go up

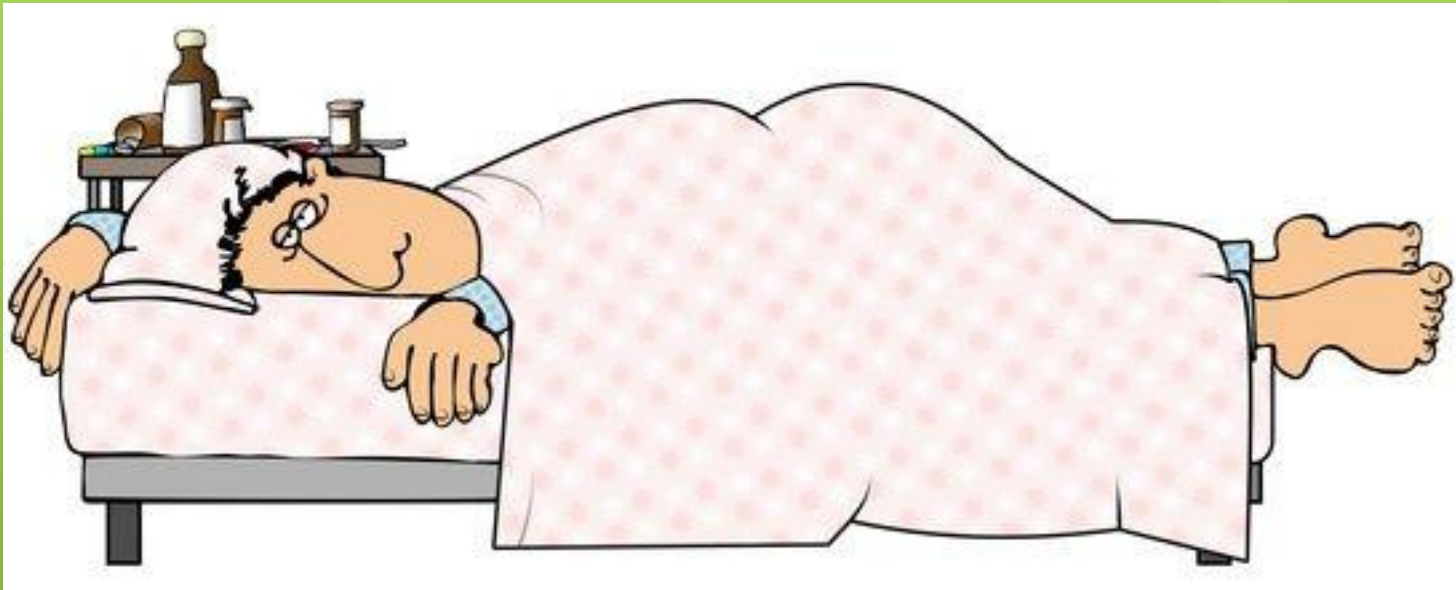

robber.



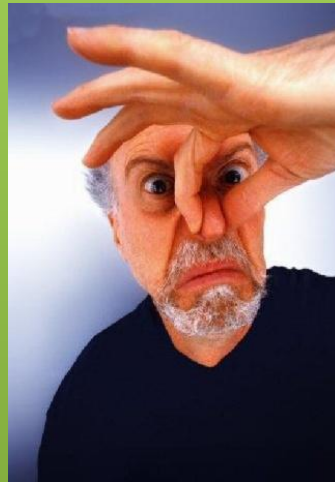
Go down with



Mary went down with the flu yesterday so she stayed in bed.

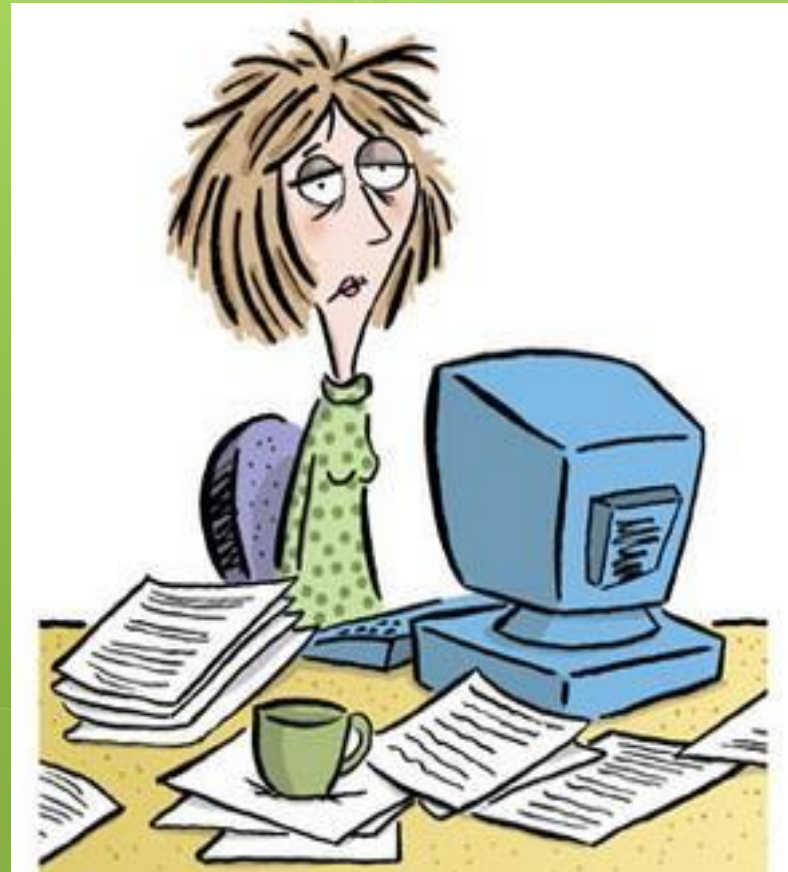
Go off
