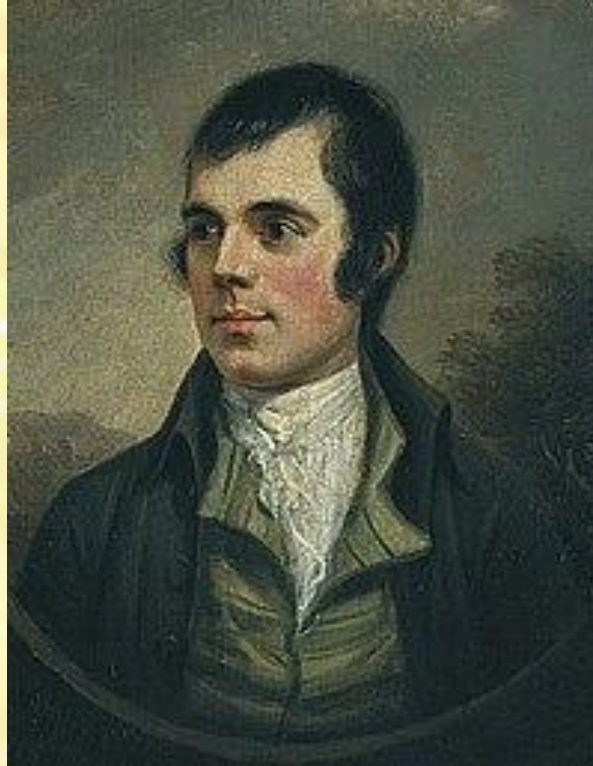


Burns Night

R. Burns was a Scottish poet and lyricist. He was the national poet of Scotland and is celebrated worldwide. He is the best known of the poets who have written in the Scots and English language.



Burns Night

Burns Birthday (25th January) is a national holiday in Scotland. Its name *Burns Night* or *Burns Supper*. This is a traditional dinner with the order of the dishes sung by the poet, brought in to the music of the Scottish bagpipe and reading lyrics of Burns (by the afternoon prayer “**The Selkirk Grace**” and “**Ode to Haggis**”).



Burns Night

During the meal sounds other poems, jokes and torches in the world of a world-famous poet. At the end of the evening guests stand and take each other`s hands and sing "Have a good time". It means the end of the holiday.
