



#### **Present Perfect Tense**







The Past Simple Tense обозначает действие, произошедшее в прошлом и не имеющее отношения к настоящему.



#### PAST SIMPLE

Yesterday, last, ago, the day before yesterday, in 1960

He played football yesterday.

He didn't play football
yesterday.

Did he play football yesterday?

He bought a car yesterday.

He didn't buy a car yesterday.

Did he buy a car yesterday?

#### PRESENT PERFECT

Ever, never, just, recently, already, yet, for, since, today

He has just played football.

He hasn't played football.

Has he played football?

He has bought a car.

He hasn't bought a ar.

Has he bought a car?
