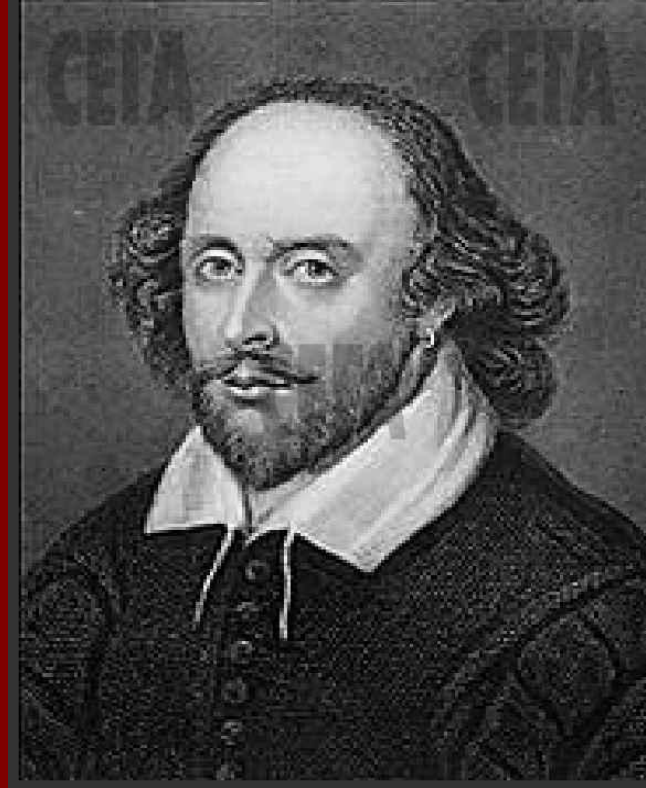
BIOGRAPHY

- ◆ Anne was 26, he was 18
- ◆ 3 children
- ◆ The youngest, Hamnet died at the age of 11

