5. Completing the gained knowledge on the topic with listening comprehension skills and proof of your own mind.

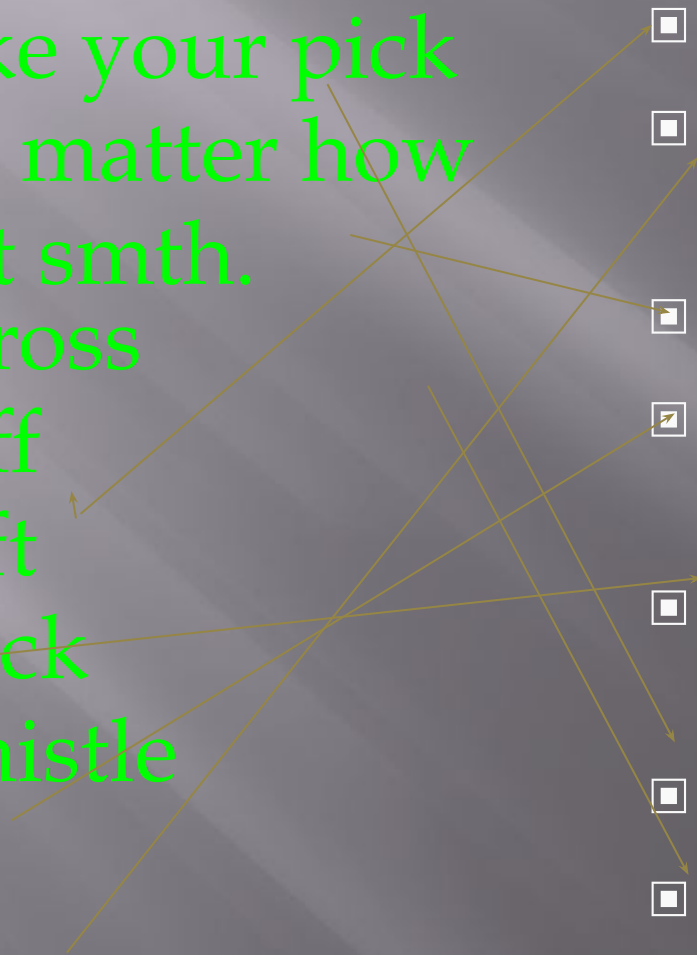

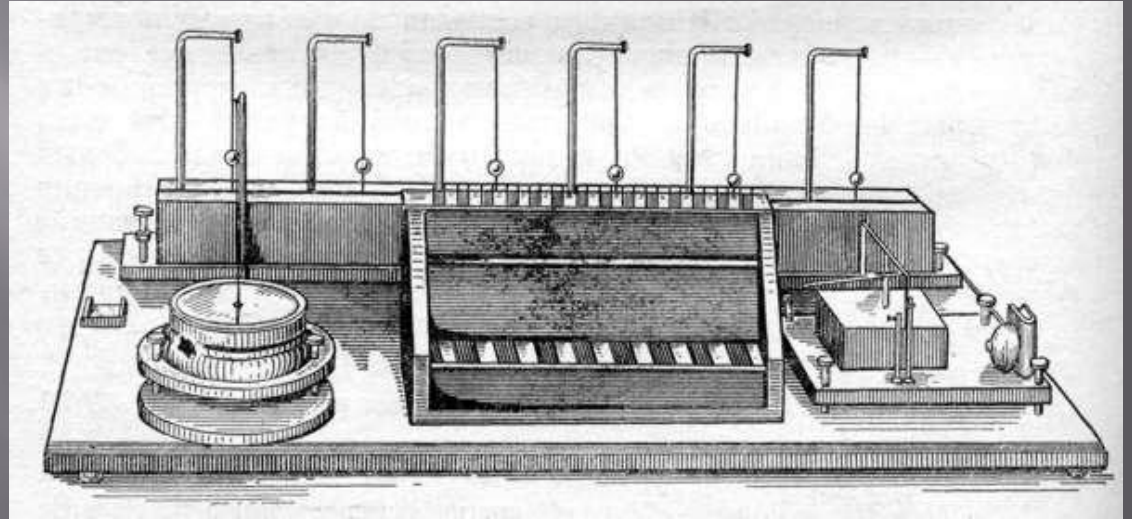

