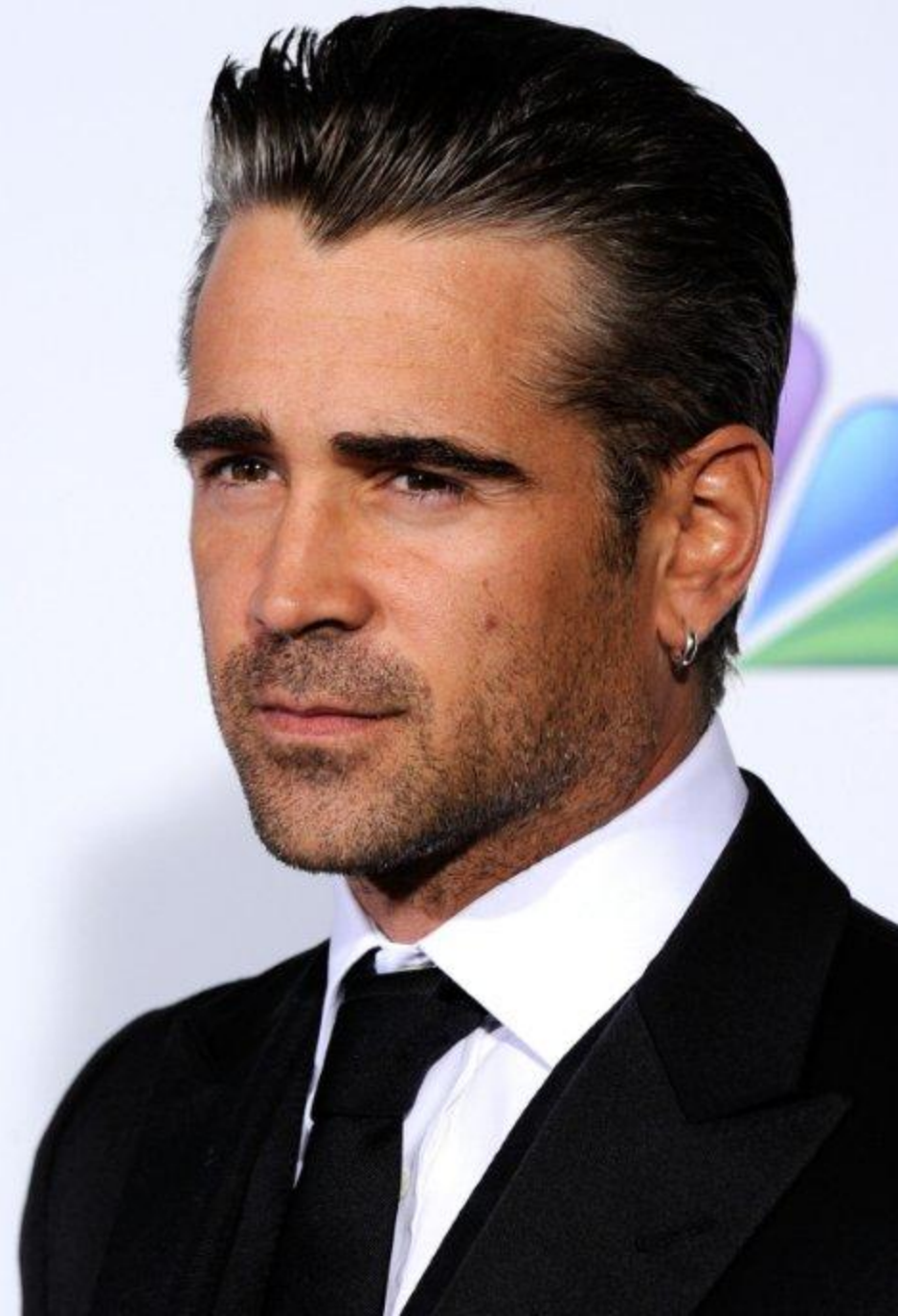

*Colin James Farrell (born May 31, 1976) is an Irish actor. Gained fame thanks to his roles in the films "Alexander," "phone booth", "dissenting opinion", "Recruit", "Miami. Division of manners" and many other.*

He was the fourth child in the family of professional footballers playing in the Farrell Éamon Club Shamrock Rovers and own packing company, and his wife-housewife Rita. Colin also has two sisters, Claudine (his personal assistant) and Catherine, and brother, Eamon, Jr. Brought up as a Catholic*

