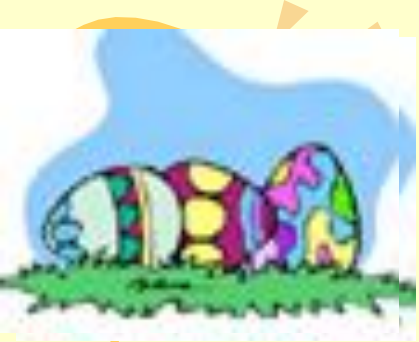


There are many holidays in Britain, on which different traditions are observed. One of such holidays is St. Valentine's day.
