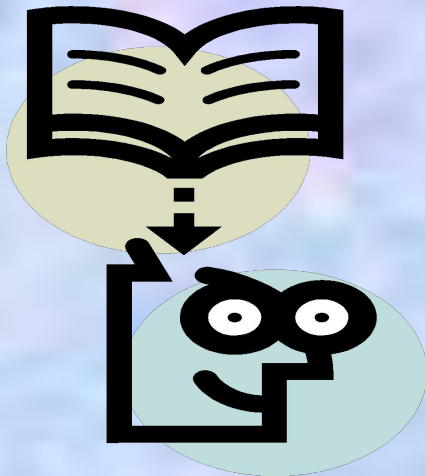

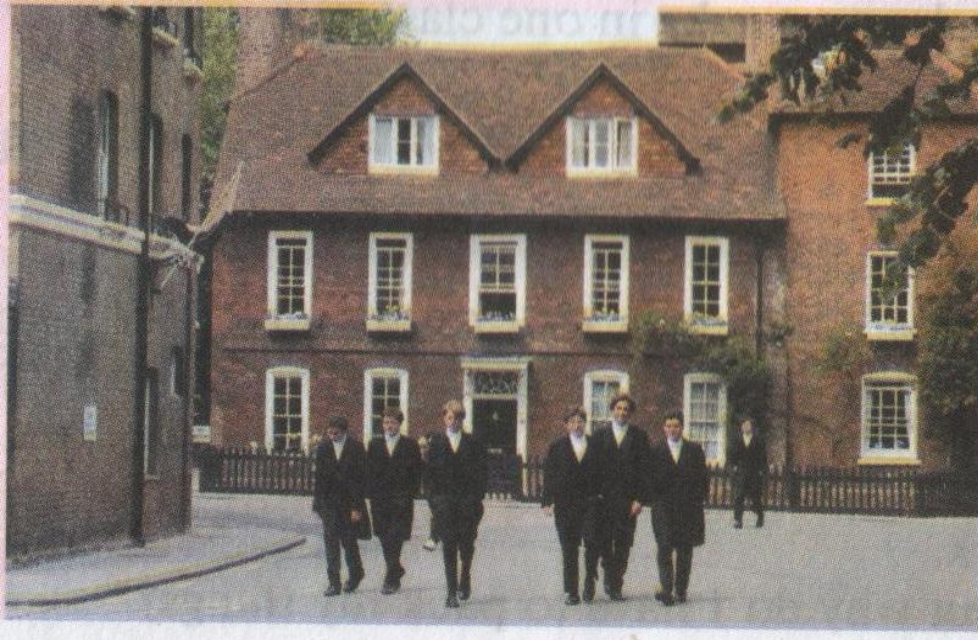

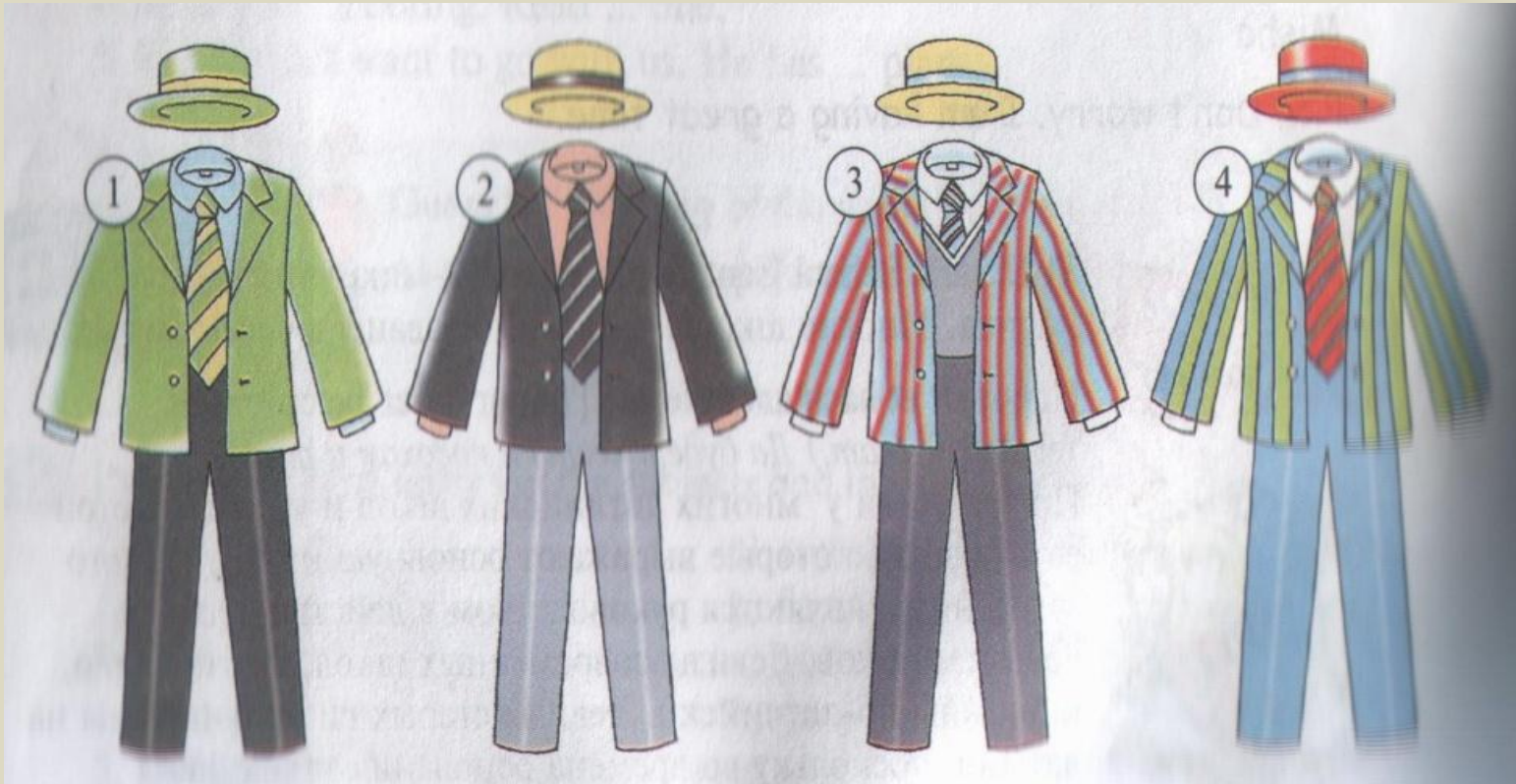

**School tie** – у англичан есть выражение **"To be true to your school tie"** -

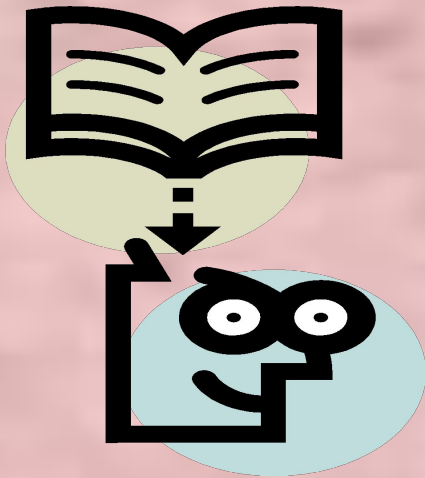