# Career.

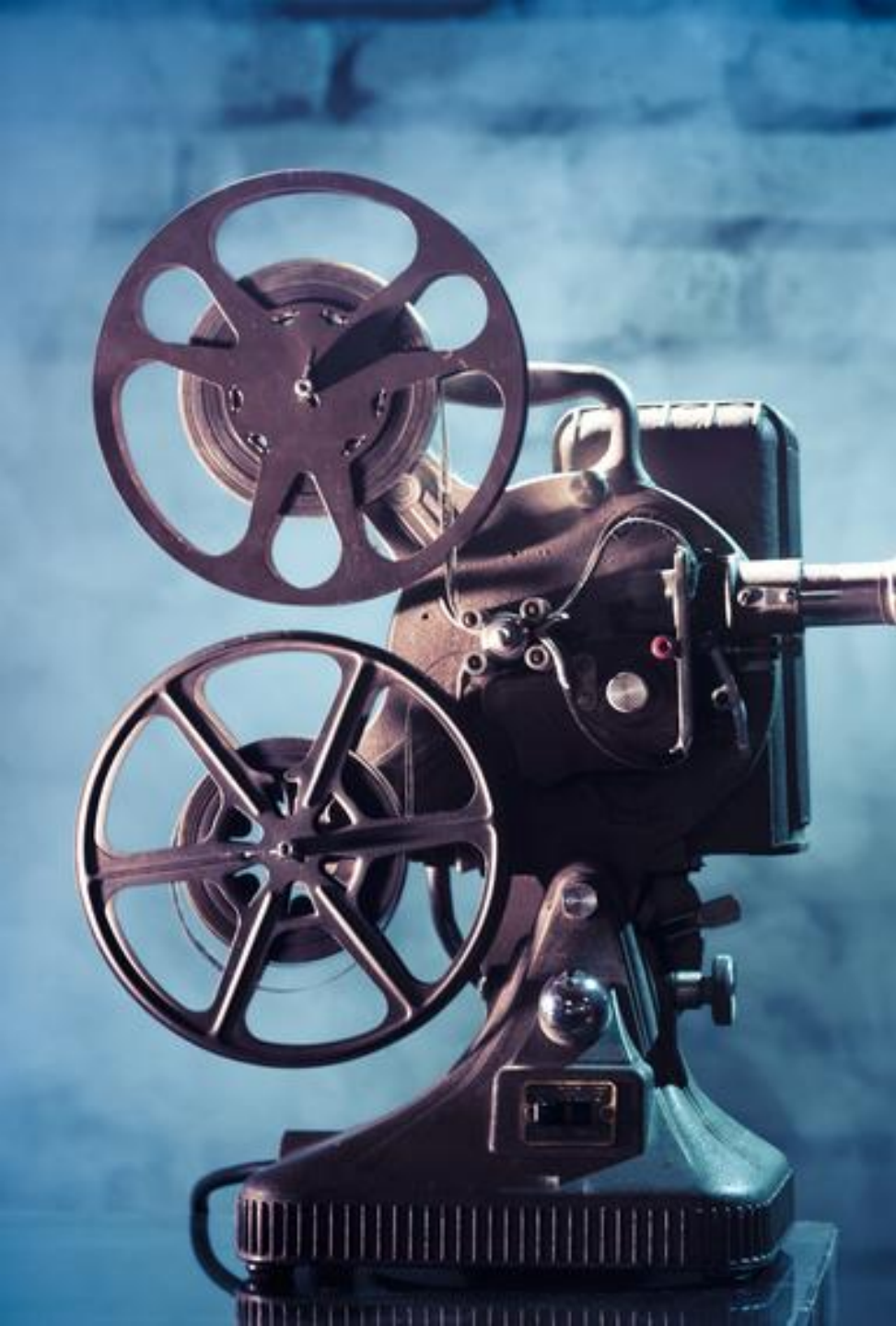
*Back in Dublin, Farrell on the advice of his brother began attending Éamon acting school The Gaiety School of Acting, but dropped out. In the year 1996 he made his debut in film in the drama "the disappearance Finbara", however, his role was so insignificant that the titles. Then, in 1997 the lead role in a low budget movie "crude oil", and in the summer of next year, Farrell starred in the miniseries "belyj tanets».*



# Career.

*Farrell felt hostility to any kind of educational institutions, threw a school and some time made a bullseye. Then, with some experience playing on the stage, took part in the staging of a small London Theater Donmar Warehouse. The role of an autistic teenager Richard Belamera was notable for Farrell in the fact that through it he met Kevin Spacey — he drew attention to the game of the young actor and advised the producers invite Farrell on one of the supporting roles of their future film "an ordinary offender».*





