

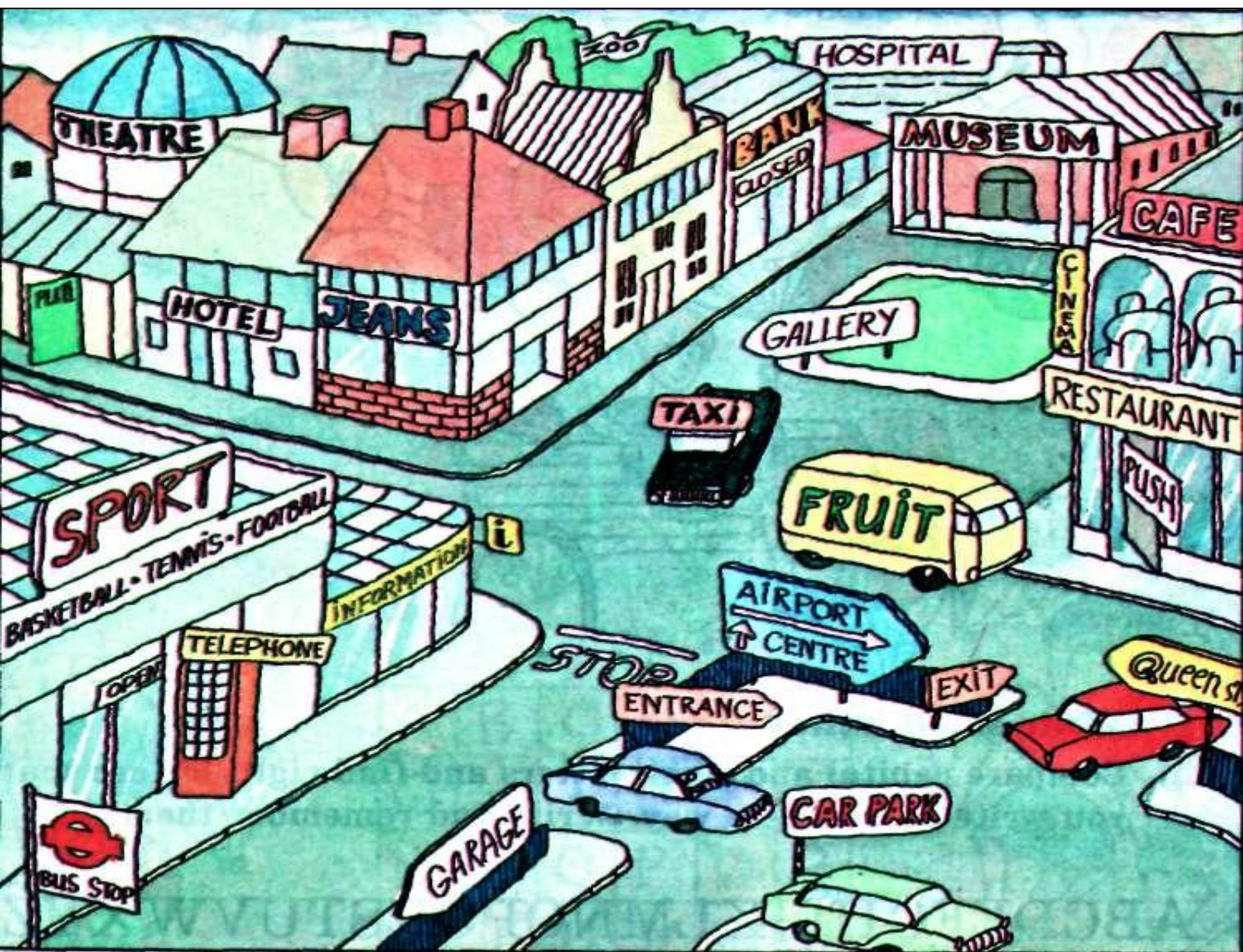

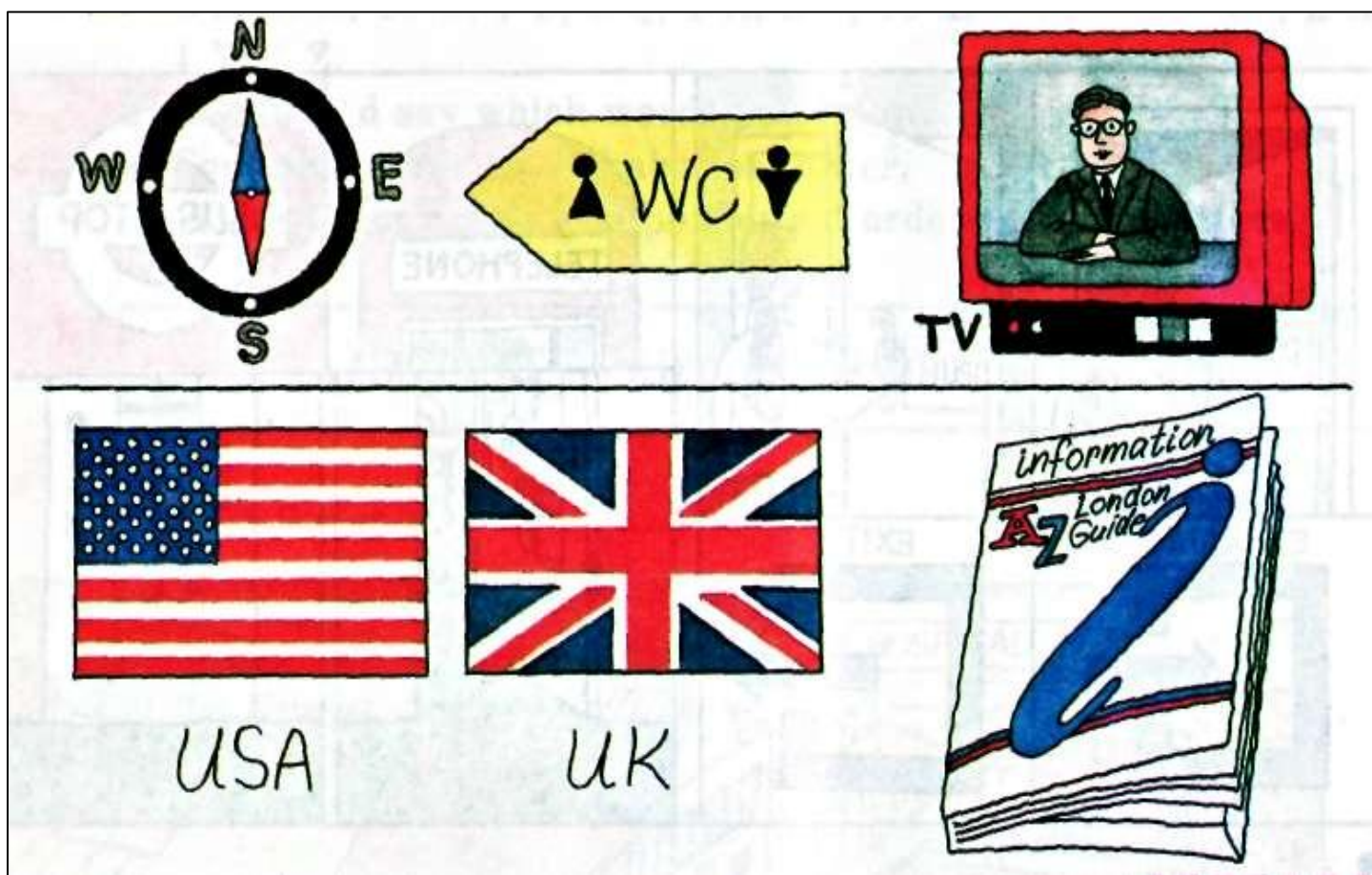
Догадайтесь о значении подчеркнутых слов.

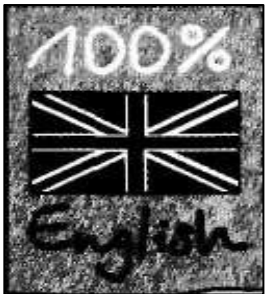
В любом языке есть слова, которые представляют трудность для перевода. Это слова, обозначающие предметы или понятия, присущие одной определенной стране. Например: в русском языке — слово *пельмени*. В Англии таких блюд нет, поэтому перевести это слово можно только путем его описания: *мясо в тесте*. Как правило, слова, обозначающие понятия, характерные для определенной культуры, не переводятся, а просто заимствуются. Так в языках всего Мира появились слова: *самовар, спутник, борщ*, пришедшие из русского языка.

Teenager — тинэйджер, *дословно* подросток в возрасте от 13 до 19 лет.



