Degradation of agricultural land has led to drought and soil erosion in many areas. Hence, malnutrition, hunger, and disease.



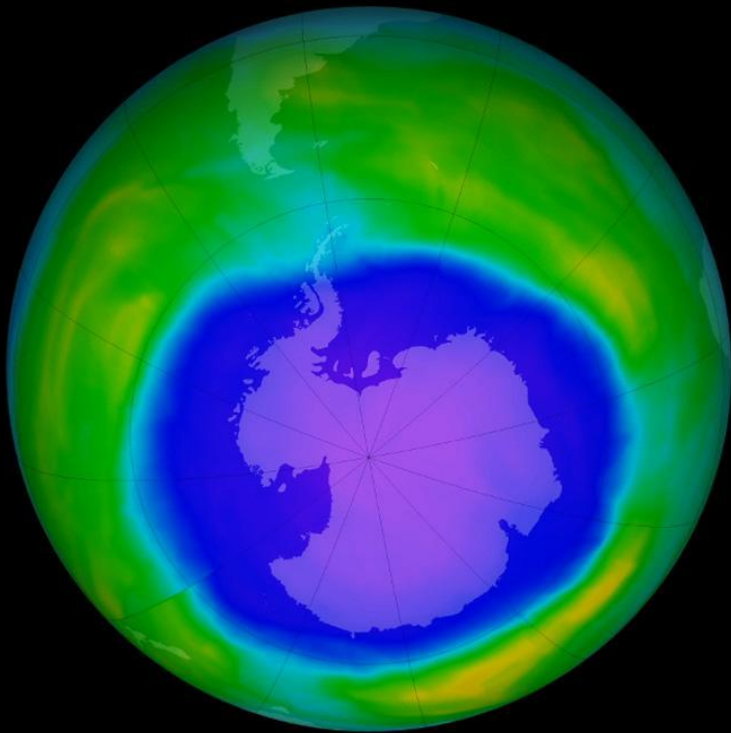
Air pollution causes more significant damage to human health.
