- In 1993 he enrolled at Stanford University in California, where he earned a master's degree and started working on his thesis. Already during his studyind, he became interested in the technology and Internet search engines, he was the author of several studies on the extraction of information from large volumes of text and scientific data, wrote a program to process scientific texts.

- Brin and Page proved the fallacy of their ideas on the university search engine google.stanford.edu, developing its mechanism in accordance with the new principles. September 14, 1997 was registered the domain google.com. There followed attempts to develop ideas and turn it into a business. Over time, the project left the university and was able to assemble an investment for future development.
- Joint business grew, brought profits and even demonstrated enviable stability at the time of the collapse of the dot-com when ruined hundreds of other companies. In 2004, the names of the founders have been named by Forbes magazine in the list of billionaires.

In May 2007, Sergey Brin married Anne Wojcicki. Anna in 1996, graduated from Yale University with a major in biology and founded the company 23andMe. In late December 2008, Sergey and Anna had a son Benji, and at the end of 2011 - the daughter. In September 2013 the marriage fell apart.
