Просьбы, советы и приказы в косвенной речи

- Приказы, советы и просьбы можно вводить не только глаголом tell. Рассмотрите список некоторых глаголов, которыми можно заменить tell, чтобы более точно передать смысл высказывания:
- 1. order - приказывать
- 2. warn - предупреждать
- 3. ask – спрашивать, просить
- 4. advise - советовать
- 5. invite - приглашать
- 6. beg - умолять
- 7. teach - учить
- 8. forbid – запрещать
- Пример:
- The doctor said to me, 'Stop smoking!' → The doctor **told** me to stop smoking.
- 'Get out of the car!' said the policeman. → The policeman **ordered** him to get out of the car.
- The man with the gun said to us, 'Don't move!' → The man with the gun **warned** us not to move.

Запомните универсальную формулу, которая поможет вам избежать ошибок в косвенной речи

- **He asked me to do something / He asked me not to do something.**

Просьбы об объектах в косвенной речи

• **ask + for + object**

Пример:

- ‘Can I have an orange?’ she asked. → She asked for an orange.
- ‘Can I have the magazine, please?’ he asked. → He asked for the magazine.
- ‘May I have a glass of apple juice?’ he said. → He asked for a glass of apple juice.
- ‘Salt, please.’ → She asked for the salt.

Предложения (suggestions) в косвенной речи

Они переводятся в косвенную речь по следующему образцу:

- She said, 'Why don't you get a mechanic to look at the car?' →
- She **suggested that I should get** a mechanic to look at the car.
- or
- She **suggested I get** a mechanic to look at the car.
- В таких случаях также можно использовать глаголы:
- 1. insist - настаивать
- 2. recommend - рекомендовать
- 3. demand - требовать
- 4. request - запрашивать
- 5. propose – предлагать

- The policeman said: “Keep the silence, please.” (Полицейский сказал: «Соблюдайте тишину, пожалуйста.») – The policeman asked
- Mother said: “Kids, you should wash your hands before lunch.” (Мама сказала: «Дети, нужно помыть руки перед обедом.») – Mother advised
- The dentist told me: “Don’t eat nuts anymore.” (Дантист сказал мне: «Больше не ешь орехи.») – The dentist warned
- Tom : “Could you lend me 20 dollars, please?” (Том: «Ты не мог бы одолжить мне 20 долларов?») – Tom asked
- Mr. Walters told his sons: “You must stay away from the lake.” (М-р Уолтерс сказал сыновьям: «Вы должны держаться подальше от озера.») – Mr. Walters warned
- John said: “You should see a lawyer, Ted.” (Джон сказал: «Тебе следует посетить адвоката.») – John advised
- The teacher told the students: “Don’t talk during the test.” (Учитель сказал студентам: «Не разговаривайте во время контрольной.») – The teacher warned
- The judge said: “Mr. Brown, you must pay a big fine.” (Судья сказал: «М-р Браун, вы обязаны заплатить большой штраф.») – The judge ordered
