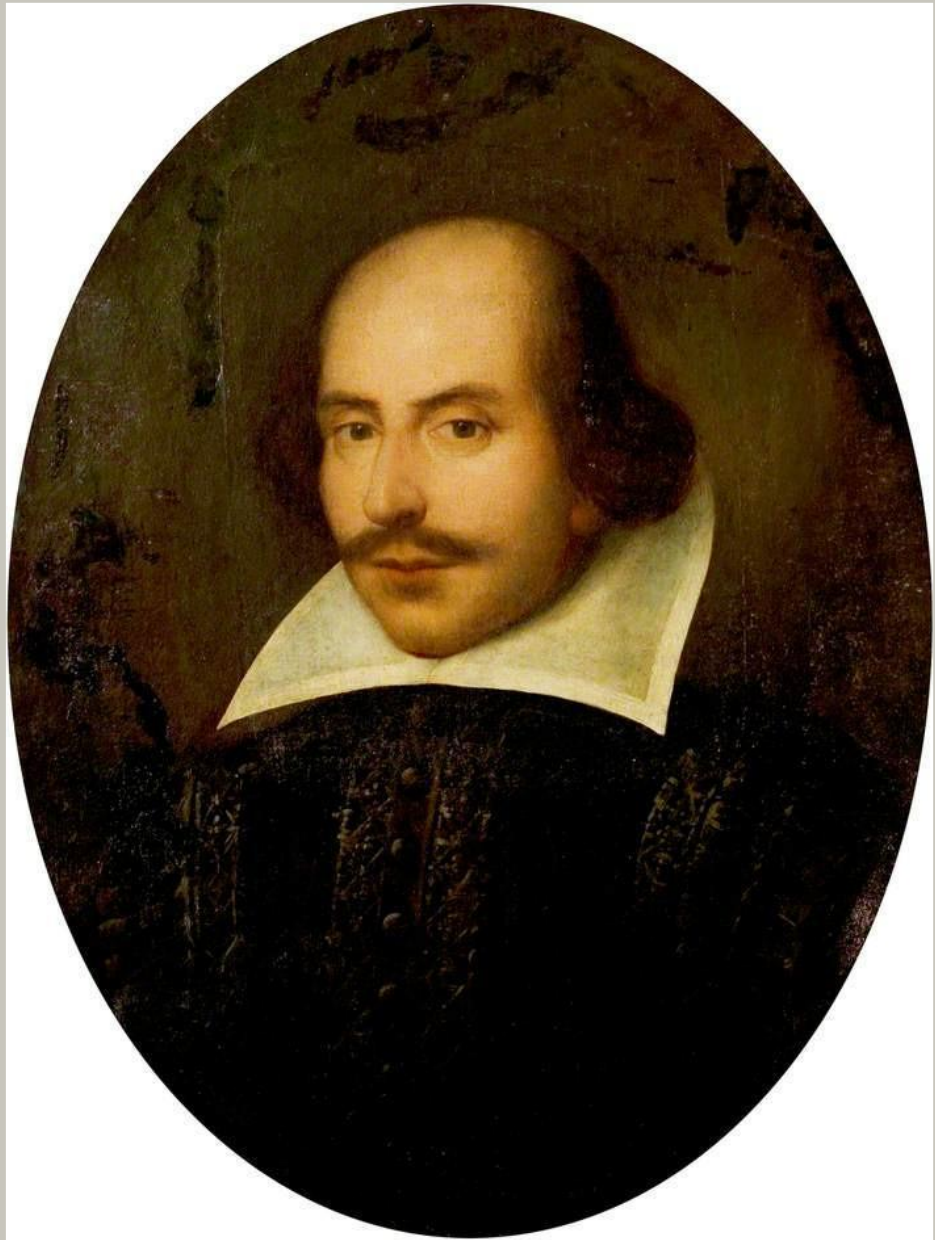

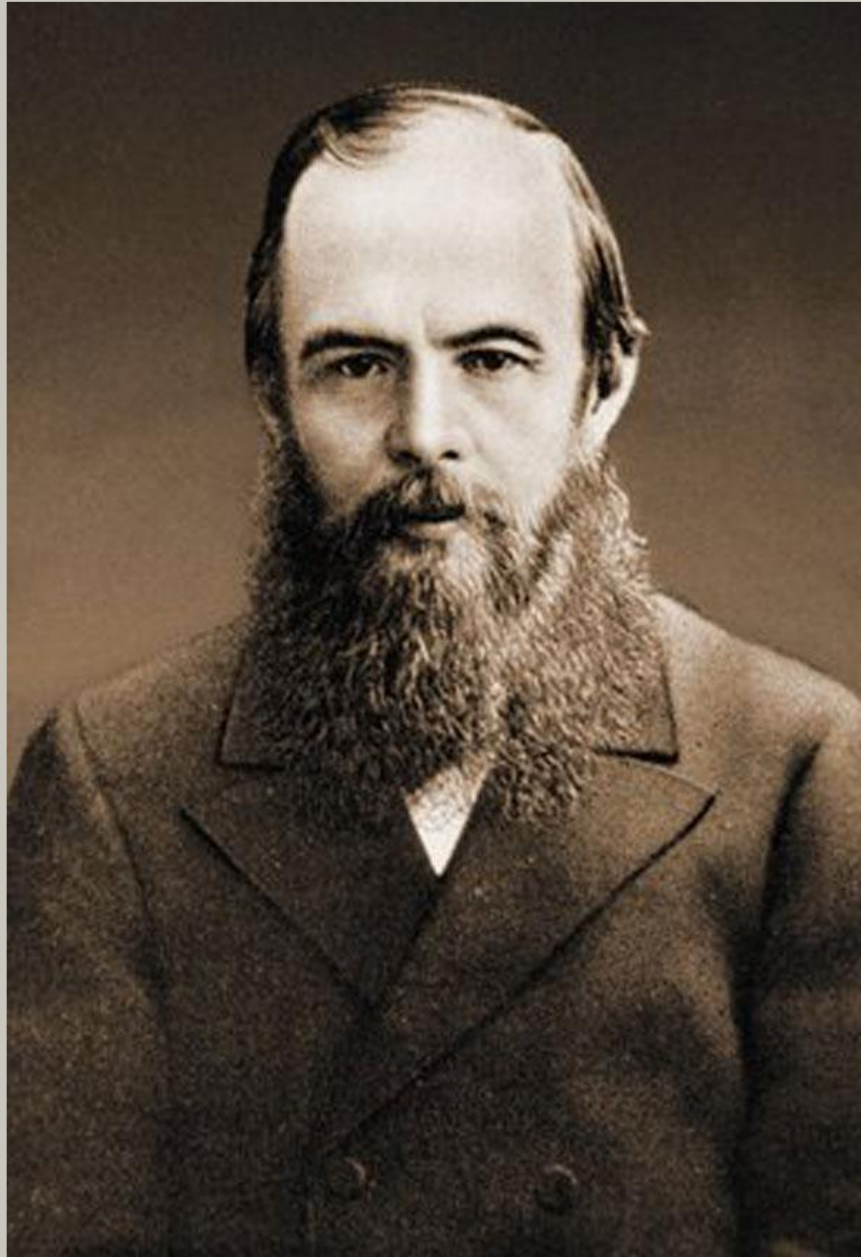
