1. The Present Progressive Tense

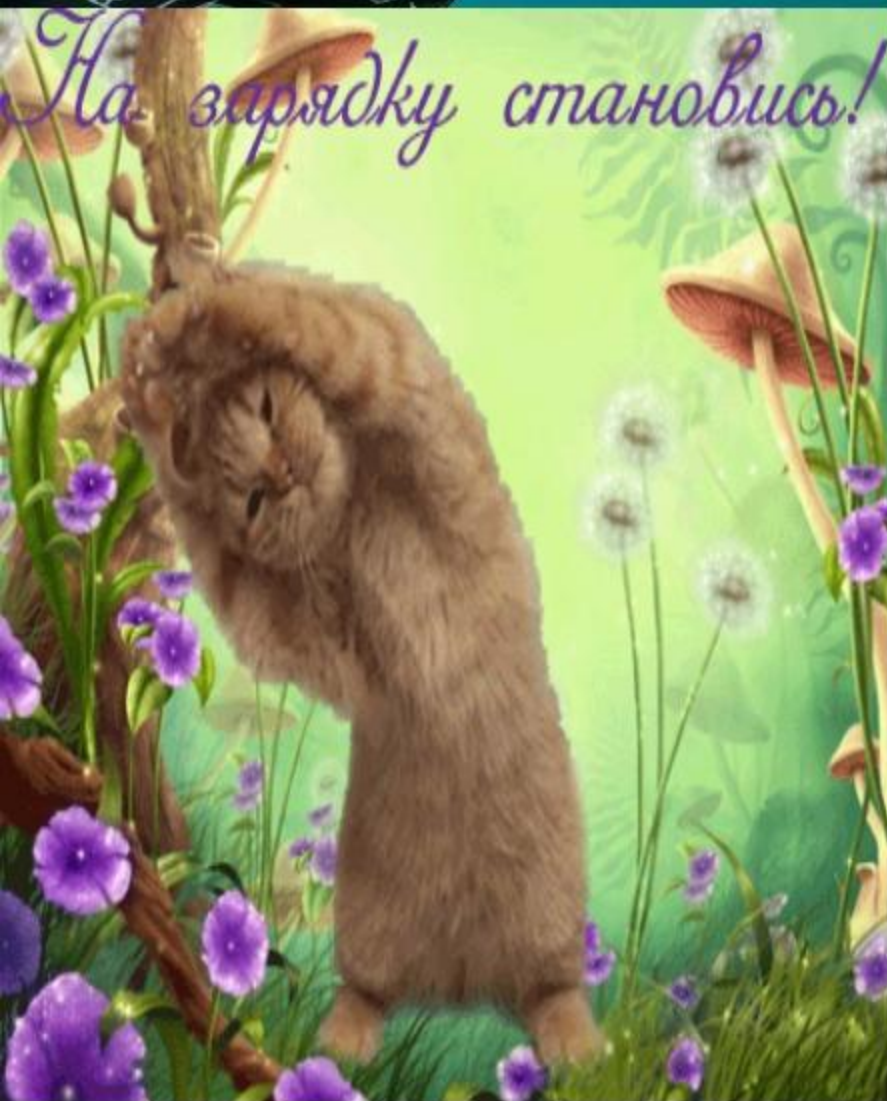
Present Progressive передает будущее событие, которое к моменту речи уже запланировано и произойдет в ближайшем будущем.

В этом значении *The Present Progressive* используется с глаголами движения или действия (*activity and motion*): *to see, to meet, to go, to come, to leave, to start*, и др. и обычно с обстоятельством времени, указывающим на будущее:

- **They're getting married in June.** — Они поженятся в июне.
- **We're leaving at 11.00 in the morning.** — Мы уезжаем в 11 утра