Hooligan - хулиган.

Слово произошло от английской фамилии Hooley. В 1890—1900 годах в городе Ислингтон человек по фамилии Hooley был главарем уличной банды. Из-за этой фамилии полиция называла членов банды *Hooley* хулиганами (*hooligans*).



Goalkeeper — голкипер.

Это слово состоит из двух слов: *goal* (ворота) и *keeper* (хранитель), дословно — хранитель ворот.

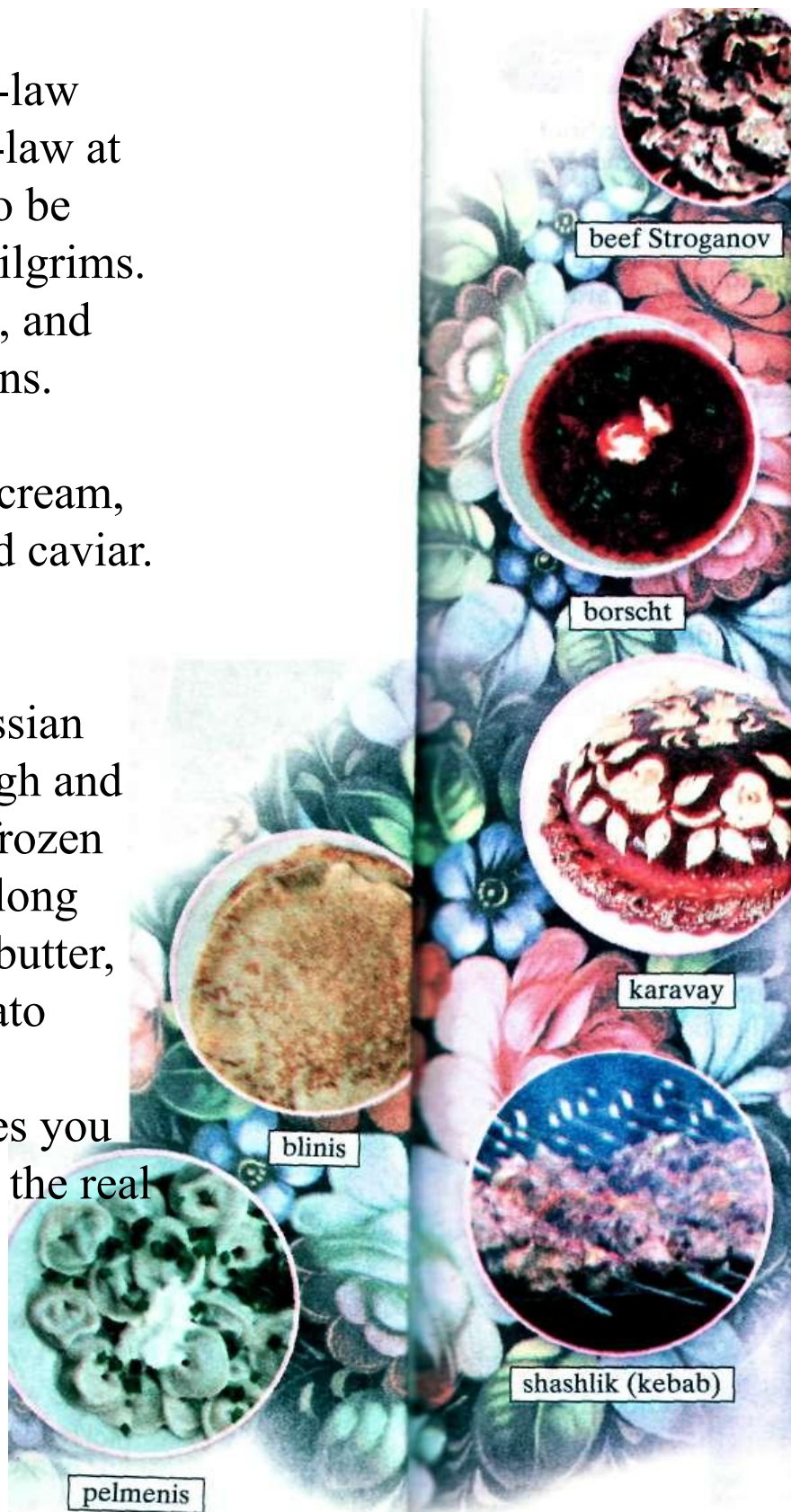
