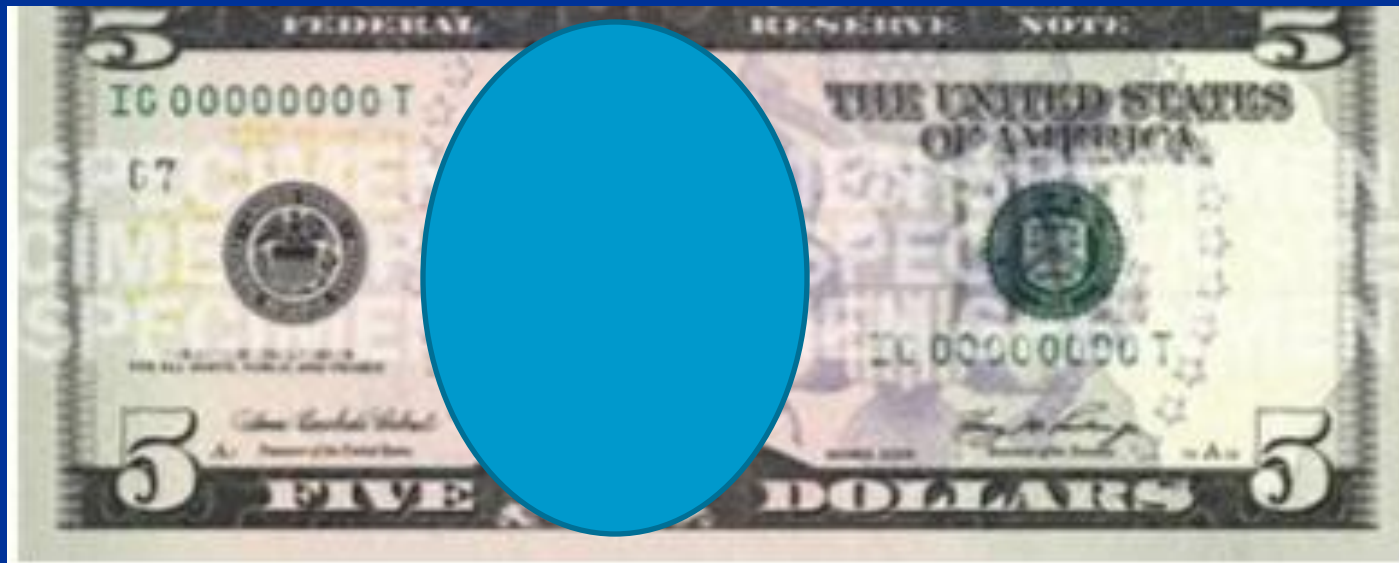

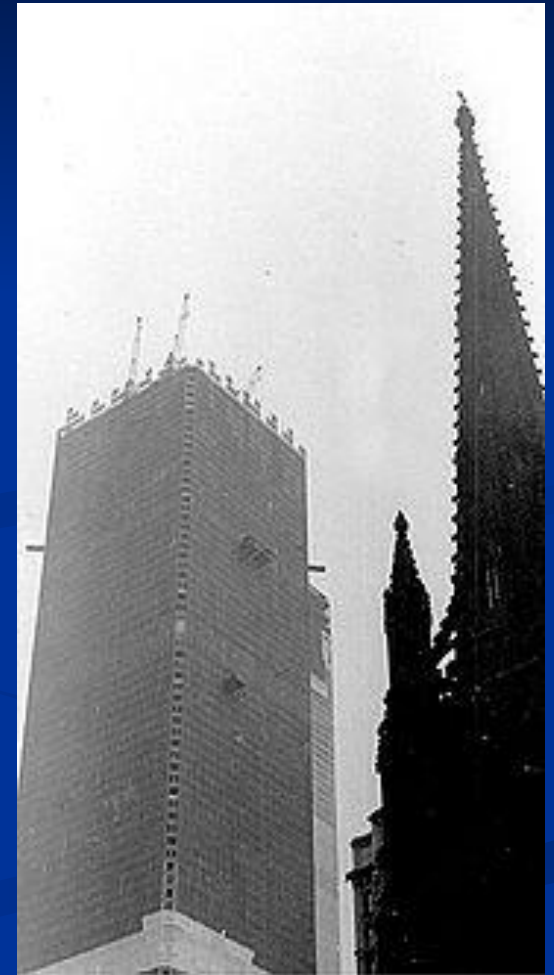

# New grammar

## Условные предложения (в изъявительном и сослагательном наклонении)

**Изъявительное наклонение** выражает реальность выполнения действия, обусловленную вполне реальными условиями:

*I will help you if you ask me. — Я тебе помогу, если ты попросишь.*

**Сослагательное наклонение** выражает невозможность, нереальность, предположительность, условность действия в настоящем, будущем и прошедшем времени:

*I would help you if you asked me. — Я бы помог тебе, если бы ты попросил* (предположительность, ограниченность некоторыми условиями настоящего или будущего времени).

*I would have helped you if you had asked me. — Я бы помог тебе, если бы ты попросил* (нереальность, определенная некоторыми условиями прошлого).

Вместо глагола *would* могут также использоваться глаголы *could*, *might*, придавая таким образом всему высказыванию различные оттенки:

*If I learnt his address, I could write to him. — Если бы я узнал его адрес, я смог бы написать ему* (сейчас или в ближайшем будущем).

*If I learnt his address, I might write to him. — Если бы я узнал его адрес, я, вероятно, мог бы написать ему* (сейчас или в ближайшем будущем).
