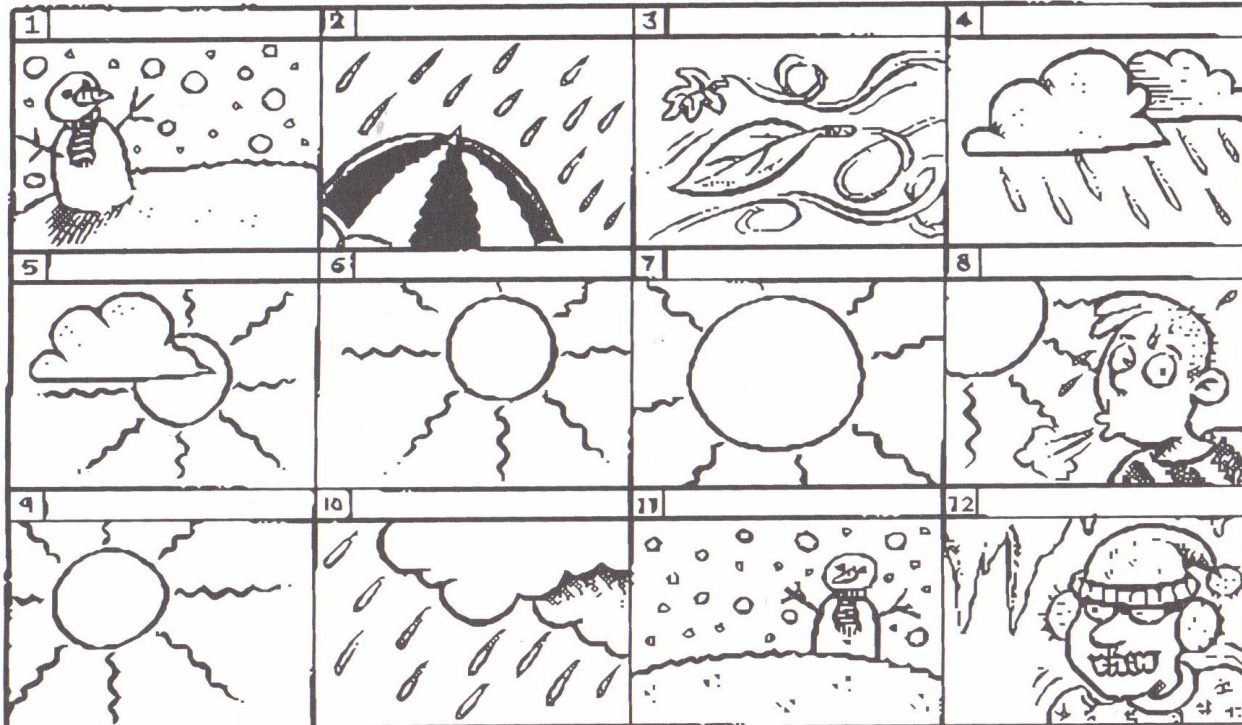

Future meaning (будущее действие) : to be going to ; Present Progressive Tense

1. Мы используем **to be going to**:

1) когда мы говорим о том, что мы собираемся (намереваемся) что-то сделать в будущем:

I **am going to** swim a lot.

Я **собираюсь** много **плавать**.

2) когда обстоятельства подсказывают нам, что обязательно, неизбежно произойдет в будущем:

It is clearing up. It **is going to** be sunny.

Проясняется. **Будет** солнечно.

(Обстоятельства подсказывают, что будет солнечно, так как исчезают облака.)

2. Мы используем **Present Progressive Tense**, когда мы описываем будущие действия, которые заранее спланированы и подготовлены:

We **are visiting** Brighton next weekend.

Мы **посетим** Брайтон в следующие выходные.

(Поездка в Брайтон состоится, так как она запланирована, билеты куплены.)

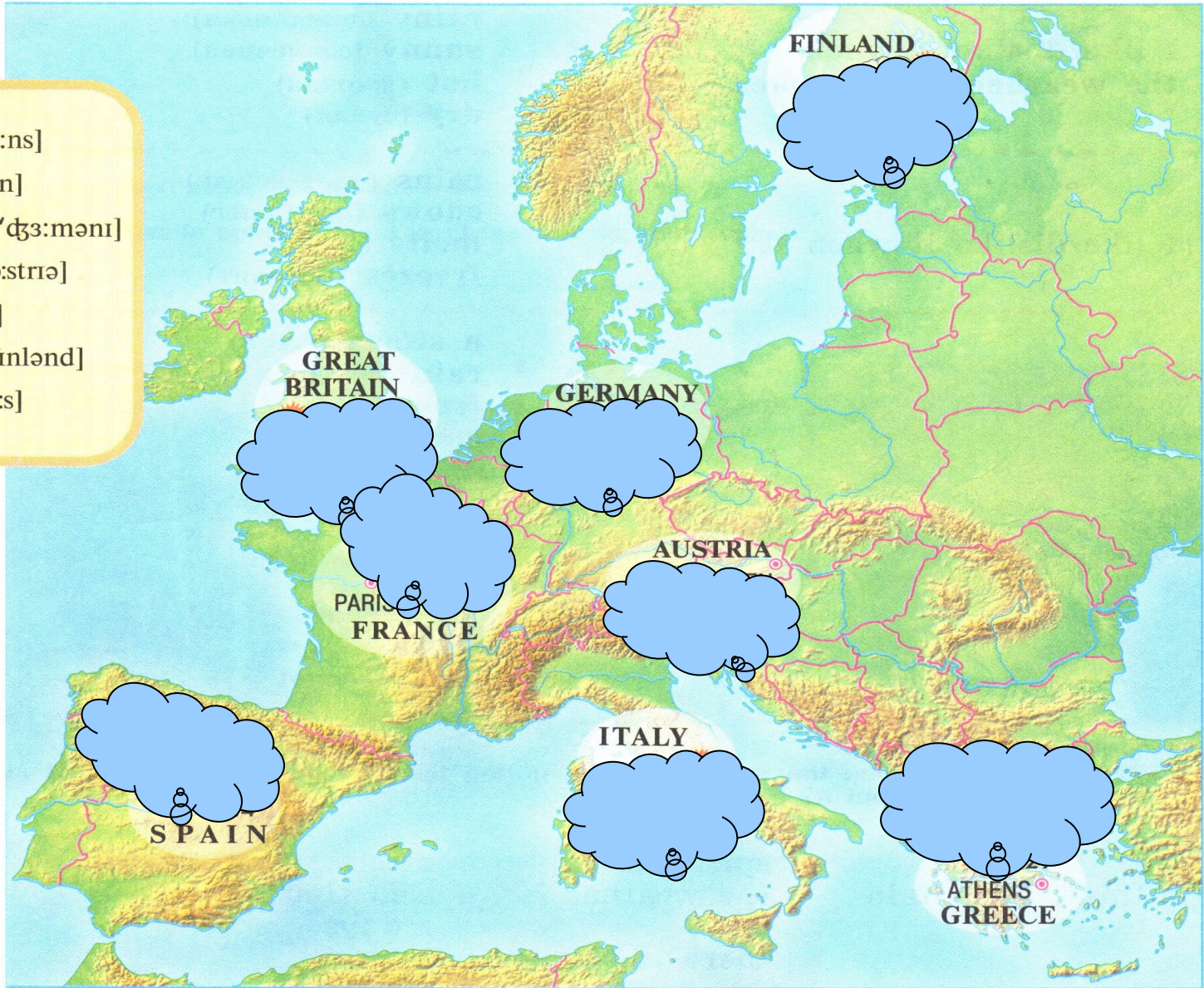
