FOR EXAMPLE:

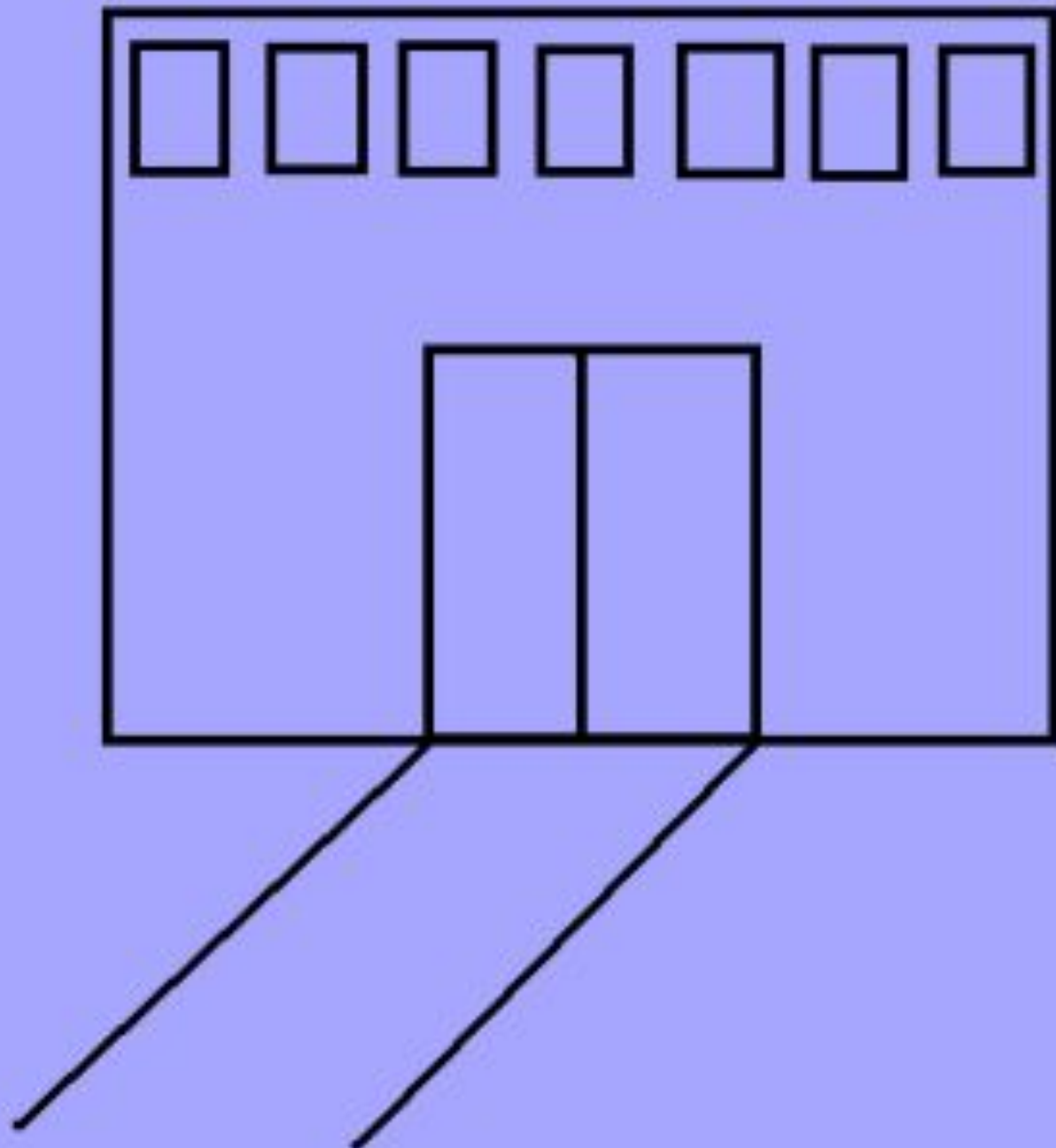
- **Be polite**

- **Must not talk at the lessons**

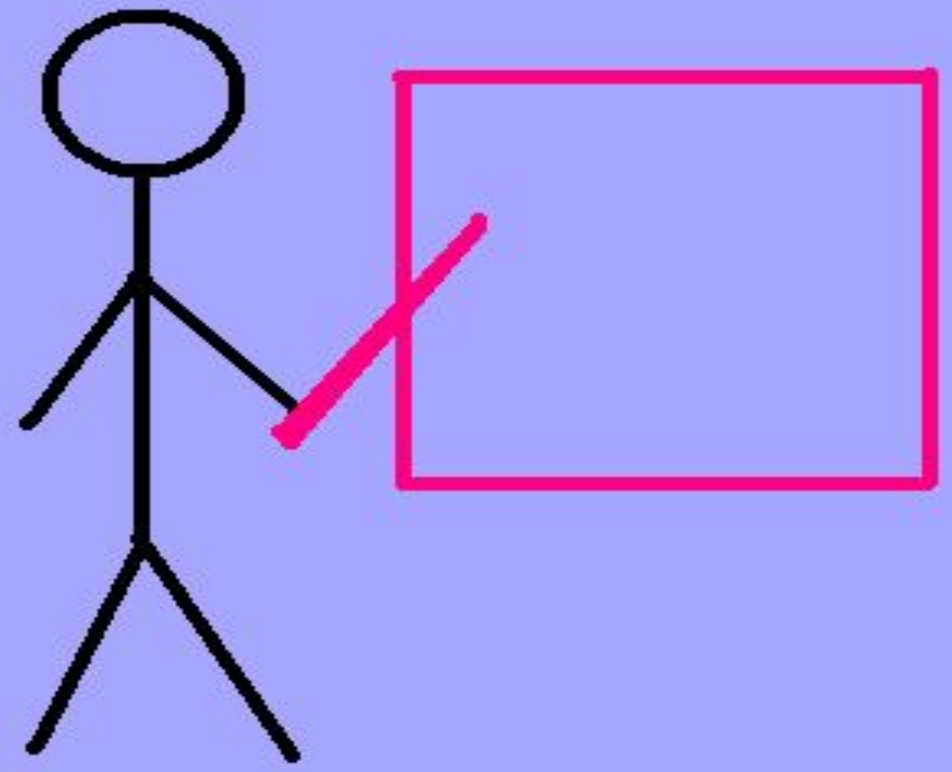


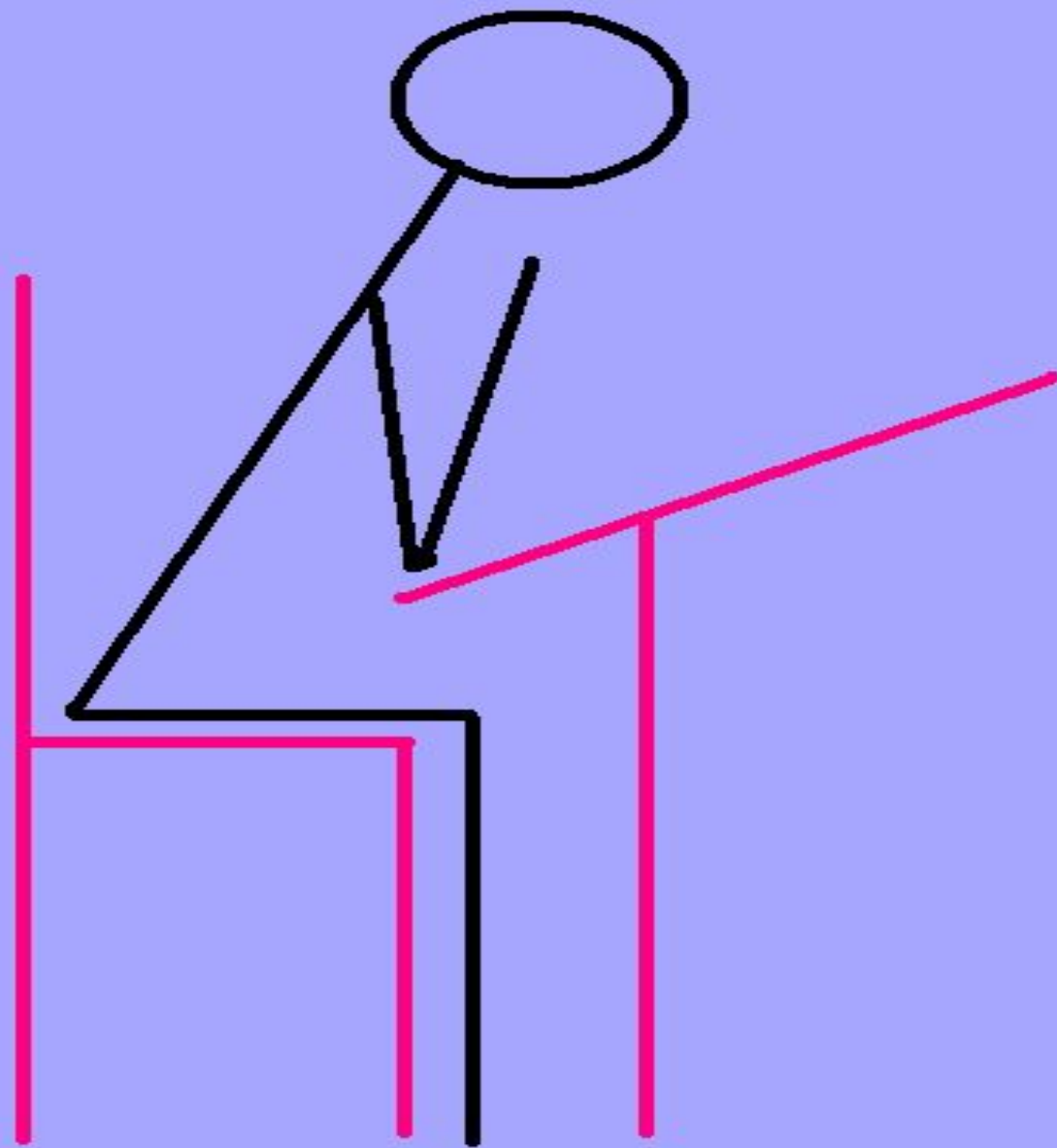

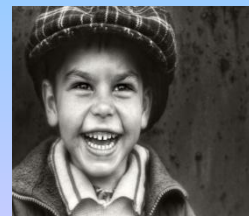
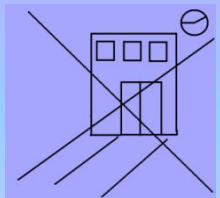
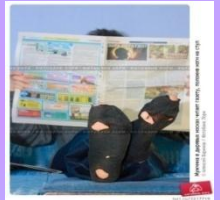
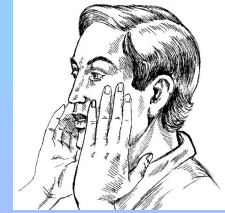
In 1880s Australian children could:
