

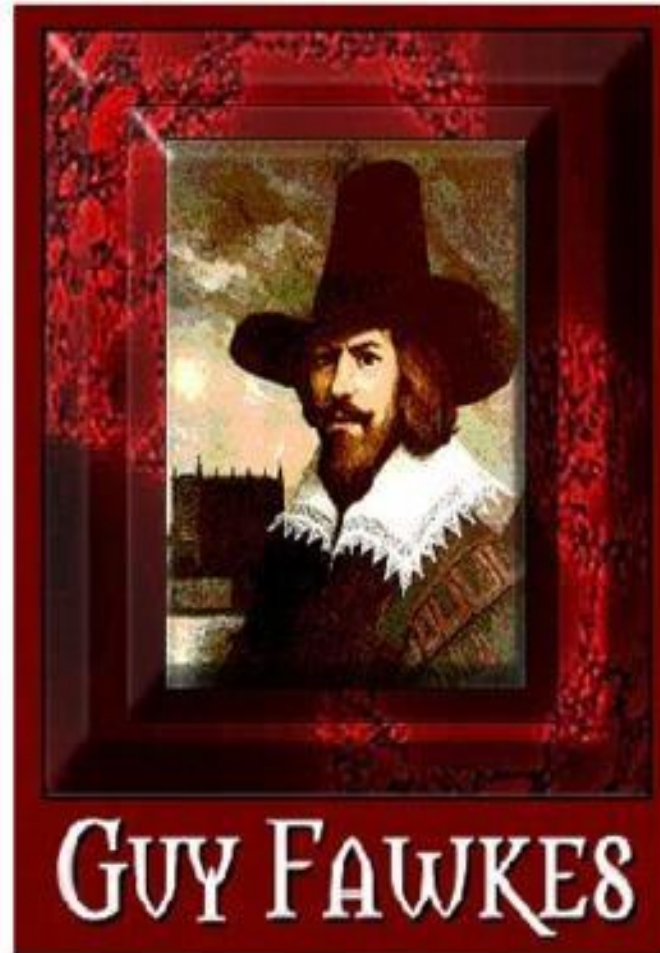

Guy Fawkes Day

Guy Fawkes was part of a gang which planned to blow up the Houses of the government in London in 1605. He was caught before he could light the gunpowder. On that day people watch a fireworks display.



Thanksgiving Day
