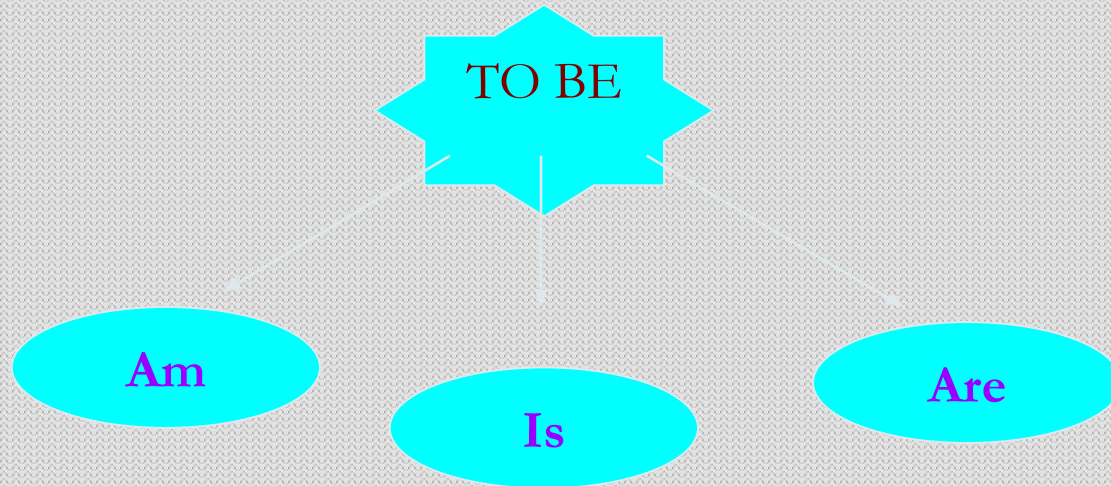
To BE
