(regular verbs)



**V + ed**

Julia **walked** in the park

Неправильные глаголы  
(irregular verbs)



**V<sub>2</sub>**

V<sub>2</sub> – вторая  
форма  
глагола

He **took** the book from the library

*The Past Simple Tense обозначает действие, произошедшее в прошлом и не имеющее отношения к настоящему.*





## ***PAST SIMPLE***

***Yesterday, last, ago,  
the day before  
yesterday, in 1960***

**He played football yesterday.**

**He didn't play football  
yesterday.**

**Did he play football yesterday?**

**He bought a car yesterday.**

**He didn't buy a car yesterday.**

**Did he buy a car yesterday?**

## **PRESENT PERFECT**

**Ever, never, just,  
recently, already, yet,  
for, since, today**

**He has just played football.**

**He hasn't played football .**

**Has he played football?**

**He has bought a car.**

**He hasn't bought a ~~car~~.**

**Has he bought a car?**

## **Use Present Perfect.**

She \_\_\_\_\_the dishes. (already, wash)

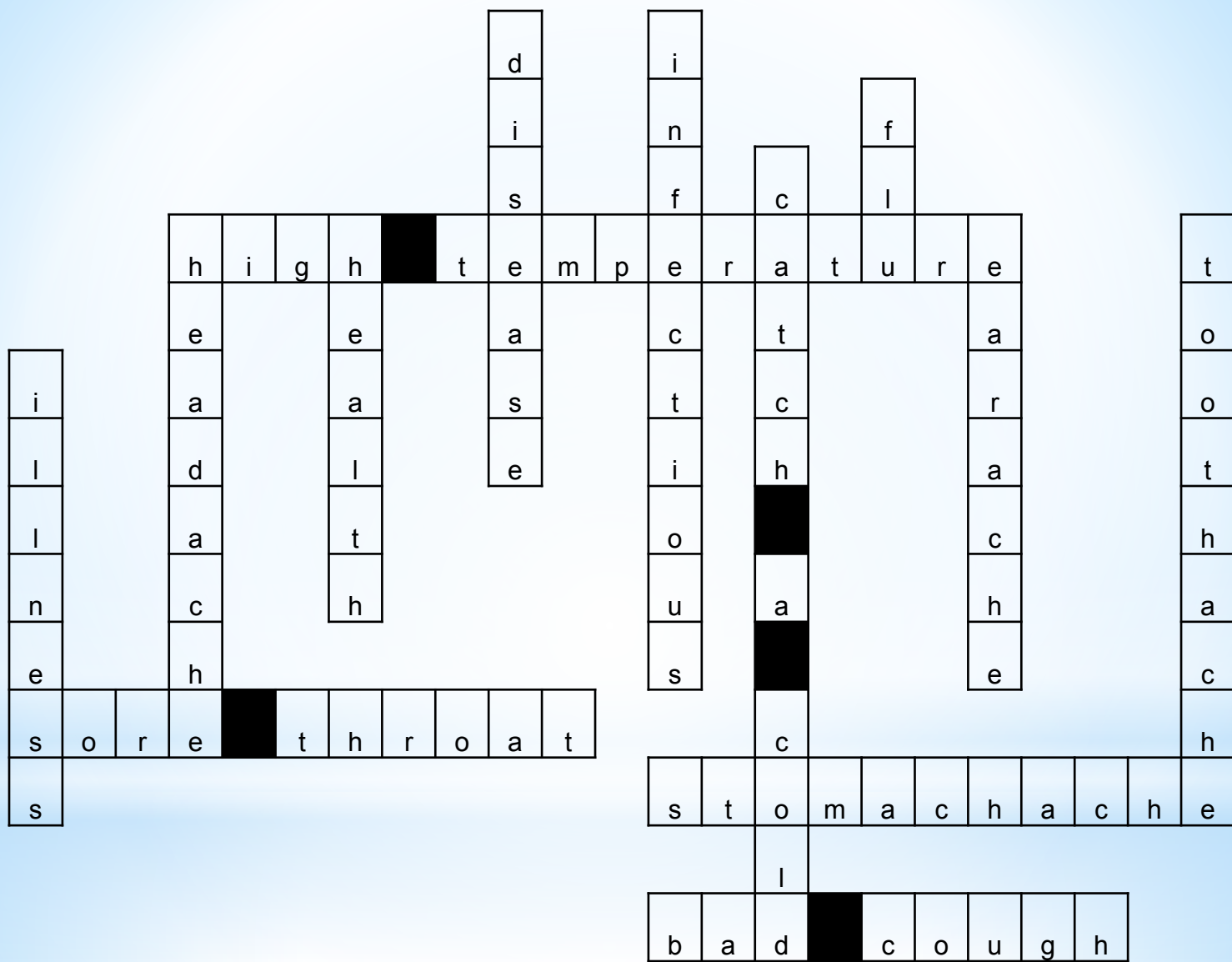
They \_\_\_\_\_their teeth. (just, clean)

Tom and Jess \_\_\_\_\_this film. (recently, see)

I \_\_\_\_\_ a letter to my friend. (already, write)

My cousin \_\_\_\_\_ his book. (not find).
