• Past Simple

1. We watched this film *last Friday*.

2. I didn't watch the News *yesterday*.

3. Did you watch "The Mask" *last Friday*.

• Past Continuous

1. We were watching this film *last Friday from 5 to 9*.

2. I wasn't reading a book *yesterday at 5*.

3. Were you reading a book *from 5 to 9 last Friday?*

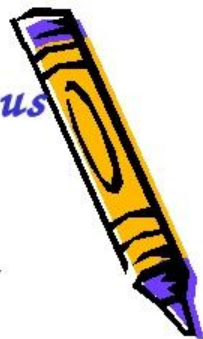

Yesterday at 5 I was reading a book.

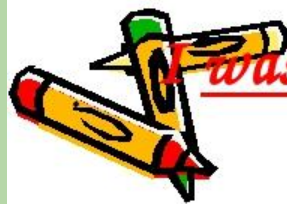

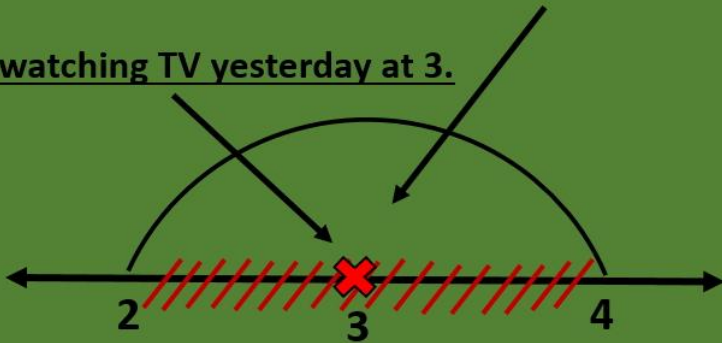
I was watching TV when you entered the room.

We were playing games yesterday from 2 till 4.

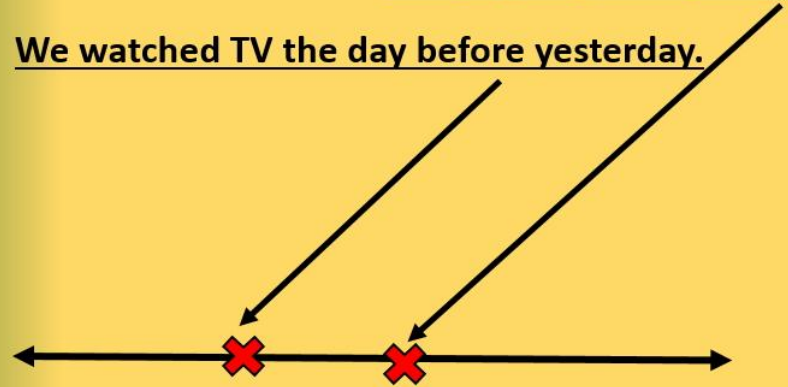
I was watching TV yesterday at 3.



Past Simple

We played games yesterday.

We watched TV the day before yesterday.

- David **fell** while he **was playing** football.