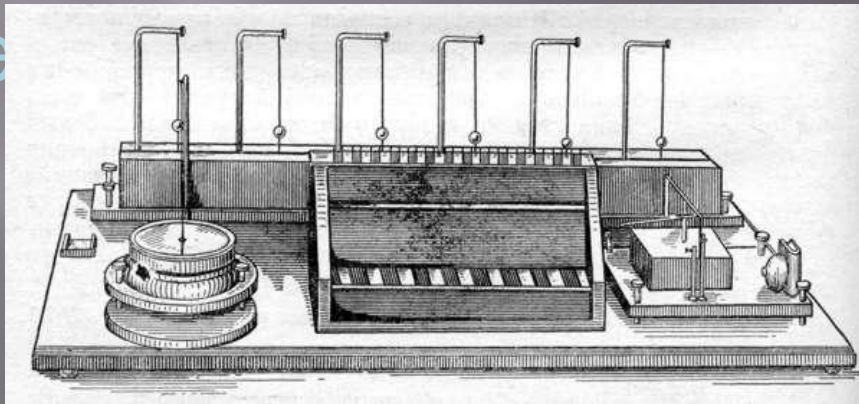
# TELEGRAPH

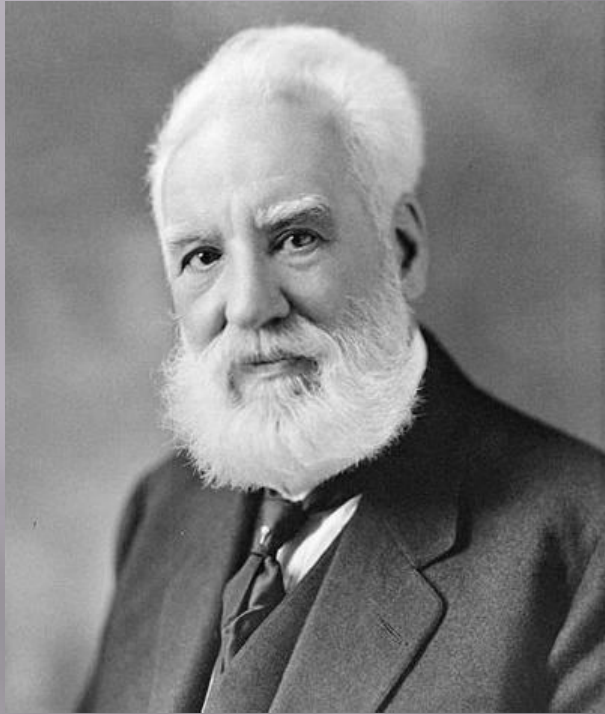

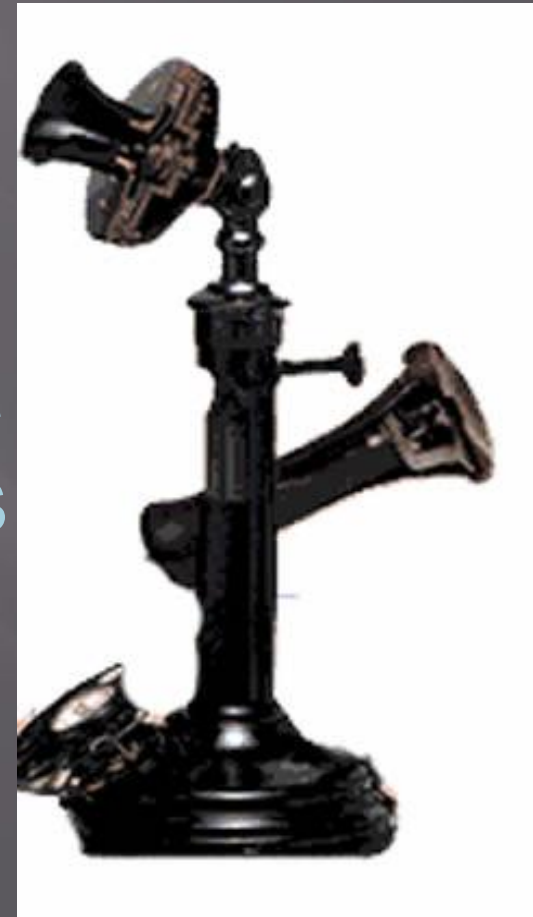

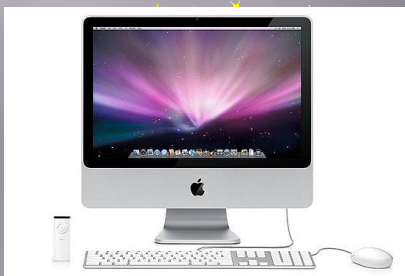
