

MOZDOK is a small town in the South of Russia

. It is the administrative and economic centre of the Mozdok region of the North Ossetian Republic.



HISTORY

The name of Mozdok came from the Kabardinian "MEZ Daegu" - "deaf (dark) wood." To date, the floodplain forests Terek reduced. In 1759, the owner of Little Kabarda Kurgoka Konchokin moved from the cross nationals in the tract Mezdogu. Among immigrants were mostly Ossetians and baptized Kabardians, numbering over 100 people.

A Russian football goalkeeper Makhachkala "Anji" and the Russian national team.






