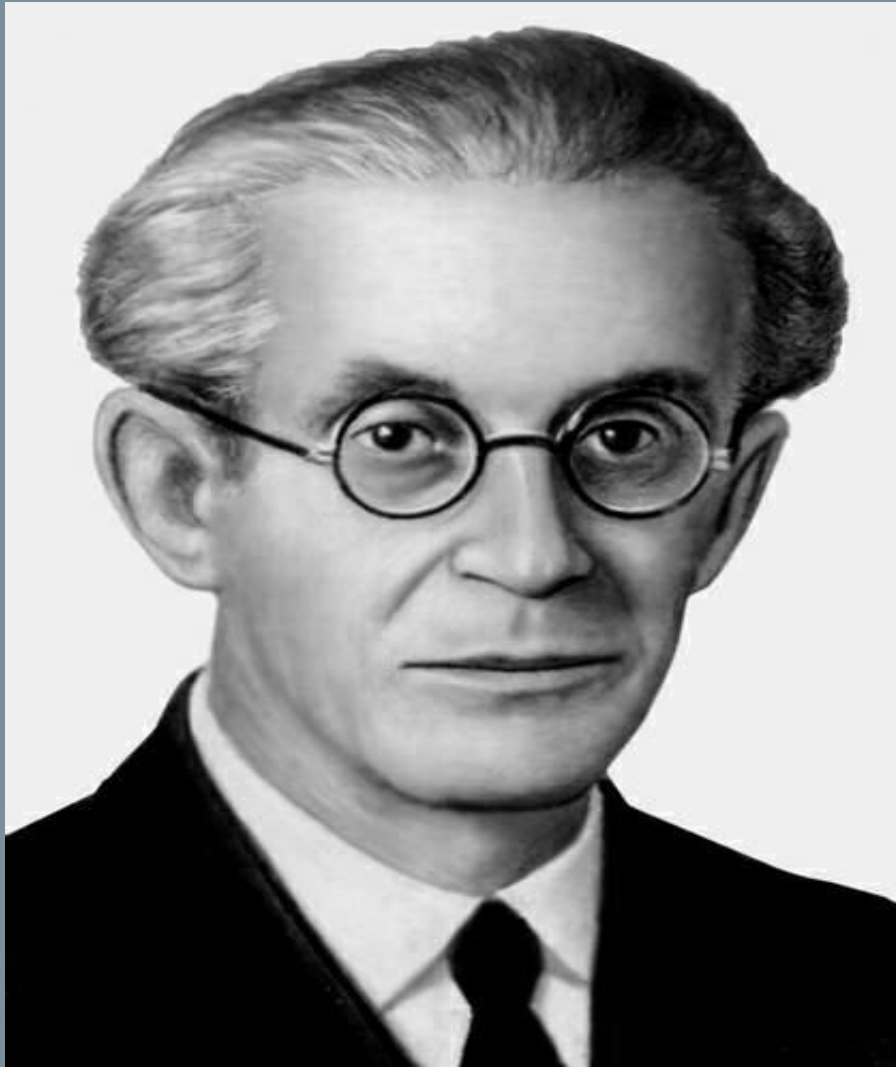

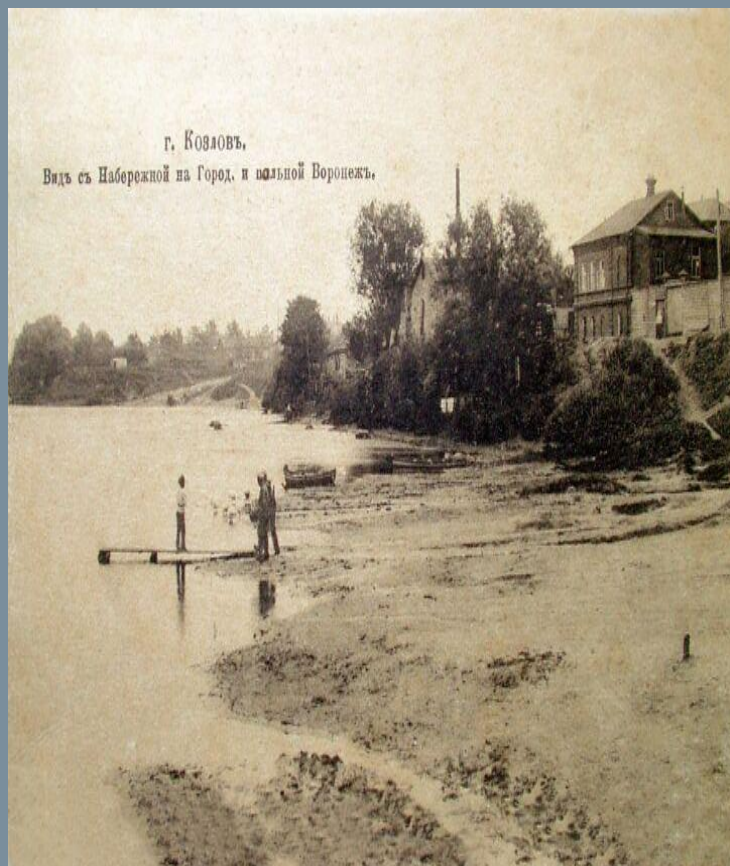

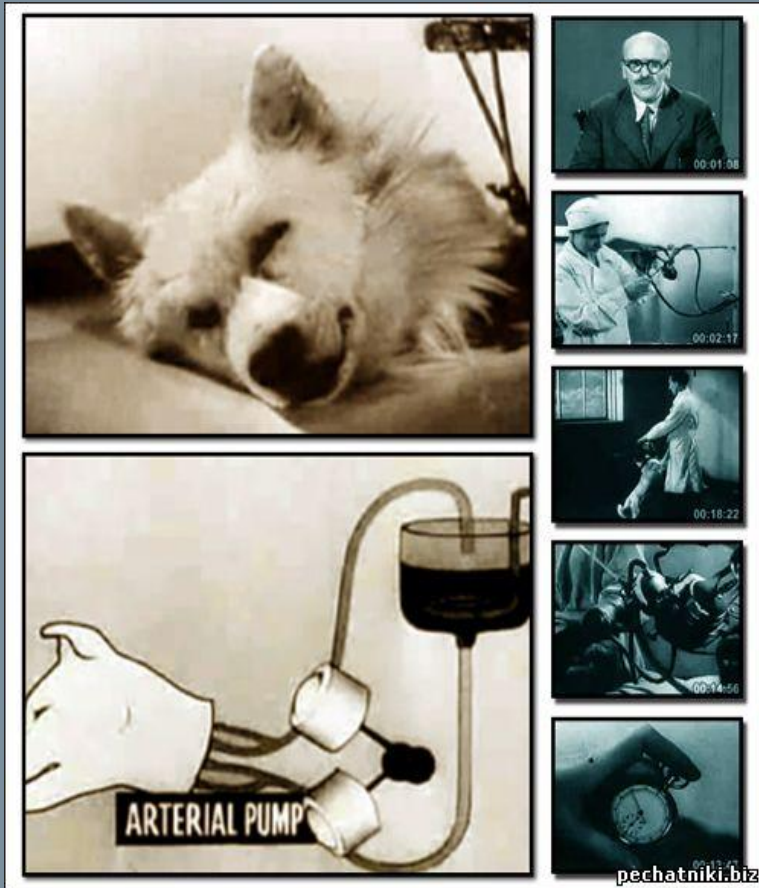


Some facts about our countryman.

- The main problem, which doctor worked - a problem of an artificial circulation



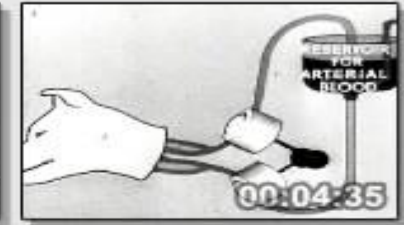
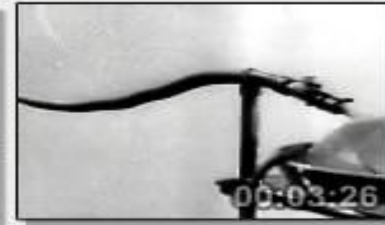
The main achievements of the scientist

