It is a charity organization which raises money and helps children in Britain and all over the world

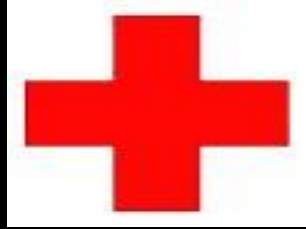


Save the Children
