Too much food makes you fat.

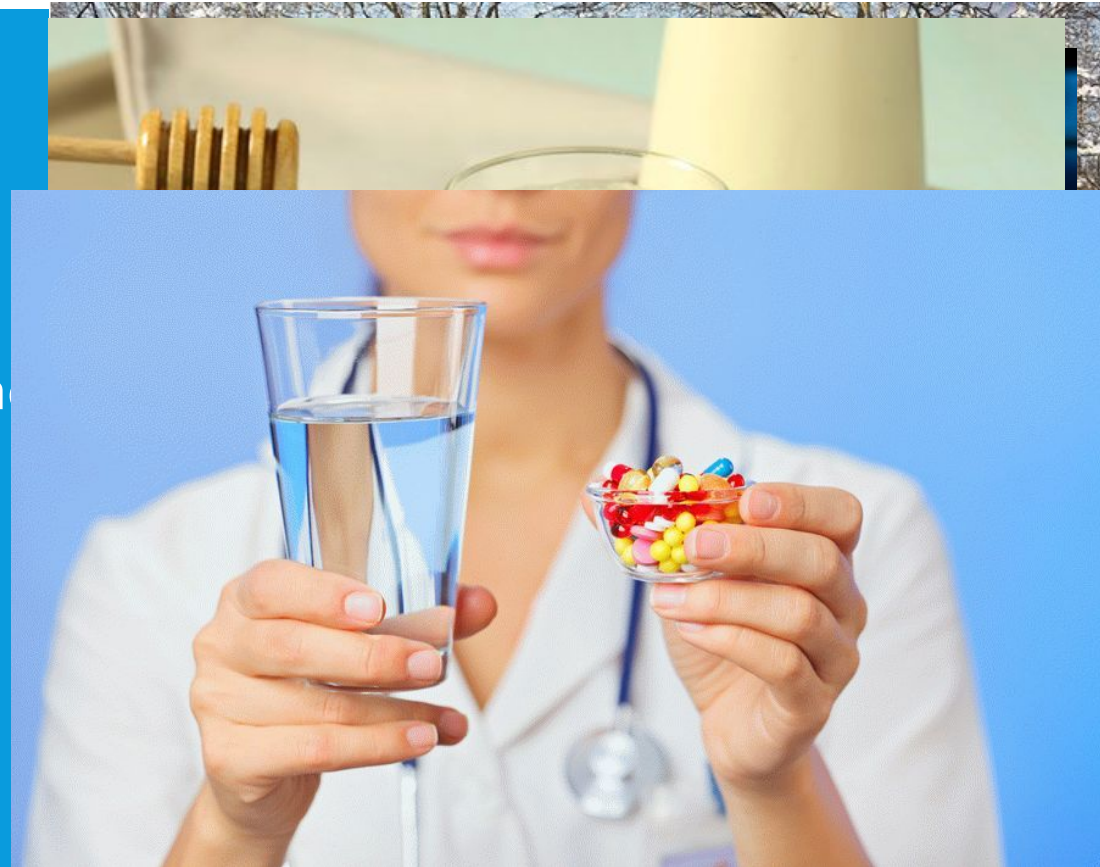

- Present Simple → Past Simple
- Present Progressive → Past Progressive
- Present Perfect → Past Perfect (have done → had done)
- Can → Could
- Future Simple → Future in the Past ( will → would)

<i>Direct Speech</i>	<i>Reported Speech</i>	<i>Examples</i>
<b>am/is are</b>	<b>was were</b>	She said: "Pete <b>is reading</b> ." She said Pete <b>was reading</b> . Tom said: "They <b>are friends</b> ." Tom said they <b>were friends</b> .
<b>have/has</b>	<b>had</b>	I said to Dolly: "Bob <b>has got a dog</b> ." I told Dolly Bob <b>had got a dog</b> . Nelly said to Tim: "I <b>have done it</b> ." Nelly told Tim she <b>had done it</b> .
<b>can</b>	<b>could</b>	Bob said to Fred: "I <b>can't swim</b> ." Bob told Fred he <b>couldn't swim</b> .
<b>do/does</b>	<b>did</b>	I said: "It <b>doesn't snow here</b> ." I said it <b>didn't snow here</b> .
<b>V play</b>	<b>V(ed)/V<sub>3</sub> played</b>	Mary said to Harry: "We <b>play</b> basketball in the gym." Mary told Harry they <b>played</b> basketball in the gym.
<b>write</b>	<b>wrote</b>	Greg said: "I <b>write</b> letters very seldom." Greg said he <b>wrote</b> letters very seldom.

Carol said: "We **shan't** arrive at 5."

Carol said they **wouldn't** arrive at 5.

Phil asked Mary: "**Will** you go shopping?"

Phil asked Mary if she **would** go shopping.

**tomorrow**            **the next day**

**in 2 days**            **2 days later**

**in 3 weeks**            **3 weeks later**

**in 5 months**            **5 months later**

**next day**            **the next day, the following day**

**this**            **that**

**now**            **then**

Peter said: "We shall start **in 2 weeks.**"

Peter said they would start **2 weeks later.**

Ann asked: "What will you do **next Friday?**"

Ann asked what I should do the **following Friday.**

Bill asked: "Why will she come **tomorrow?**"

Bill asked why she would come **the next day.**