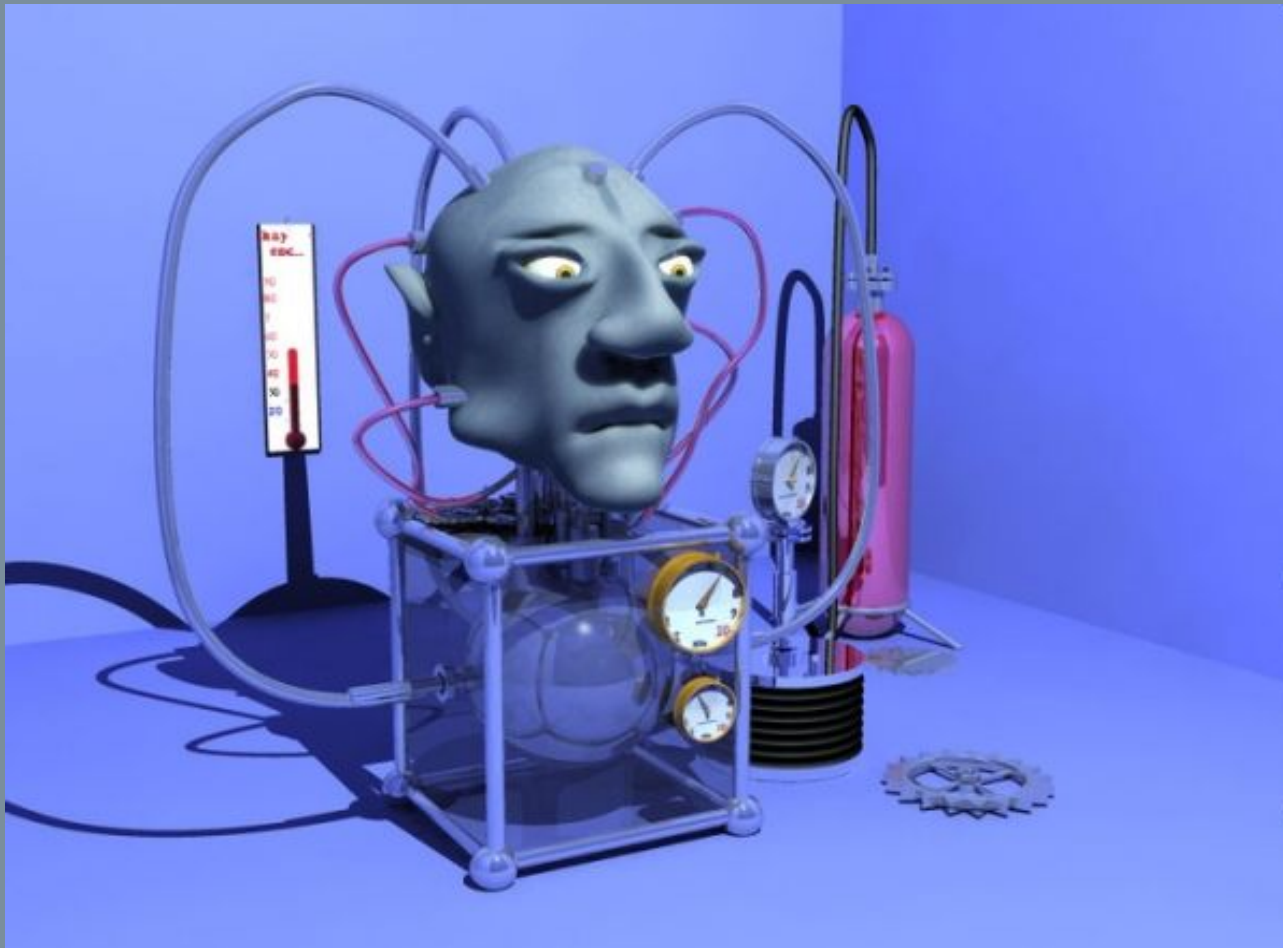
Mikhail Bulgakov was impressed by the experiments Brukhonenko created one of his most famous works- the fantastic novel " The dog's heart ".

In 1942 in the Sklifosovsky Institute under the leadership Brukhonenko were developed conditions of preservation of the blood to keep it for two-three weeks, that was extremely important in providing assistance to the wounded.