## *The first notable appearance of Farrell on the screen*

*In the meantime, the first notable appearance of Farrell on the screen — in 1999, he took part in the opening rezhissjorskom Tim Roth, the psychological thriller "the war zone" with Tilde Swinton and Ray Winston in the lead roles. In the same period, Farrell is filmed on television, appearing in seven episodes is quite popular in Ireland tv series "Ballykissangel" about the life of a young priest-Englishman in a small Irish village and in the television series "Purely English murder", "Love in the 21st century" and "David Copperfield" (true, when mounting a scene with his participation in this series were deleted). Later in the year 2000 thanks to the patronage of Kevin Spacey, Farrell starred as the young Bandit Alec criminal comedy Ordinary offender» about daring Linche grabitele. Despite a strong cast, the picture failed at the box office and received very negative reviews from critics*

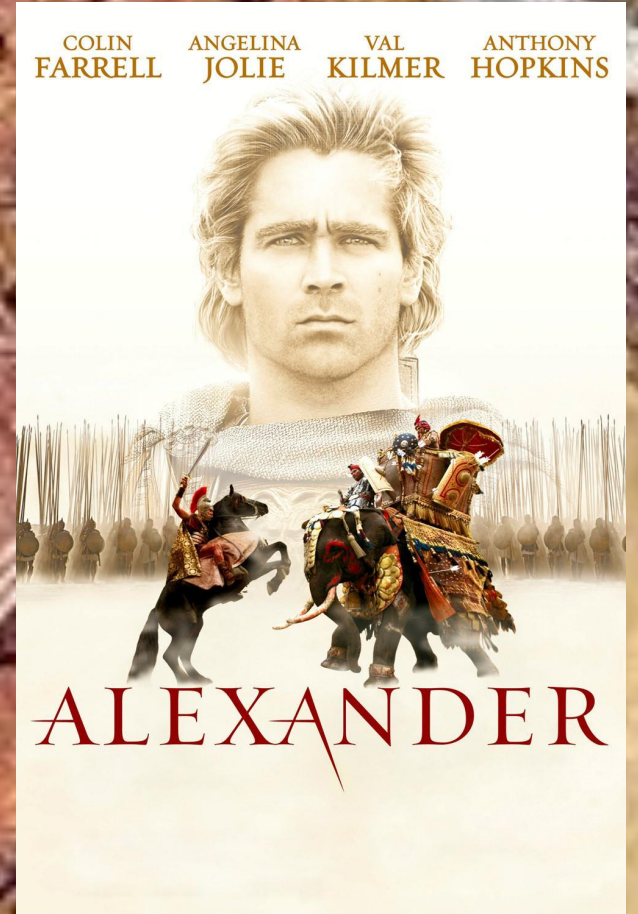




# Alexander.

*«Alexander»— historical film directed by Oliver Stone about the life and death of the Commander of Alexander the great.*

*The movie tells the story of friendship, love, betrayal, and about human life, subsequently became great.*



plot.