Irina Eduardovna Slutskaya

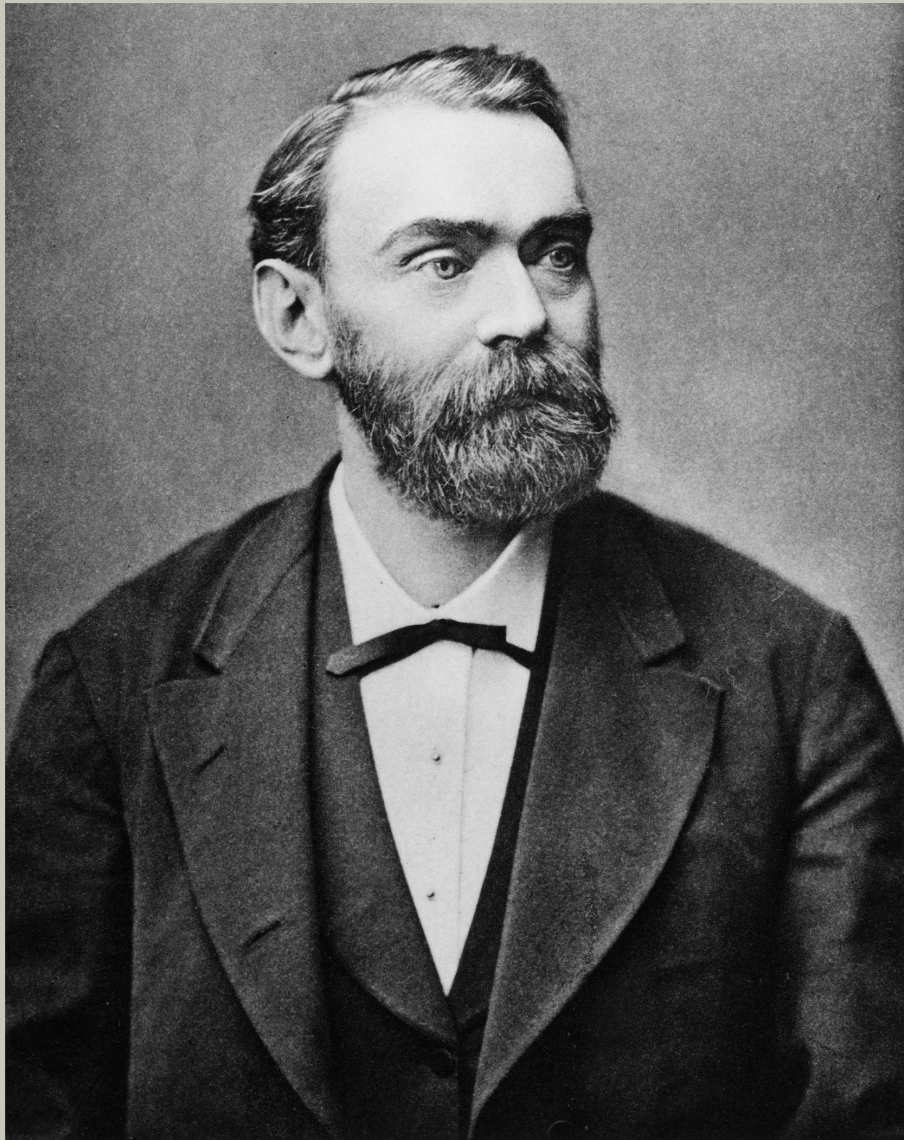

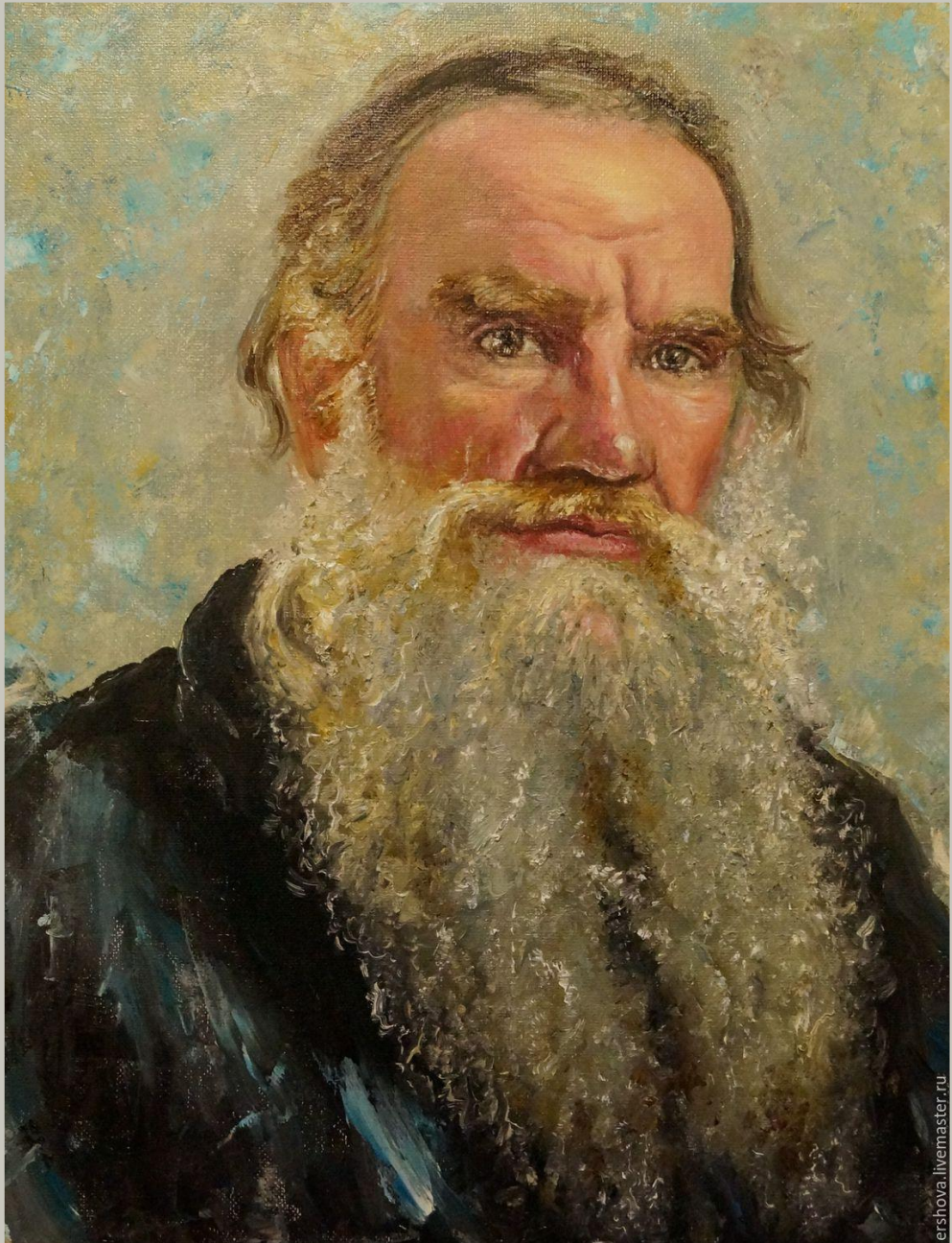
