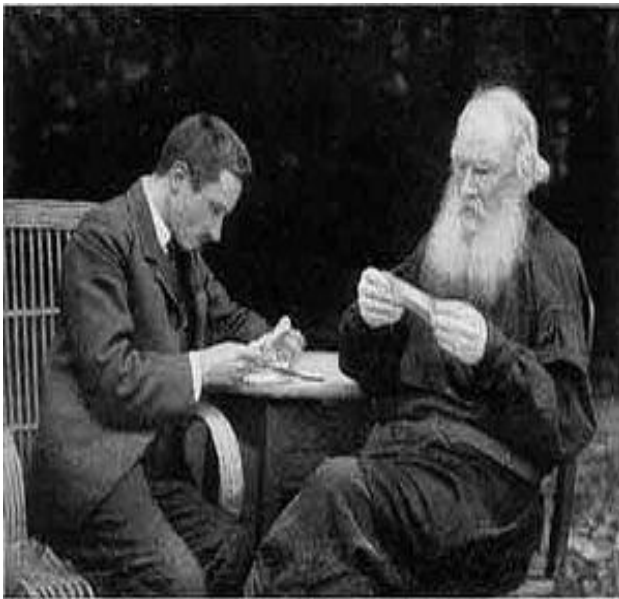
- Victor Agapov was born on April 3, 1939 in Kuznetsk . He is a laureate of several literature prizes among which there is the All-Russian Literary Prize named after M. Yu. Lermontov. This prize was awarded to him in 2010 posthumously.



VALENTIN BULGAKOV

Valentin Bulgakov was born on November 25, 1886 in Kuznetsk.

Bulgakov was a follower and the last secretary of L. N. Tolstoy, as well as the head of a number of literary museums.

LEONID SMIRNOV



Leonid Smirnov was born on April 16, 1916 in Kuznetsk. He was an outstanding figure in the defense industry.

L. Smirnov is twice hero of socialist labor.



VYACHESLAV VLASOV



He was born on March 26, 1952 in Kuznetsk. He is a Russian scientist, a Candidate of Historical Sciences (1978), an assistant professor (1984), a pedagogue, a high achiever of public education(1994), an Academician of the International Academy of Informatization, the first pro – rector of the Penza State Pedagogical University (2001)



BORIS TENIN



- Boris Nenin was born on March 23, 1905 in Kuznetsk. Boris Tenin is People's Artist of the USSR, a laureate of the Stalin Prize. He worked at the Moscow Theatre on Malaya Bronnaya He starred in many films and performances. His most famous role is the role of Commissioner Megre for central television.

ROMAN KARMAZIN



- Roman Karmazin was born on January 2, 1973 in Kuznetsk. He is a famous Russian professional boxer, a world champion (2005-2006) in IFB version (International boxing federation). He performed in the first middleweight.

ALEXANDER KALASHNIKOV



- A. Kalashnikov was born on January 9, 1956 in Kuznetsk. He was a director of the theatre «BUM». In 1997 he became a Honored Worker of Culture of the Russian Federation. Since 1985 he began searching in the genre of street wandering theatre. He was a participant in international theatre festivals in Moscow, Saint – Petersburg, Uzhgorod, German, Turkey, Norway.
- He is an honorary citizen of Kuznetsk.

LYUDMILA LOZITSKAYA



- Ludmila Lozitskaya was born on April 26, 1924 in Kuznetsk. She was a dramatic actress. Honored Artist of the Russian Federation (1957), People's Artist of the Russian Federation (1966). She graduated from school number 1 in Kuznetsk, worked as a turner and studied at the studio of the local theatre (1942-1947). Since 1947 she began to work in the Penza Drams Theatre. Then she became the leading actress of the theatre. She was awarded the Order of Labor Red Banner (1986). Ludmila Lozitskaya is an honorary citizen of Penza (1994).

Предтеченский Михаил



- Предтеченский Михаил Иванович (1902, Кузнецк – 20.08.1919), участник Октябрьской революции и Гражданской войны. Окончил в Кузнецке реальное училище, организовал в училище кружок юных революционеров, послуживший основой первой комсомольской ячейки «Коммунистический Союз молодежи (КСМ) им. 3-го Интернационала». Добровольцем ушел на Восточный фронт. В сражении был тяжело ранен. Умер на поле боя. Его именем названа улица в Кузнецке (1957).