# Telephone station

# E-MAIL

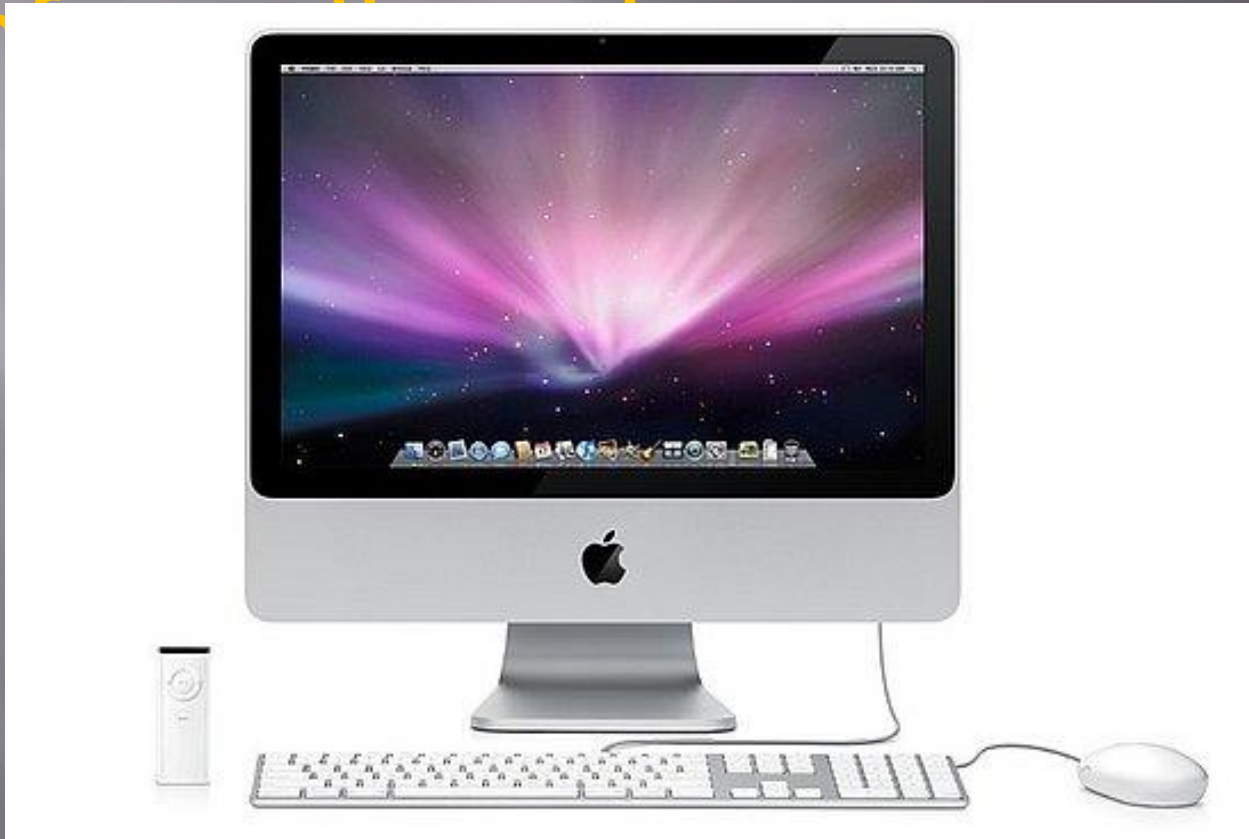
A method of using computer for composing, storing and receiving messages over electronic communication system





