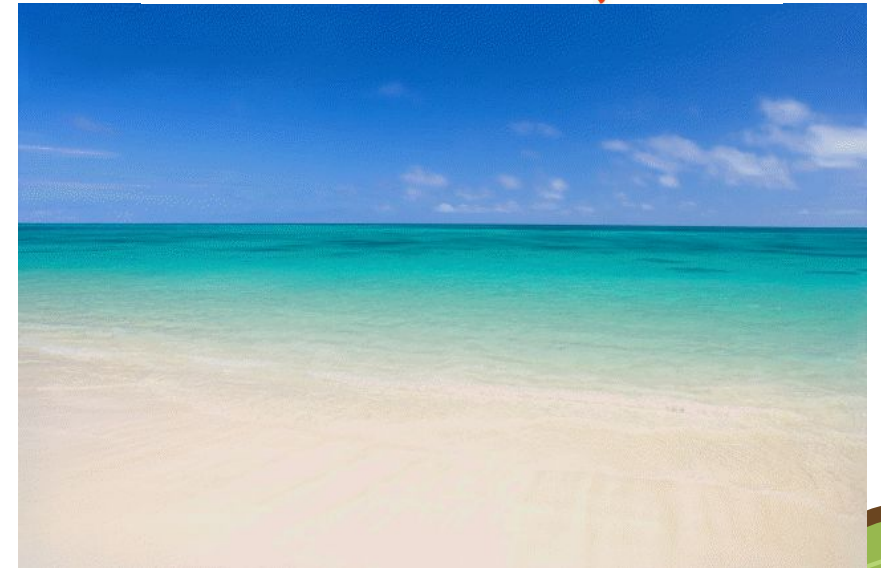
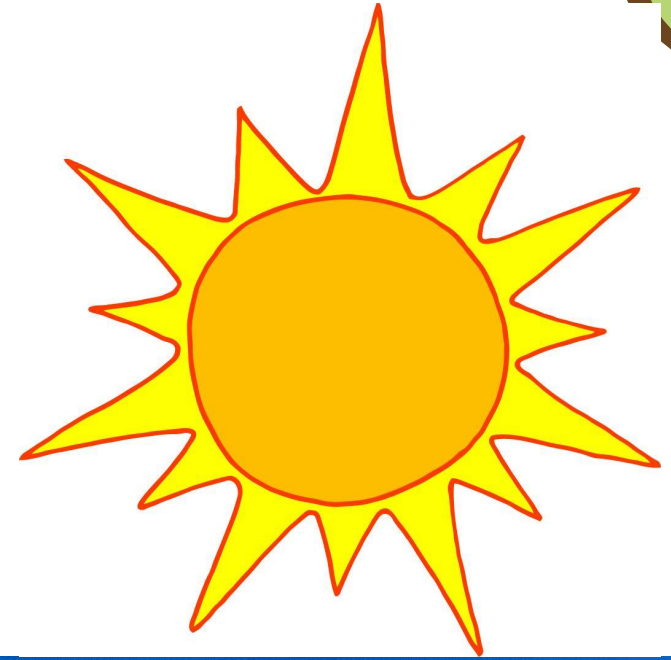


# At the Sea-Side

The cottage is not very big but over the summer my cousins also visit at other times so they have extra beds for visitors. My sister and I shared a bunk bed and we got up when the sun came up.

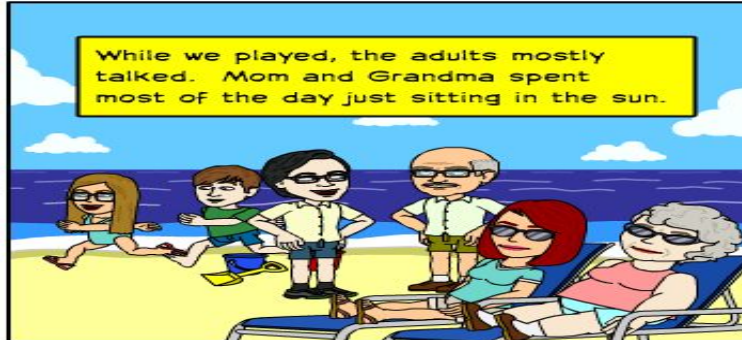
My grandmother made us all a big breakfast but we couldn't wait to go to the beach. We went after we ate but not before Mom put lots of sunblock on us.



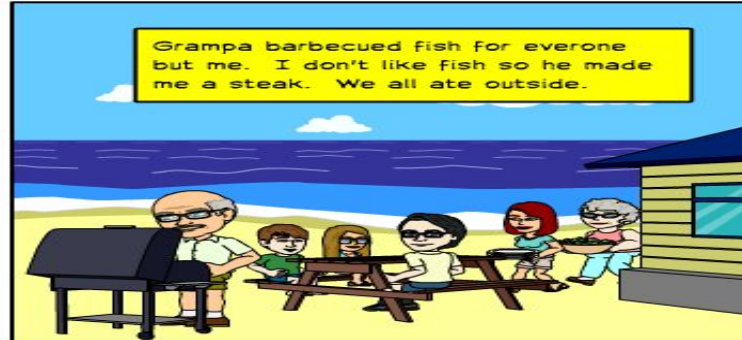
We swam and played in the sand all day. I collected things on the beach. At low tide, Grandpa, Dad and me looked for mussels and clams in the sand.



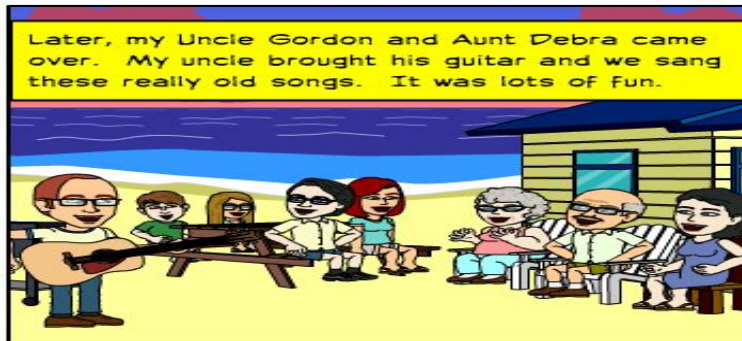
While we played, the adults mostly talked. Mom and Grandma spent most of the day just sitting in the sun.
