

Prefixes for negative adjectives

un + adjective

unkind, unable, unwise, unhealthy, unclean, unfaithful

in + adjective

incapable, inanimate, insane, indecent, indefinite, inactive

but "in" changes when it comes before "p", "m", "l" and "r":

im + adjective

impossible, impatient, impolite, immortal, immoral, immobile

il + adjective

illegal, illogical, illegible

ir + adjective irregular, irreverent, irreversible
