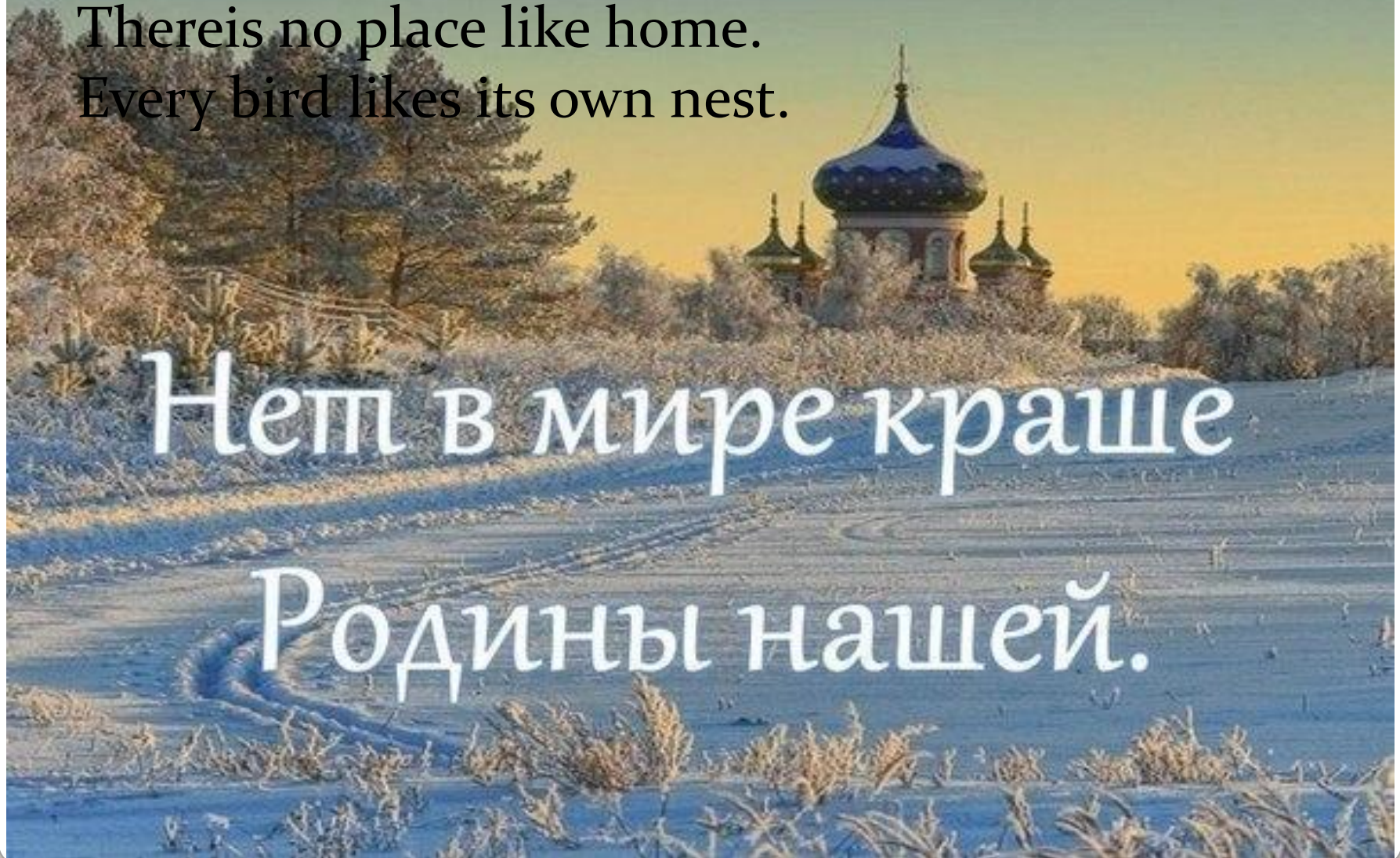

The Seven Strong Men Rock Formations or Poles (The Komi Republic) are 7 gigantic stone pillars. They are around 30 to 42 m high. They were formed by ice and winds.

Lake Baikal is a lake in the south of Siberia. Lake Baikal contains 20% of the world's unfrozen surface fresh water. It is the clearest of all lakes.




The Petergoff Palace includes palaces and gardens. It is located in Saint Petersburg. It is famous for its fountains.



Mamayev Kurgan is a great monument in Volgograd. It commemorates the Stalingrad Battle. In 1967 the statue named "The Motherland Calls" was the largest free-standing sculpture in the world.