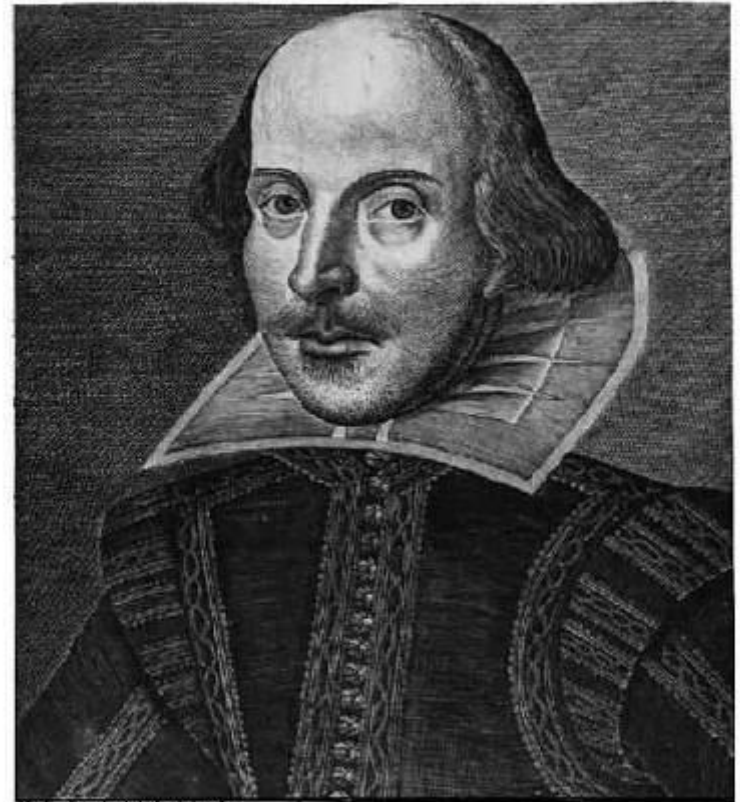



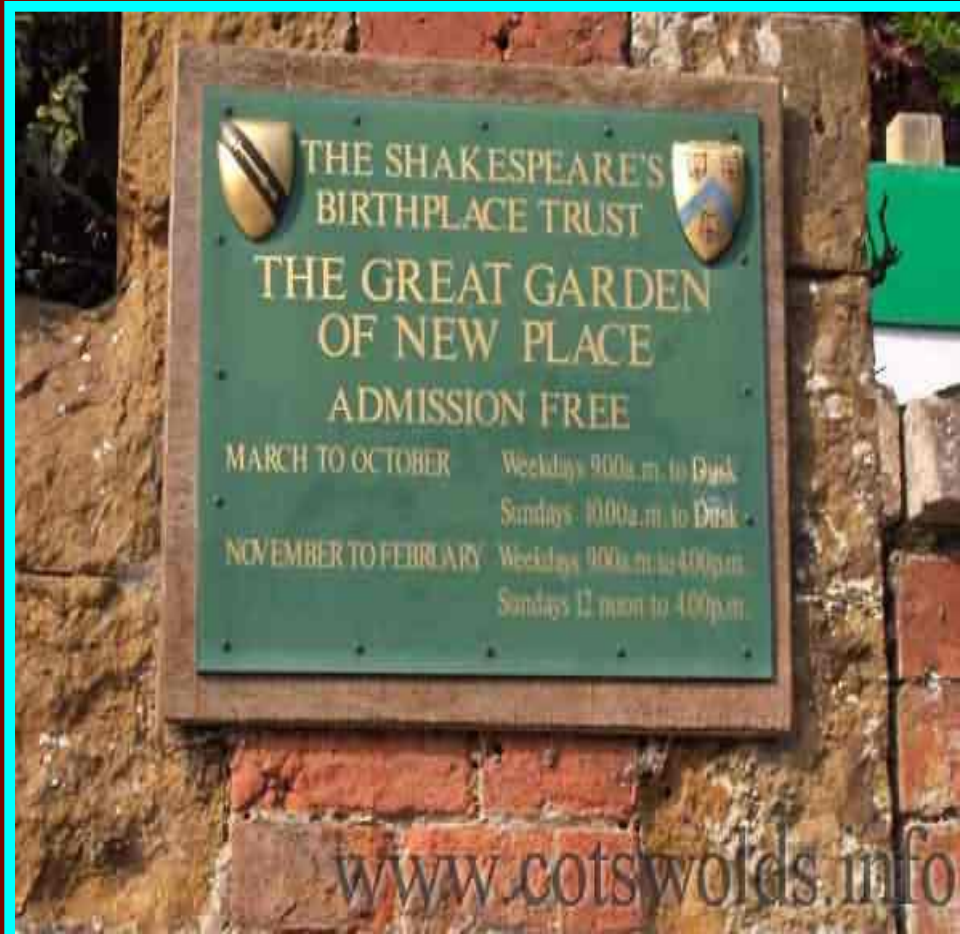

The end of his life

- ❖ Returned to Stratford in 1610
- ❖ In 1616 Shakespeare died on April, 23 (his birthday)
- ❖ Was buried in Holy Trinity Church, where he was christened

AFTER WILLIAM SHAKESPEARE'S DEATH THERE WAS MUCH TALK ABOUT REMOVING HIS REMAINS FROM STRATFORD TO THE WESMINSTER ABBEY BUT THE IDEA WAS SOON ABANDONED.

- THOUGH WRITTEN MORE THAN 400 YEARS AGO, HIS PLAYS CONTINUE TO BE READ AND PERFORMED.





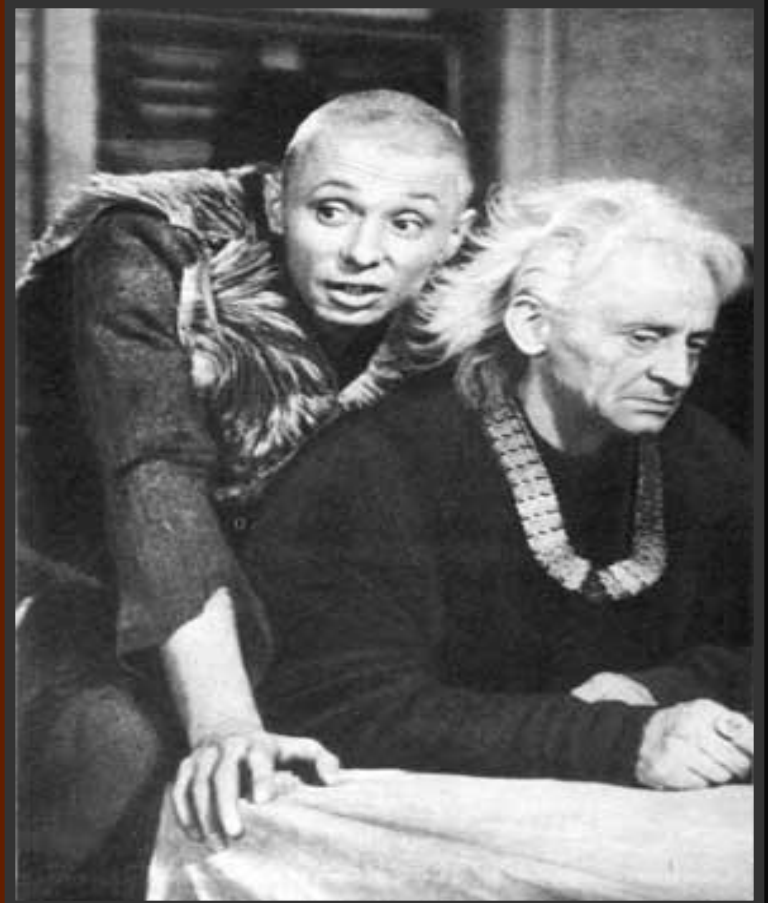
