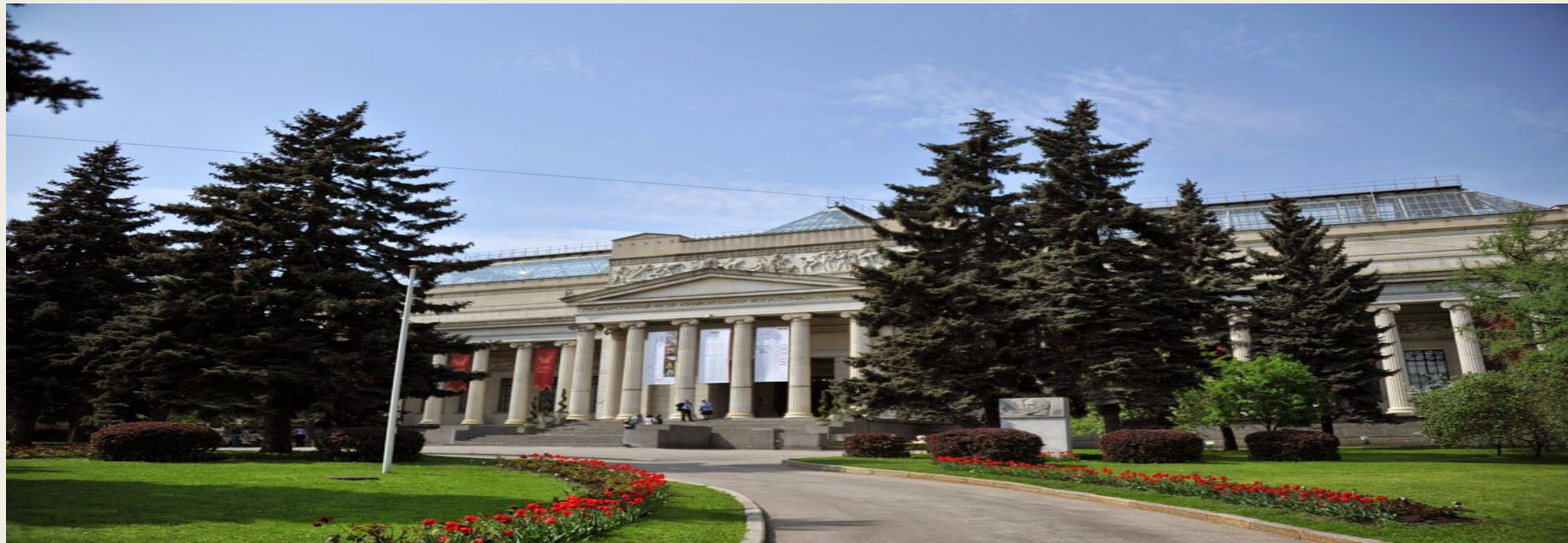


# THE PUSHKIN MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS

State Pushkin

The building was built in Greek style by Roman Klein in 1898-1912 to house a museum of fine art, founded by the initiative of professor Ivan Cvetayev. Since 1937 has been known as the Pushkin Museum of Fine Art.



It has one of the world's largest ancient collections of European art. Now the picture gallery has over 2 thousands works of various schools of painting.



# Why concrete this name, Pushkin Museum?

The name of Alexander Pushkin was given to the Museum in 1937, on the anniversary of the tragic death of the poet. Reasons for the renaming were a historical event.
