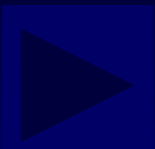

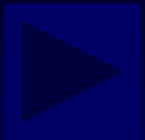

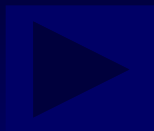

Isles.



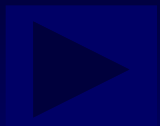

- The symbols of England is a rose.



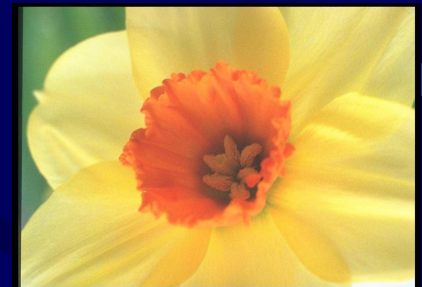
- The symbol of Scotland is a shamrock.



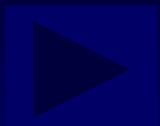
- The symbol of Ireland is a thistle.



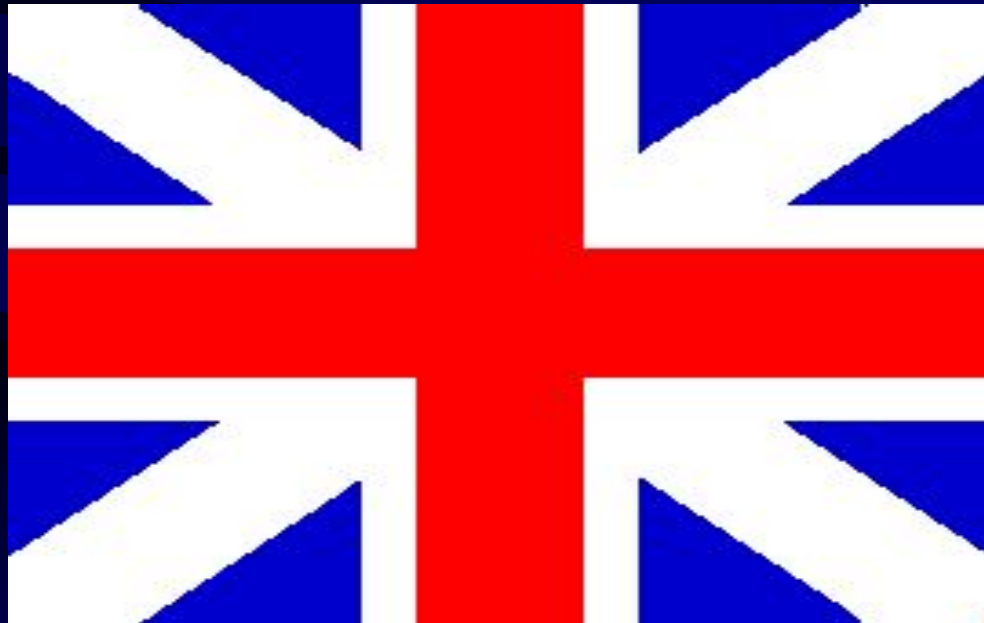
- The symbol of Wales is a daffodil.

United Kingdom?

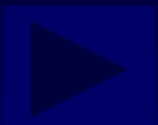


The flag of the United Kingdom is known as the Union Jack.





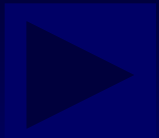

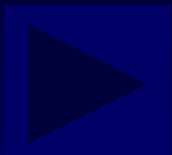

Ireland – Irish.



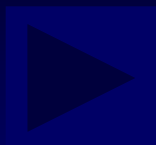

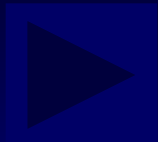


About 100,000

Scottish Gaelic.





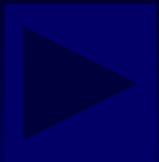

New Zealand.



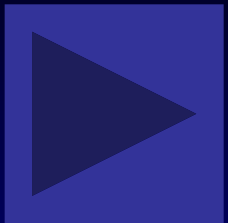

The Queen's name is Elizabeth.



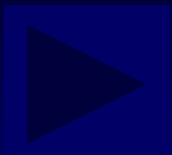

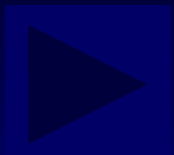


The Queen usually travels

places.





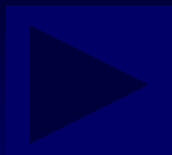

Buckingham palace.



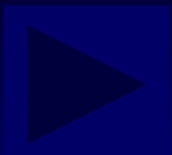

Commons.



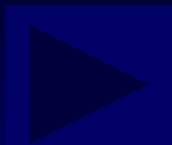
What does

Commons?

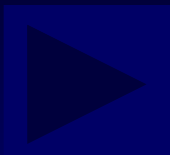


There are 650 members in the