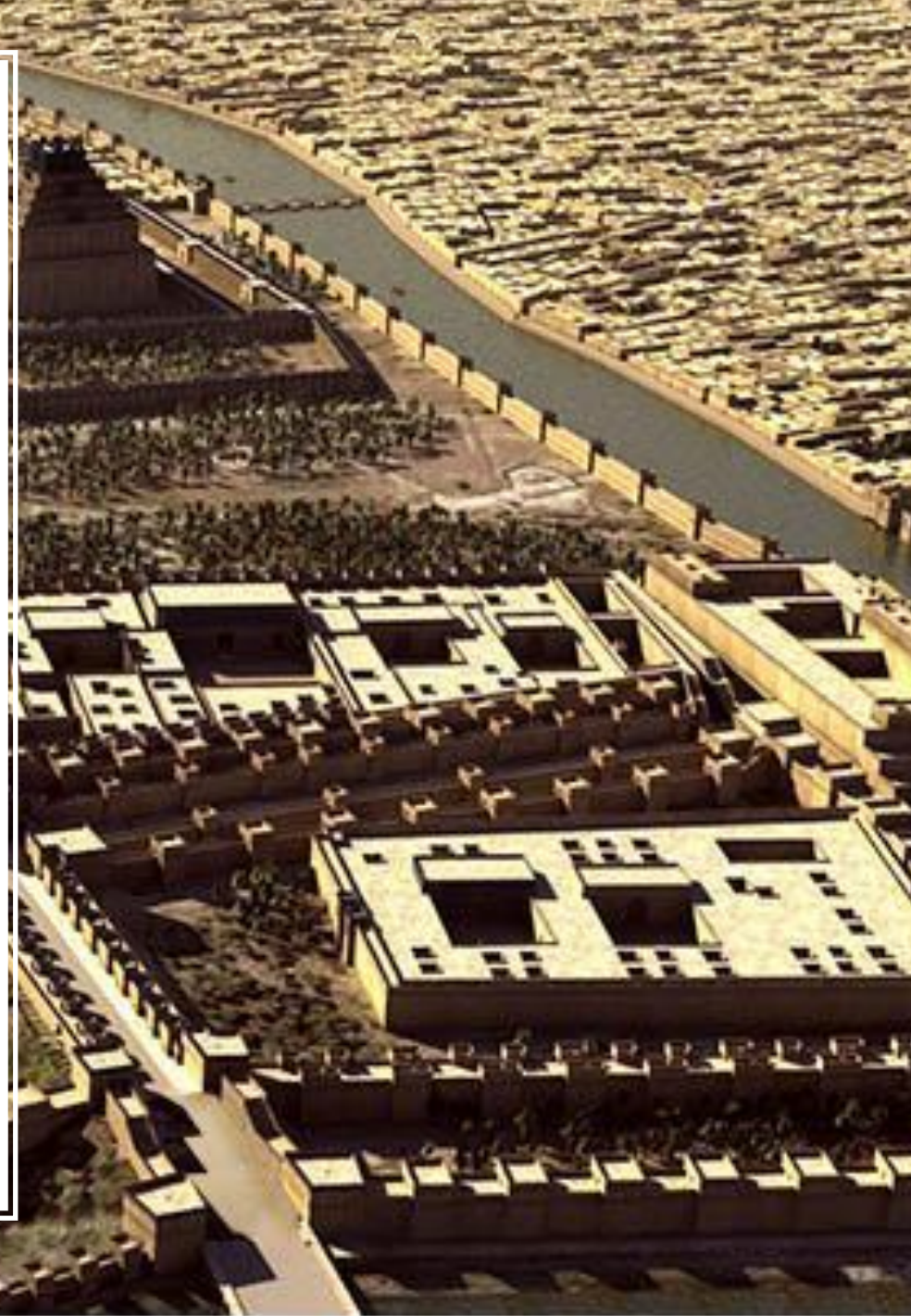
*The story of Alexander tells the elderly Ptolemy Lag, who was once his colleague and became the King of Egypt, and focuses primarily on the conquest of Alexander of Persia and India. Events are taking place against the background of the personal life of the great Commander. In 20 years the King of Macedonia, Alexander for 13 years reign conquered most of the known civilized world at that time. Director trying to comprehend such a brilliant success and fate of Alexander, who admired him, as God.*

*In the film, although not in some detail with historical accuracy, showing two battles: the battle of gaugamela and the Persian King Darius III Kodomanom and the river Hidaspin with the Indian King Horn.*



*At the beginning of the film tells about parents of Ptolemy Alexander the great-King of Macedonia, Philip II and his wife Jepirskuju Olympiad and shared an unsuccessful life. Shows how Alexander studied with the philosopher Aristotle, bucefal spoke at the Piru quarrelled with his father. As a result, Philip II dies at the hands of bodyguard-lover Pausanias, Alexander becomes King of Macedonia and Olympias, on which Palo suspicion of murder put massacre of newly minted King's wife and her child..*

The latter shares power with his old Commander Antipatrom-the father of a young military Cassandra and Alexander embarks on a crusade to the East, in the course of which inflicts a decisive defeat on the Persians at Gaugamela, and captures Babylon. Young and invincible King declares Babylon the capital of his new empire and immediately gives security guarantees daughter Daria Kodomana Statire that marks the beginning of the Eastern policy of the Tsar. Alexander soon buries found them murdered satrap-traitor Bessom Darius, invades Bactria and Sogdia and there on Piru sees Princess Roxana among dancers. He intends to marry Roxana, but this causes opposition from military commanders, and Cassander comes into conflict with the King.



*Despite this, Alexander marries Roxana, with Princess itself originally did not want to marry konsumirovat', and attempted to kill the King with a dagger. Alexander soon satisfied repressions against comrades — Parmenion and his son, Filoty, and Filotu are executed after a trial and Parmenion was killed by the hands of Antigonus Cyclops-Imperial Commander. The invincible King of the Hindu Kush mountains and leads overcomes the army of the Indus Valley, but his bereavement. At Piru Alexander kills during an argument on the feast of its ally and friend Black Klita, moreover, he makes his favorite persa Bagoja, who noticed the King of Macedonia, still in Babylon. Soon the Macedonian army wins the battle with the Indian King Horn, during which Alexander gets wounded and Bucephalus dies. In the end, the Macedonian King, realizing all the difficulties of its army during the long and grueling campaign, returned to Babylon. There are dying from the illness of the King's closest friend Hephæstion and Alexander himself and soon dies.*

*At the end of the film, Ptolemy completes the story that tells her slave-Secretary about the fate of the family of Alexander and his empire.*