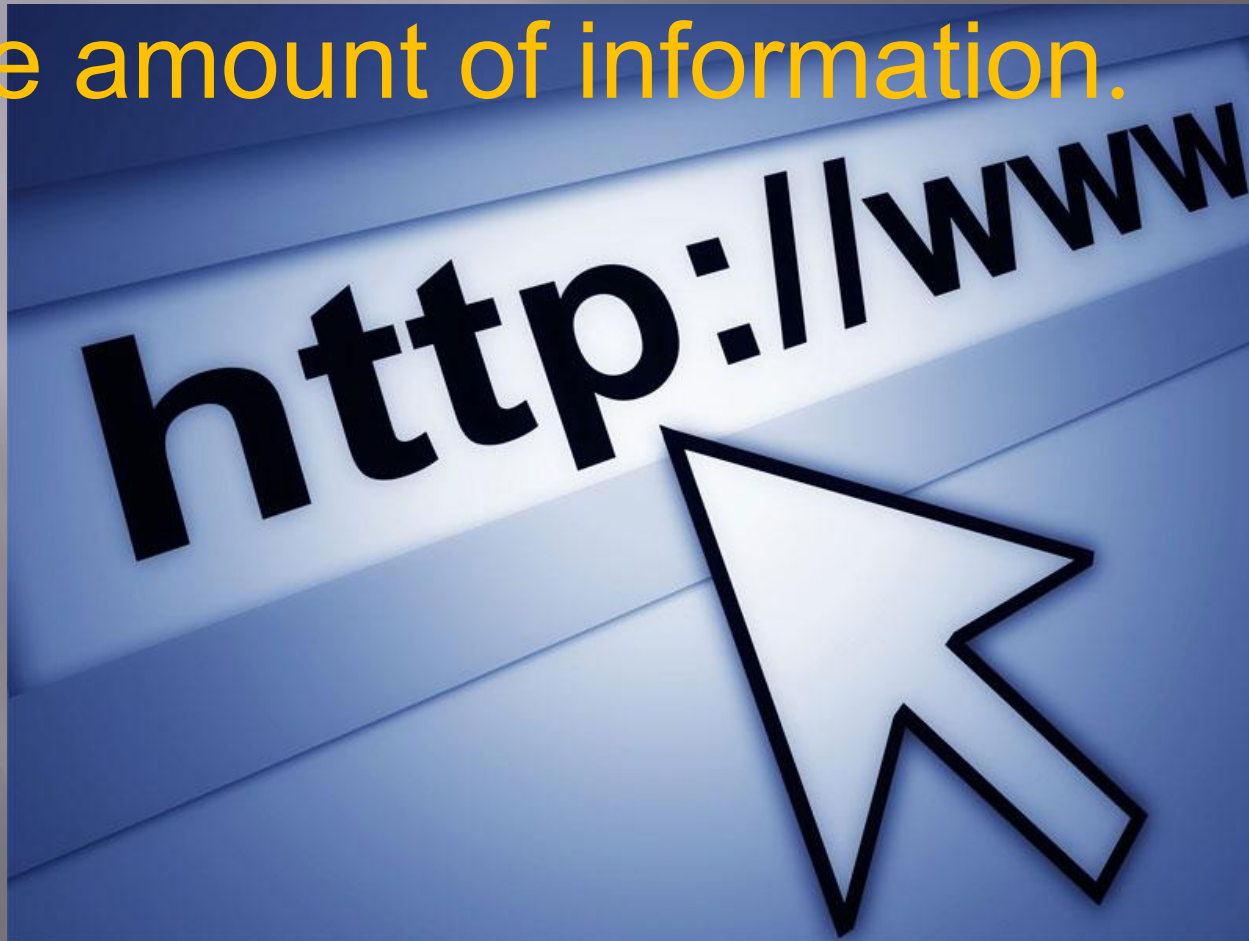
