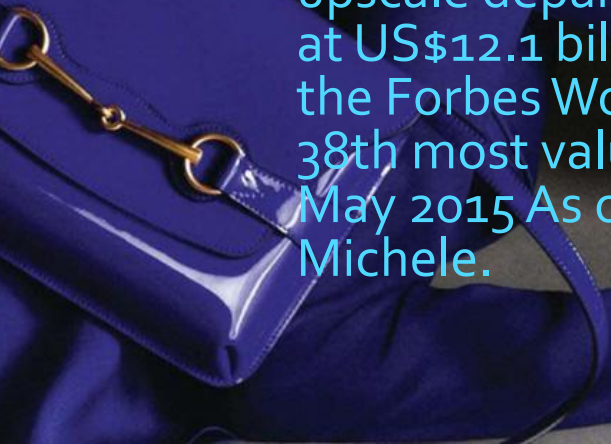

Gucci - is a luxury Italian fashion and leather goods brand, part of the Gucci Group, which is owned by the French holding company Kering. Gucci was founded by Guccio Gucci in Florence in 1921. Gucci generated about €4.2 billion in revenue worldwide in 2008 according to *Business Week* and climbed to 41st position in the magazine's annual 2009 "Top Global 100 Brands" chart created by Interbrand ; it ranked retained that rank in Interbrand's 2014 index. Gucci is also the biggest-selling Italian brand.[[] Gucci operates about 278 directly operated stores worldwide as of September 2009, and it wholesales its products through franchisees and upscale department stores. In the year 2013, the brand was valued at US\$12.1 billion, with sales of US\$4.7 billion. In the Forbes World's Most Valuable Brands list, Gucci is ranked the 38th most valuable brand, with a brand value of \$12.4 billion as of May 2015 As of January 2015, the creative director is Alessandro Michele.

Louis Vuitton

- *Louis Vuitton Malletier, commonly referred to as Louis Vuitton, or shortened to LV, is a French fashion house founded in 1854 by Louis Vuitton. The label's LV monogram appears on most of its products, ranging from luxury trunks and leather goods to ready-to-wear, shoes, watches, jewelry, accessories, sunglasses and books. Louis Vuitton is one of the world's leading international fashion houses; it sells its products through standalone boutiques, lease departments in high-end and through the e-commerce section of its website. For six consecutive years (2006–2012), Louis Vuitton was named the world's most valuable luxury brand. 2012 valuation was US\$25.9 billion. Year 2013 valuation of the brand was US\$28.4 billion with a sales of US\$9.4 billion. The company operates in 50 countries with more than 460 stores worldwide*

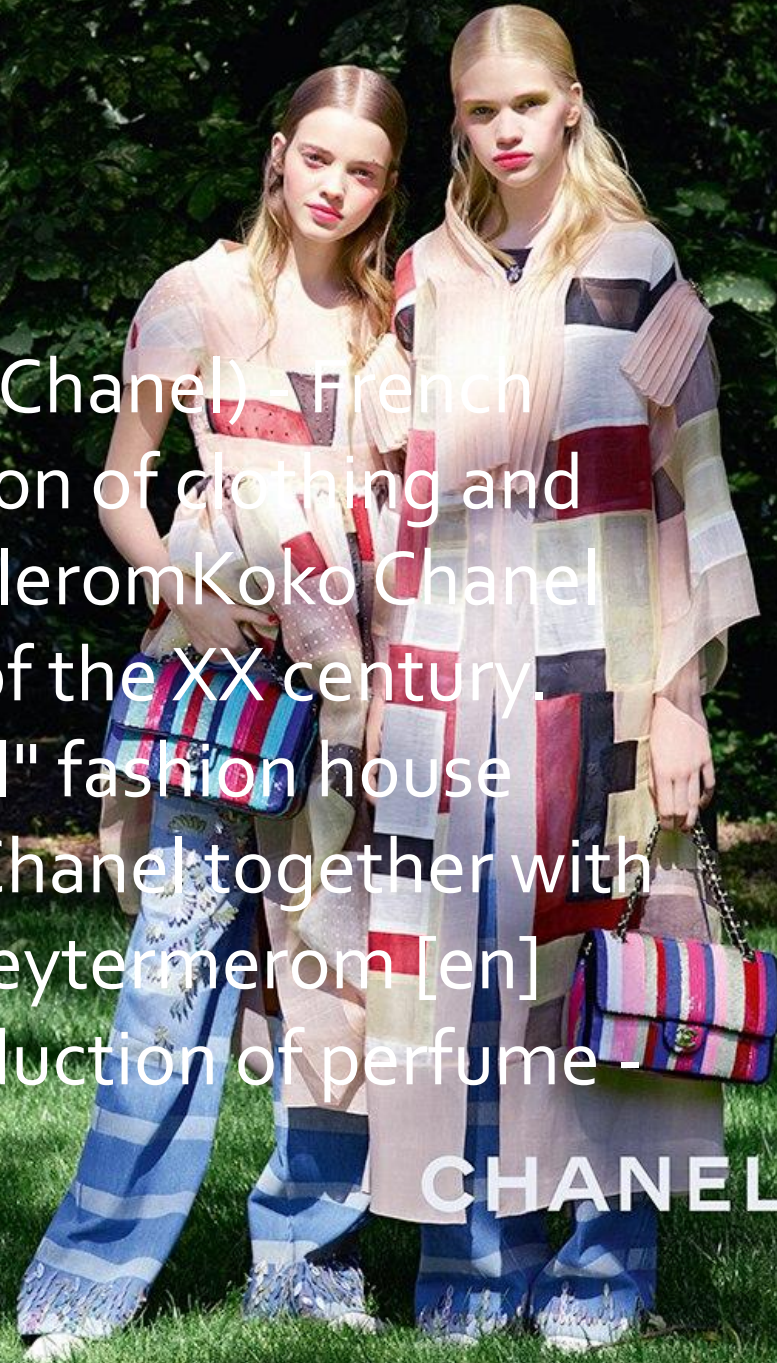

(Abbreviation of Versace, Versace's pronounced) - Italian company founded in 1978 by fashion designer Gianni Versace, the manufacturer of fashionable clothes, perfumes, watches, home furnishings, accessories and other luxury items. After Versace's death in 1997, concern the management passed to his younger sister, Donatella Versace. Company logo is a jellyfish Rondanini.

- Prada (Prada pronounced) - the famous Italian privately owned company specializing in the production of fashionable clothes, shoes and accessories, which owns the fashion house of the same name and trademark. Headquartered in Milane. Istoriya brand began in Milan in 1913, when Mario Prada - the founder of the brand, opened a small shop on the implementation of elegant travel bags. Using exotic soft skin of walruses, Mario managed to attract the attention of influential customers worldwide. Then the company was called «Fratelli Prada» («Prada Brothers»). In 1958, the management of the company has taken the daughter of Mario Prada - Louise.

Atelier of high fashion was opened in Paris in a family house on the Avenue Montaigne. [2] In February 1947, Dior was presented the first collection of women's clothing, American journalists nicknamed New Look, which has revolutionized the world of post-war fashion.
