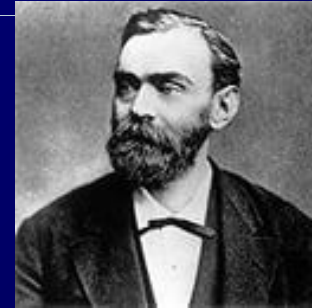

- ✦ Fell in love for the first time at the age of 40;
- ✦ In his honour the asteroid was named;
- ✦ Wasn't a "public man" – loved to be alone.

Alfred spoke 5 languages: Swedish, German, Russian, English and French. Best of all he loved English but preferred to read books by Russian authors.

The way Nobel Prize looks

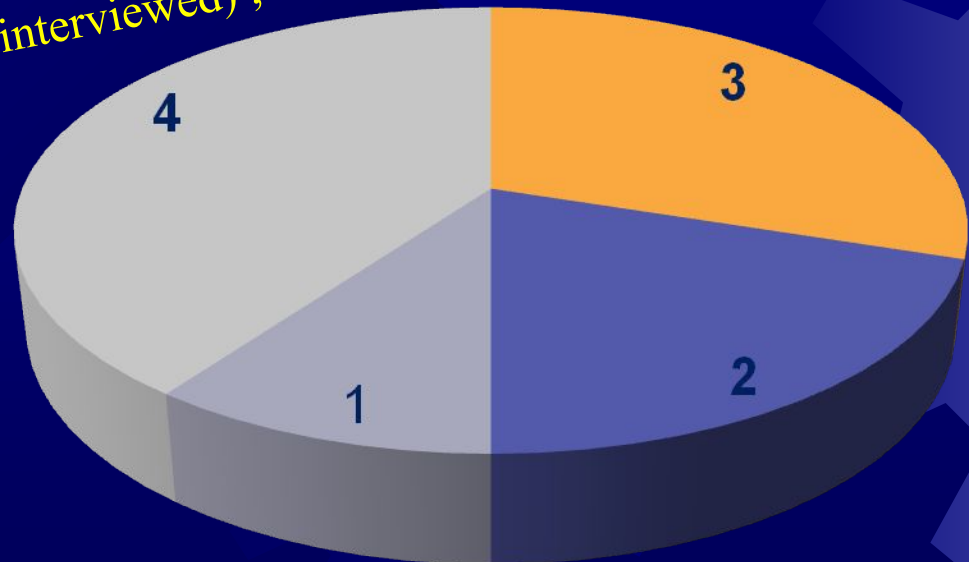