# COMPUTER

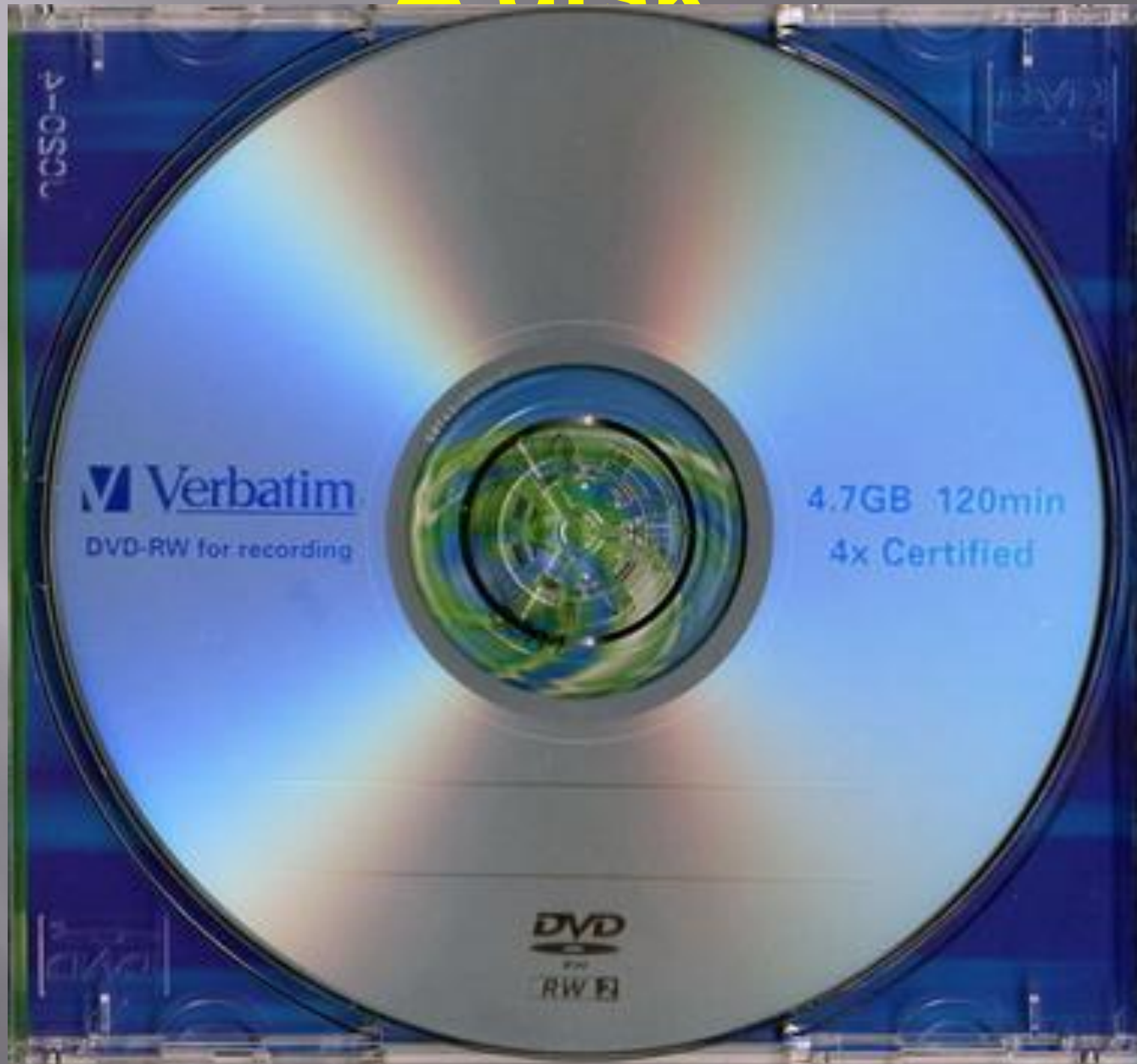
