She was the third in line to the throne after her uncle (later Edward VII) and her father. She became queen on 6 February 1952.

Buckingham Palace is her official London home.

At present the British royal family is headed by **Queen Elizabeth**. The marriage of the Princess Elizabeth to Philip, Duke of Edinburgh took place in November 1947.



The Queen's husband **Philip**, Duke of Edinburgh, was born in 1926 and served in the Royal Navy. He takes a great deal of interest in industry, in the achievements of young people (he founded Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme in 1956) and in saving rare wild animals from extinction.
