- The E-Teacher Scholarship Program offers English teaching professionals living outside of the United States the opportunity to take one of nine online professional development courses through the University of Oregon.

TESOL CORE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

Developed by Teachers of English to Speakers of Other Languages, Inc., the TESOL Core Certificate Program is a 130-hour online training program providing a foundation in the theory and practice of English language teaching.

- ◉ a 60-hour (6-week) online foundation course: **“Fundamentals of TESOL.”**
- ◉ a 60-hour (6-week) online specialty course. Participants choose one of two specialty courses: **“Teaching Language Skills and Assessment: Adult Learners”** or **“Teaching Language Skills and Assessment: Young Learners.”**
- ◉ a 10-hour professional development

TESOL CORE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM CONTENT

- ◉ **Principles of ESOL Adult Language Instruction.**
- ◉ Motivation, culture and identity. Teaching and learning styles.
- ◉ Reading and literacy (Intensive and extensive reading. Assessing reading.)
- ◉ Listening, vocabulary, and digital resources: (Types of listening tasks and their contribution to the development of listening skills. Assessing listening. The most effective vocabulary learning strategies. Digital resources for listening and vocabulary).
- ◉ Speaking and pronunciation. (Providing conditions for genuine speaking practice. Various speaking activities. Aspects of pronunciation and intonation and their teaching. Assessing speaking).

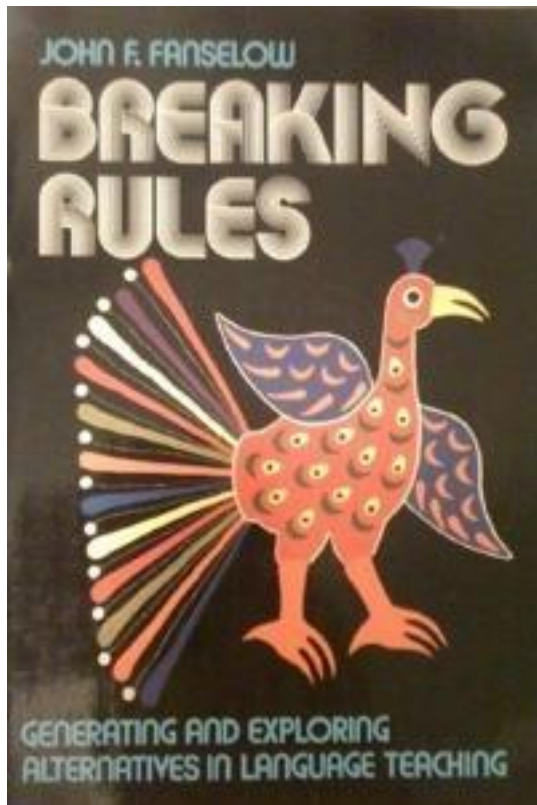
