- * Symbol-----Daffodil

Northern Ireland

- * Capital-----Belfast
- * Population----1.5 million
- * Symbol-----Shamrock

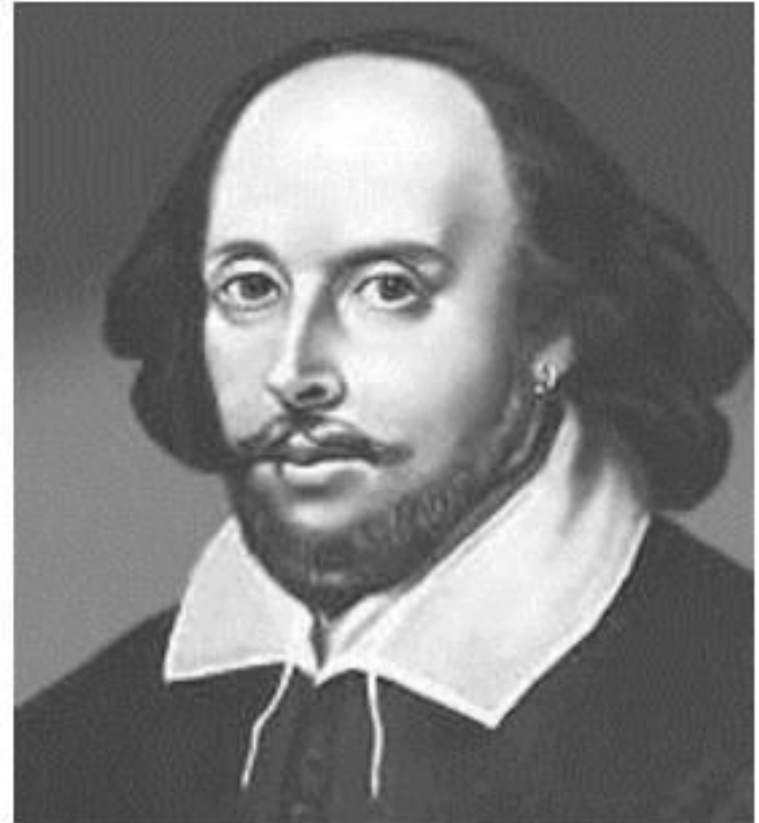
The beatles

-an English writer of plays ,one of the most famous ever. Among the most famous of his plays are the tragedies of *Romeo and Juliet*, *Julius Caesar*, *Hamlet*, *Othello*, *King Lear*, the comedies of *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, *The Merchant of Venice*, and the historical plays *Richard III* and *Henry V*. He also wrote some very good poetry, especially the Sonnets, and worked as an actor at the Globe
